LAST TIME OUT: The Tarpons broke a late 3-3 tie with a run in the 8th and went on to win, 4-3, to claim the series in Kissimmee on Wednesday night at Osceola County Stadium...After a leadoff double by **Pablo Olivares** (2-for-4, 2B, 2R), Tampa got four-straight two-out singles by **Alexander Palma** (1-for-3, BB, RBI, R) , **Diego Castillo** (1-for-4, R), **Wilkerman Garcia** (1-for-4, RBI) and **Steven Sensley** (1-for-4, RBI), jumping out to a 3-0 lead in the 1st...Florida later tied the score with a run in the 2nd and two more in the 4th off **RHP Miguel Yajure** (6.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 1BB, 3K, WP, 90P/62S)...Olivares used his speed to give Tampa back the lead in the 8th, hitting a leadoff single, stealing 2B and stealing 3B before scoring on an errant throw...**RHP Jefry Valdez** (W, 1-3) retired nine-of-10 batters faced over a scoreless 3.0IP (1H, 3K) to earn the win in relief.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: After winning the first two games in Kissimmee, the Tarpons will send **RHP Frank Germán** (4-4, 3.78) to the bump this afternoon to try and complete a three-game sweep. In three starts against the Florida this season, Germán is 3-0 with a 1.10 ERA (16.1IP, 15H, 3R/2ER, 7BB, 22K). Tampa has won 12-of-14 games against the Fire Frogs this season with a run differential of +24 runs.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Tampa Tarpons (31-28) have 13 games remaining in the regular season and are currently in 2nd place in the Florida State League North Division 2nd-Half Standings, trailing the 1st-place Dunedin Blue Jays (34-27) by 2.0G. Dunedin won the 1st-Half Title, securing the first of two North Division playoff spots. Should the Blue Jays also win the 2nd-Half Title, the second playoff spot would then go to the next best overall record in the division. Clearwater (63-65) currently leads that race, with Tampa (59-66) 2.5GB.

HOT HITTERS: **Diego Castillo** (1-for-4, R) is batting .338 (23-for-68) with 9R, 2HR and 12RBI during his current 18-game on-base streak... **Donny Sands** is currently on an 11-game hitting streak and, over his last 15-games, is batting .333 (17-for-51)... **Alexander Palma** (1-for-3, BB, RBI, R) has 4HR over his last 12 games, batting .256 (11-for-43) with 7R and 11RBI in that span.

HIP, HIP, (YA)JURE! On Wednesday, **RHP Miguel Yajure** logged his 12th quality start, holding the Fire Frogs to 3ER in 6.0IP (6H, 1BB, 3K, WP, 90P/62S). The 21-year-old has allowed only 14ER in 77.2IP (1.62ERA) over his last 13 outings. Among qualified pitchers in the Florida State League, Yajure ranks tied for 1st in SO (122) and 2nd in IP (127.2), ERA (2.26) and WHIP (1.08). The Cabimas, Venezuela native has 14 starts of at least 6.0IP, including six of at least 7.0IP.

SCHMIDT PROMOTED: On Thursday, **RHP Clarke Schmidt** was promoted to Double-A Trenton. The 23-year-old made 13 appearances (12 starts) with Tampa this season, going 4-5 with a 3.84 ERA (63.1IP, 59H, 35R/27ER, 24BB, 69K, 2HR, 4HB). On 8/5 at Lakeland, Schmidt logged his best-career outing, matching a career-high with 9Ks over a scoreless 7.0IP (3H, 3BB, 105P/63S) to earn the win vs. the Flying Tigers.

BABY BOMBERS: The Tarpons currently rank tied for second in the league with 89 home runs, trailing only Bradenton (97). 21 different Tarpons have contributed to the total, led by **Dermis Garcia** (17HR).

RACKING UP THE Ks: Tarpons' pitchers tallied a season-high 18 strikeouts in the series-opener at Florida. Entering today, Tampa's pitching staff ranks third in the Florida State League with 1,108 strikeouts., trailing Fort Myers (1,114) and Clearwater (1,111).

STEINBRENNER FIELD REHAB CENTER: Yankees **RHP Ben Heller** ("Tommy John" surgery) joined Tampa on 6/23, becoming the seventh player to rehab with the Tarpons this season. **LHP CC Sabathia** made a rehab start on 4/7, recovering from offseason heart surgery. **3B Miguel Andújar** (right shoulder strain) and **SS Troy Tulowitzki** (strained left calf) joined the Tarpons on 4/30, and **OF Aaron Hicks** (left lower back strain) on 5/6. **OF/DH Giancarlo Stanton** (left biceps strain) played a game with the Tarpons on 5/20 and rejoined on 6/11. **SS Didi Gregorius** ("Tommy John" surgery) joined Tampa on 5/25. Fun Fact: Andújar, Tulowitzki, Stanton and Gregorius have all homered with the Tarpons this season.
