Last Game: Pensacola Blue Wahoos left-hander Seth Varner and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Nick Neidert dueled for seven innings, and Pensacola catcher Chris Okey hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the seventh to spark his team's late rally to an 11-3 win in the opener of a five-game series at Blue Wahoos Stadium Wednesday night. The Jumbo Shrimp (10-16 second half, 38-56 overall) took the lead when third baseman Brian Schales hit the first pitch by Varner (5-1) in the top of third inning for a home run to left-center field. Pensacola (17-8, 47-46) tied the game in the bottom of the third inning, as center fielder Jose Siri hit a two-out solo home run to left-center field off Neidert (8-6). The Blue Wahoos took the lead in the bottom of the fourth inning, when Neidert walked third baseman Mitch Nay before striking out two batters, and right fielder Aristides Aquino hit a two-out, go-ahead RBI double to left-center field. With Pensacola leading, 2-1, in the top of the fifth inning, Schales hit a one-out single to right field, and catcher Rodrigo Vigil singled to left field. Neidert put down a sacrifice to advance both runners, and left fielder Brian Miller hit a ground ball that Pensacola shortstop Luis Gonzalez dropped, allowing the tying run to score. Center fielder Monte Harrison then lined a go-ahead RBI single to left-center field. Varner faced the minimum for the rest of his outing, lasting a season-long seven innings and allowing three runs – one earned – on six hits and one walk with four strikeouts. Neidert held the 3-2 lead until the seventh inning, when Aquino walked, and Okey homered to center field, giving Pensacola a 4-3 lead. Neidert allowed four earned runs on eight hits and two walks with six strikeouts in seven innings. Pensacola widened its lead with seven runs in the bottom of the eighth inning against Jacksonville right-hander Kyle Keller. Left fielder TJ Friedl and Nay singled, and second baseman Shed Long hit an RBI double. Shortstop Luis Gonzalez added a two-run single, pinch hitter Narciso Crook hit a sacrifice fly, and Siri hit a three-run home run to make it 11-3.

NEWS AND NOTES

Roster Moves: Second baseman Isan Diaz has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Diaz played in 83 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .245 with 10 home runs and 42 RBI. He is the reigning Southern League Player of the Week for July 9-15, an honor he also earned from June 4-10. Diaz is regarded by MLB.com as the Marlins No. 7 prospect, and this is the first call-up to the Triple-A level in his career. In a corresponding move, infielder Justin Twine has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Twine played in 70 games for the Hammerheads, hitting .235 with three home runs and 31 RBI. This is the first call-up to the Double-A level in Twine's career, and he was originally selected by the Marlins in the second round (No. 43 overall) in the 2014 draft out of Falls City High School in Falls City, Texas.

Hoosville Time: This is the third of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and Blue Wahoos, and this is Jacksonville's first trip to Pensacola in 2018. In the first half, the Jumbo Shrimp went 6-2 and won both series against the Wahoos in April and late May, early June. The last series featured two games cancelled due to rain on June 2. The Jumbo Shrimp will make a return trip to Pensacola from August 14-18. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, including a 2-8 mark at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Pensacola also swept Jacksonville in this park in the 2018 South Division Championship Series.

Shrimp Homering to the Top: Jumbo Shrimp sluggers Monte Harrison and Peter O'Brien are tied for the Marlins organizational lead with 12 home runs in the 2018 season. The Jacksonville pair are even with High-A Jupiter's John Silviano who also has 12 home runs to lead the organization. Isan Diaz is now tied for fourth in the organization with Triple-A New Orleans' Jonathan Rodriguez, also with 10 home runs.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have nine players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), OF Brian Miller (10), Merandy Gonzalez (13), Joe Dunand (16), Jordan Yamamoto (19) Robert Dugger (22) and John Norwood (30).

LAST START: Duval took a loss in his start on Friday July 13 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds. Duval worked five and two-third innings where he allowed seven runs on eight hits with a walk, three strikeouts, and he allowed a season-high four home runs as Jacksonville lost 8-6.

BAYBEARS START: Duval took a loss in his start on Wednesday July 4 against the Mobile BayBears at Hank Aaron Stadium. Duval worked a season-high seven innings, allowing three runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts. Duval allowed all three runs in the bottom of the second, then turned his last five innings in scoreless fashion as Jacksonville lost to the BayBears 3-1.

BACK AND FORTH: Duval continues to shift back and forth between the starting rotation and the bullpen. Duval recently was in Jacksonville's bullpen, going 0-2 with a 15.95 ERA in his four relief outings. Duval's first eight outings this season were starts in Jacksonville's rotation, going 1-5 with a 6.42 ERA, striking out 38 batters in his 40 and two-thirds innings of work. Jacksonville was 2-6 in those starts. Overall as a starter Duval is 2-6 with a 5.56 ERA in his 11 starts.

MINOR LEAGUE CAMPING PROJECT: During this past offseason, Duval lived in an RV given to him by his mom to use as a home, he was trying to avoid signing a lease for the offseason. Duval lived in the RV with his friend and trainer Kevin Mixon, with the 29-foot motorhome parked just outside of Salinas, California and near their training facility. The RV did not have a shower or toilet, but found ways to make it doable. Duval detailed his offseason in the RV with a blog "The Minor League Offseason Camping Project" which can be found online at minorleaguecampingproject.wordpress.com, and he has continued blogging into the 2018 season, giving insights on his experience as a Jumbo Shrimp pitcher.

#43 MAX DUVAL RHP | 6-5, 235 lbs | Born: April. 15, 1991 in San Luis Obispo, California. 27 years old.

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 28, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League. With Evansville, Duval went 8-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 14 starts, striking out 113 batters in 87 innings of work and he won the 2017 Frontier League Brian Tollberg Award for Most Valuable Pitcher, and he was also a Frontier League All-Star. After he signed with the Marlins on July 28, he went 4-0 with a 2.09 ERA in six starts for the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. Came within two outs of a seven inning perfect game on August 9, 2017. He retired the first 19 batters he faced before ultimately allowing a run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a complete game win.

2016 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League, where he was 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA in seven starts. Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on June 23, 2016. Pitched at four different levels of the Diamondbacks organization, making one relief outing with High-A Visalia where he was 1-0 with a 9.64 ERA, going 2-6 with a 3.02 ERA in 10 starts for the Single-A Kane County Cougars, then with Short Season Class A Hillsboro had no wins or losses and a 7.36 ERA in two appearances and one start, then also two appearances and a start for the AZL Diamondbacks, going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in two appearances and one start. All of his moving around different affiliates mainly happened in a 14-day span in late June and early July.

2015 Highlights: Split the season pitching in the Frontier League, making four appearances with the Schaumburg Boomers where he had no wins or losses and a 13.50 ERA. He also pitched for the Frontier Greys, where he was 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts. The Greys were a team that played strictly road games in the Frontier League, hence the name Greys after the traditional road jersey color.

2014 Highlights: Duval made his professional baseball debut pitching for the Schaumburg Boomers in the independent Frontier League, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA in three relief outings.

College: Started college career at Cuesta College before transferring to Hawaii for his junior season. At Hawaii in 2012 he hit .186 with one home run and 18 RBI as an infielder. At the plate in 2013, Duval hit .192 with no homers and 3 RBI. He also pitched that season, with no wins or losses and a 6.48 ERA in six games in relief. After college considered quitting baseball but mom encouraged him to keep playing, which landed him in independent baseball to give pitching a real chance.

Duval lived in the RV with his friend and trainer Kevin Mixon, with the 29-foot motorhome parked just outside of Salinas, California and near their training facility.
