**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (12-14) fell to the Biloxi Shuckers (17-10) by a 3-2 score in the second game of the five-game series at MGM Park on Thursday night. With the Shuckers trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the ninth, Biloxi centerfielder Corey Ray ended the game with a two-run walk-off home run to right field to give the Shuckers their second straight one-run win in the series. Jacksonville right-handed relief pitcher Marcus Crescentini (1-3) allowed the walk-off homer in the ninth to take the loss, while Biloxi right-handed relief pitcher Brad Kuntz (1-2) earned the win. With runners on the corners in the top of the first, an errant pickoff attempt by Ventura at first base scored Isan Diaz from third to give Jacksonville a 1-0 lead. Jacksonville maintained the lead thanks to a strong start by right-handed starter Pablo Lopez. He turned in five scoreless innings allowing three hits with two walks and four strikeouts, and his first 14 innings pitched at the Double-A level have been scoreless. The Shuckers tied the game at 1-1 in the bottom of the seventh with a solo homer by Clint Coulter off Jacksonville reliever Zech Lemond. Later in the inning with the bases loaded and one out, Stephen Vogt flew into a double play against Jacksonville left-handed reliever Jeff Kinley, with Cade Gotta throwing out Wendell Rijo at home plate to keep the game tied. The game remained tied until the top of the ninth, when with two outs Isan Diaz hit an RBI single to centerfield to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 2-1 lead. The bottom of the ninth began with Coulter reaching on an error by Jumbo Shrimp shortstop Chris Diaz, then two batters later Ray hit the walk-off home run to right field to end the game. The Jumbo Shrimp were 1-for-13 batting with runners in scoring position, and the Jumbo Shrimp left nine runners on base in the one-run loss.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Norwood Gets On Base:** John Norwood carries the Southern League's longest consecutive game on-base streak into tonight's game at Biloxi Norwood dating back to April 9 has reached base safely in his last 21 games entering Thursday's games, hitting .301 in that stretch with three home runs and seven runs batted in, and his on-base percentage in that time is .348. This is the longest consecutive game on-base streak that began during the 2018 season. In 25 total games, Norwood has been on base in 24 of them, with the lone exception being his game on Sunday April 8 at Jackson when he went 0-for-4 at the plate.

**Hernandez Starts in Rehab Assignment:** Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Elieser Hernandez is making his second major league rehab start from the Miami Marlins, Hernandez was sidelined due to dental surgery in spring training, and is in his first season with the Marlins after he was selected in the major league phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft from the Houston Astros. Hernandez had a no decision in his last start on Sunday, working five innings where he allowed a run.

**Harrison Heating Up:** Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Monte Harrison is having one of his best stretches of the young 2018 season at the plate. Harrison has homered twice in the last seven games for Jacksonville, and Sunday went deep to left field despite a howling wind at the time. Harrison has hit safely in 11 of the last 12 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, and over his last 10 games is hitting .359 with two home runs and three runs batted in. Harrison is now regarded as Miami's No. 1 prospect according to MLB.com. Harrison is also facing his former organization, as he was traded from the Brewers to the Marlins along with teammate Isan Diaz and Lewis Brinson, Jordan Yamamoto in exchange for outfielder Christian Yelich in January 2018.

**Shrimp and Shuckers:** This is the first of four series this season between Jacksonville and Biloxi. The next two meetings will be in Jacksonville from June 8-12 and in the second half from July 12-16. The Jumbo Shrimp will not make a return trip to Biloxi until August 6-12. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Shuckers played five series, with Jacksonville going 9-15 in those games. That included a 6-9 record in Biloxi, and the Shrimp were 3-6 against the Shuckers in Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp did win their last series here in late August, including a key doubleheader sweep on August 30 that shrunk Jacksonville's magic number to clinch the second half South Division title from five to one, and the Shrimp clinched a playoff berth the next day with a win at home against the Blue Wahoos.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months. Today Neidert starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Shuckers in Biloxi, and he carries a 2-1 record with a 4.12 ERA into his fifth start of the season.

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**32 – ELIESER HERNANDEZ, RHP**

**LAST START:** After his major league rehab assignment was transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville, Hernandez made his Double-A debut on Sunday April 29 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Hernandez worked five innings where he allowed a run on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts. The lone run he allowed was a leadoff home run by Brian O'Grady, then his final four innings were scoreless. He left the game with Jacksonville in front 2-1, and the Shrimp would win the game 4-3 thanks to Sharif Othman's walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth.

**DISABLED LIST TO START 2018:** Hernandez is on Miami's disabled list after dental surgery this spring. Hernandez made two rehab starts for Jupiter, going 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA, with starts on April 6 and April 24. He missed time in mid-April with a broken finger nail in his first rehab start on April 6. In his last start on Tuesday April 24, Hernandez pitched four innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts as the Hammerheads fell to the Palm Beach Cardinals 5-4.

**RULE 5 DRAFT PICK-UP:** Hernandez was acquired by the Marlins from the Houston Astros in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft on December 14, 2017. A team that selects a player in the Rule 5 Draft pays \$50,000 to the team from which he was selected. The receiving team must then keep the player on the Major League 25-man roster for the entirety of the next season, and the selected player must remain active (not on the disabled list) for a minimum of 90 days. If the player does not remain on the Major League roster, he is offered back to the team from which he was selected for \$25,000. If his original team declines, the receiving team may waive the player.

**2017 WITH BUIES CREEK:** Hernandez posted a 4-5 record and a 3.98 ERA over 15 appearances and 11 starts with High-A Buies Creek in the Astros organization. He missed two months due to a back injury suffered midseason.

Acquired by the Marlins from the Houston Astros in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft on December 14, 2017

**2017 Highlights:** Hernandez posted a 4-5 record and a 3.98 ERA over 15 appearances and 11 starts with High-A Buies Creek in the Astros organization. He missed two months due to a back injury suffered midseason. Made seven appearances, five starts, before landing on disabled list with right back strain on May 19, in that time went 2-3 with a 5.46 ERA. Made three rehab appearances with the GCL Astros, going 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 10 innings. Following reinstatement, went 2-2 with a 2.67 ERA in eight appearances and six starts. As starter: 2-5, 4.17 ERA in 11 starts, and as reliever: 2-0, 3.29 ERA in four games in relief. After the season made five starts with Aguilas del Zulia in Venezuelan Winter League, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA.

**2016 Highlights:** Combined to go 6-8 with a 4.51 ERA in 24 appearances (19 starts) between Single-A Quad Cities and High-A Lancaster. With Quad Cities went 4-3 with a 2.37 ERA in 11 appearances and nine starts. With Lancaster, 2-5 with a 6.93 ERA in 13 appearances and 10 starts.
