**Last Game:** Jackson Generals right-hander Taylor Widener struck out a career-high 12 batters in six shutout innings, leading the visitors to an 11-3 series-opening win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 2,325 at Publix Corks & Forks Wednesday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Widener (4-3) kept Jacksonville (27-37) hitless until two outs in the fourth inning. He scattered three hits and two walks while striking out each Jumbo Shrimp batter at least once. The Generals (36-29) took a 3-0 lead in the second inning against Jacksonville right-hander Cody Poteet (2-7). Jackson right fielder Josh Prince reached on a dropped fly ball by right fielder John Norwood, went to third base on catcher Marcus Littlewood's single, and scored on shortstop Jose Vinicio's RBI single to left field. Widener had a bunt single to load the bases, and center fielder Daniel Robertson hit a two-run single. In the fifth inning, Jackson third baseman Kevin Medrano hit a leadoff double to the left-field corner, Poteet walked first baseman Rudy Flores with one out, and left fielder Jamie Westbrook hit a two-run double to left field to extend Jackson's lead to 5-0. Poteet finished six innings, allowing five runs – four earned – on seven hits and two walks with five strikeouts. The Generals posted a five-run seventh inning against Jacksonville right-hander Zech Lemon. Medrano doubled to left field, second baseman Domingo Leyba singled to right field, and Flores hit an RBI single to left field, before Westbrook hit a two-run triple to right-center field. Two batters later, Littlewood hit a one-out, two-run home run to the right field bleachers to make it 10-0. In the bottom of the inning, the Jumbo Shrimp tallied three runs off right-hander Mason McCullough, as Norwood doubled, third baseman Brian Scales singled, and All-Star catcher Rodrigo Vigal hit an RBI single. A passed ball and sacrifice fly scored two more runs. Jackson's final run came on Flores' eighth-inning single.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Wittgren Joins Shrimp on Rehab Assignment:** Miami Marlins right-handed relief pitcher Nick Wittgren has joined the Jumbo Shrimp on a major league rehab assignment. Wittgren is currently on Miami's 10-day disabled list, retroactive to June 1, with a right middle finger contusion. Wittgren started the season in with Triple-A New Orleans, where he was 0-2 with a 10.13 ERA in seven relief outings with a save. Wittgren was recalled to the Marlins on April 21, and with Miami pitched in 18 games in relief while going 2-1 with a 3.06 ERA, striking out 17 batters in his 17 and two-thirds innings of work. Wittgren has pitched parts of the last three seasons for the Marlins in the majors, going 9-5 with a 3.71 ERA in 104 appearances. Wittgren previously pitched in Jacksonville in 2013 and 2014, collecting 20 saves during the 2014 Southern League Championship season.

**Diaz S.L. Player of the Week:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp second baseman Isan Diaz has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for June 4-10, announced by the league office on Monday. Diaz hit safely in all seven games last week, hitting .565 (13-for-23), which was the highest batting average in Double-A baseball and the fourth-highest in all of Minor League Baseball for that time period. During his hitting streak, Diaz drove in seven runs, collected four doubles, drew six walks, stole three bases, and scored five runs. His .667 on-base percentage was the best in Minor League Baseball for the week, and he also led the Southern League with a 1.406 on-base plus slugging percentage (OPS).

**Seven Shrimp All-Stars:** The Southern League announced that six Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp players have been named to the league's South Division All-Star roster for the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game on Tuesday, June 19, at Regions Field in Birmingham, Alabama. Right-handed pitchers Nick Neidert and Pablo Lopez, left-handed pitcher Jose Quijada, catcher Rodrigo Vigil, designated hitter Eric Jagielo, and outfielder Monte Harrison will represent Jacksonville as South Division All-Stars. Left-handed pitcher Jeff Kinley was also added to the South Division All-Star Roster Saturday June 9 by the Southern League.

