Giants Begin Three-Game Series In Stockton... The San Jose Giants open a three-game series against the Stockton Ports this evening at Banner Island Ballpark. Logan Webb (1-2, 2.35 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

Homestand Review... The Giants posted a 3-4 record on their seven-game homestand that concluded yesterday afternoon. San Jose split four games with Lancaster to open the homestand before dropping two out of three to Modesto – their first home series loss of the season. The Giants hit .241 as a team and had a 3.52 ERA during the homestand.

Road Trip... Tonight marks the beginning of a nine-game road trip for the Giants. Following the current series against Stockton and an off day on Monday, San Jose will play a three-game set in Modesto before concluding the trip with three games in Lake Elsinore. It's the Giants' longest road trip of the season. San Jose is 10-9 on the road this season. The Giants have won five out of their last seven road games.

Team Stats... The Giants are second in the California League in team batting average (.268) and second in ERA (3.60). San Jose is third in the league in runs scored (5.1 runs per game) and third in home runs (32). On the mound, the Giants have allowed the fewest home runs in the league (17), but have issued the most walks (166, 4.0 per game). San Jose's 53 errors this year are also third-most in the league.

Inside The Season Series... The Giants won three out of four games against Stockton from April 12-15 at Municipal Stadium in the only previous meeting between the teams this season. San Jose won the final two games of the series on walk-off home runs in extra innings (Jalen Miller on April 14, Gio Brusa on April 15). It marked the Giants' first back-to-back walk-off extra-inning wins since 2004. 10 out of San Jose's final 29 games of the first half will be played against Stockton. The Giants (23-18) are currently two games behind the first-place Ports (25-16) in the first half North Division race.

Pitcher Of The Week... DJ Myers was named California League Pitcher of the Week on Monday – San Jose's first weekly award this season. In two relief appearances last week, Myers pitched 11 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, one walk and 14 strikeouts (1-0 record).

Holding Leads / Late Comebacks... The Giants are a perfect 17-0 this season when leading after seven innings. Only San Jose and Lake Elsinore are unbeaten this year when holding a lead after the seventh. Conversely, the Giants have won a league-high four games this season when trailing after seven innings.

Franco Doubles... Wander Franco leads the California League with 16 doubles this season. He's hit 12 doubles over his last 17 games. Franco's .312 batting average ranks tenth in the league.

Cycle x2... April 11 was an historic night for the San Jose Giants as both Gio Brusa and Jalen Miller hit for the cycle in an 18-6 victory at Lancaster. Brusa (4-for-6, 2B, 3B, HR, 6 RBI) completed his cycle with a triple in the top of the eighth. Miller (5-for-7, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), who tied a Giants single-game team record with five hits, tripled in the ninth inning for San Jose's second cycle of the night. The duo became the fourth and fifth players in the 31-year history of the San Jose Giants to hit for the cycle. Prior to Brusa and Miller, the last SJ Giant to hit for the cycle was Thomas Neal on April 28, 2009 at Lancaster.

* Is in his fifth professional season ... Selected by the San Francisco Giants in the fourth round of the 2014 draft (118th overall pick).

* Scheduled to make his eighth start and ninth overall appearance of the season in this evening's game ... Has pitched 23 innings this year and allowed just six earned runs (2.35 ERA) ... Walked 12 and struck out 21 ... Has yet to pitch more than four innings in an outing ... Has pitched past the third inning only once in seven starts ... Will be facing Stockton for the first time.

* Most recent start came on May 13 against Lancaster ... Threw three scoreless innings with no hits allowed ... Walked one and struck out four ... Retired nine out of the ten batters he faced ... Threw 37 pitches.

* Pitched a season-high four innings on May 2 against Visalia ... Allowed just one unearned run and two hits ... Threw a season-high 64 pitches.

* Has allowed one or no earned runs in six out of his seven starts.

* Owns a .247 opponents batting average (.222 vs. left, .264 vs. right) ... Has limited the opposition to a .133 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs (2-for-15) ... Has yet to give up a home run this season.

* Prior to this season, hasn't made a start since May 31, 2016 (with Class-A Augusta).

* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching out of the bullpen for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Made 15 relief appearances for the Volcanoes and was 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA ... Struck out 31 and walked seven over 28 innings.

* Had a 2.47-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio last season – the highest groundout rate on the Salem-Keizer staff ... Limited right-handed hitters to a .174 batting average (12-for-69, 26 SO) compared to a .359 batting average against left-handed hitters (14-for-39).

* Made his 2017 season debut on June 15 – over 12 months since his last game action.

* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2016 before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his right elbow in June ... Was 2-3 with a 6.21 ERA in nine starts for the GreenJackets.

* Worked as a starting pitcher for Salem-Keizer in 2015 (14 GS, 3-6, 4.92 ERA) ... Began his professional career with the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2014.

* Drafted by the SF Giants out of Rocklin High School (Rocklin, CA) ... Posted a 0.49 ERA over 57 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 to earn Sierra Foothill League MVP honors ... Was also a quarterback on the football team in three varsity seasons.

* Had committed to play college baseball at Cal Poly prior to signing with the Giants.