**Generally Speaking:** This is the final of two series between the Jumbo Shrimp and Generals in 2018. The Jumbo Shrimp started the 2018 season at Jackson, losing four out of five games to the Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Generals split their five meetings, with Jacksonville winning three of five games in Jacksonville in late May, while the Generals won three of five in late June. The reason for so few meetings? The Jumbo Shrimp and Generals are separated by 713 miles, with typical bus rides lasting between 11 and 13 hours between North Florida and West Tennessee.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**23 – NICK NEIDERT, RHP**

**6-4, 3.31 ERA, 12 games and 12 starts**

**2018:** 6-4, 3.31 ERA (24 ER/65.1 IP) in 12 G and 12 GS.  
**CAREER:** 24-15, 2.96 ERA (105 ER/319.1 IP) in 67 G and 67 GS.

**2018 vs. JXN:** 0-0, 7.84 ERA (9 ER/10.1 IP) in 2 G and 2 GS.  
**CAREER vs. JXN:** Same.

**LAST START:** Neidert suffered his first loss in nearly a month on Saturday June 9 against the Jackson Generals at the Baseball Grounds. Neidert worked six innings where he allowed four runs on seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts. He allowed a run through the first five innings, then three in the sixth to lose Jacksonville's lead, and the Shrimp lost 6-3.

**BARONS START:** Neidert earned his second straight victory as he defeated the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field on Monday June 4. Neidert worked seven innings, allowing one run on three hits with four walks and eight strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-2, and his final five innings were scoreless.

**2018 S.L. ALL-STAR:** Neidert was one of seven Jumbo Shrimp and four Jacksonville pitchers to be named a 2018 Southern League Midseason All-Star, and manager Randy Ready expects him to pitch one inning for the South Division All-Stars at the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game on Tuesday June 19 at Birmingham's Regions Field.

**LAST GENERALS START:** Neidert had a no decision in his first start of 2018 on Friday April 6 against the Jackson Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. Neidert worked three and two-thirds innings, allowing four runs (three earned) on eight hits with three walks and four strikeouts. Neidert also helped his own cause at the plate, hitting an RBI single in his first professional at-bat. Neidert left the game with Jacksonville tied with Jackson 4-4, and the Jumbo Shrimp went on to lose the game 14-6.

**DENBO ON NEIDERT:** "He's another starting pitcher candidate for us," Marlins vice president of player development and scouting Gary Denbo said. "We believe he will have a chance in the future to join our starting rotation. He's only 21 years old. He has the ability to command his fastball," Denbo said. "His changeup is plus. We like the movement he has on the fastball because it's different than what you normally see. He's got deception, which makes it very difficult for batters to pick up the ball, and he's a good athlete. There's a lot of qualities there that make us believe he will help us in our starting rotation in Miami."

**PROSPECT:** Neidert enters the 2018 season as the Marlins No. 5 prospect according to Baseball America and the No. 8 prospect according to MLB.com.

## #23 NICK NEIDERT RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: Nov. 20, 1996 in Atlanta, Ga. 21 Years Old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners with RHP Robert Duggar, INF Chris Torres in exchange for Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Named the California League Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 19 starts for Single-A Modesto in Seattle's system. Was a California League Midseason and Postseason All-Star, going 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 14 starts before the break, then 5-0 with a 1.45 ERA in five starts after the break. Earned California League Pitcher of the Week honors for July 3-9 after tossing seven shutout innings on July 6 at Visalia. Finished the season at Double-A Arkansas, making Travelers debut on July 22. With Arkansas he was 1-3 with a 6.56 ERA in six starts. Lost first three starts for Arkansas, snapped skid with a win in his fifth start on August 12 against Midland.

**2016 Highlights:** Spent all of 2016 with Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League, going 7-3 with a 2.57 ERA in 19 starts. Went 6-1 with a 2.22 ERA over his first eight starts. Factored in just three decisions (1-2) over final 11 starts, despite allowing one-or-zero runs in eight of those outings. Won four consecutive starts from June 15-July 3, posting 2.67 ERA during that span, setting a career high with 12 strikeouts on June 23 vs. Kane County, and also had 11 on July 3 at Peoria.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the second round of the 2015 draft, made 11 starts for the AZL Mariners, going 0-2 with a 1.53 ERA. There he held opponents scoreless in six of 11 starts.

**Personal:** Attended Peachtree Ridge High School in Suwanee, Georgia. Selected as a First Team All-American and Southeastern All-Region First Team by Perfect Game in 2015. Had signed to pitch at the University of South Carolina before signing with Mariners.
