## LYNCHBURG HILLCATS (27-32) VS. FREDERICK KEYS (27-33)

Games 60 & 61 - Tuesday, June 11, 2018 - 5 p.m. - Nymeo Field

Game One: LHP Tanner Tully (2-6, 5.61) vs. RHP Michael Baumann (3-0, 1.88)

**LAST GAME:** The Hillcats were shutout on Monday, falling to the Frederick Keys, 1-0. The game was a scoreless tie heading to extra innings, and Keys infielder Chris Clare won the game with a walk-off single in the tenth. **Sam Hentges** logged a career-high 6.2 innings and did not allow a run while striking out six. Frederick starter Alex Wells went eight scoreless innings and struck out a career-high eight batters. He threw just 85 pitches. Jared Robinson was hit with the loss, allowing the unearned run in extra-innings. Prior to the tenth inning, not one baserunner had reached second base on either team. Lynchburg fell to 1-3 in extra-inning contests this year.

**STAR STUDDED:** Three Lynchburg Hillcats were named to the North Division All-Star team, the league announced Monday. **Conner Capel**, and **Sam Hentges** received the recognition for the first time in their careers, while **Dalbert Siri** was named an All-Star for the second time. Capel's .814 OPS ranks second-best in the entire Cleveland farm system, while Siri has allowed just two earned runs over his last 14 innings. Hentges who was named the team's opening day starter, leads the team with 55 strikeouts, including a career-high 10 punch outs against the Keys on April 17.

**ROAD WOES:** The Hillcats have struggled on the road this year with a 12-18 record, and have dropped the opening game of a road series in all but one of their overnight trips. Lynchburg is 2-3 at Nymeo Field this season. The Hillcats are 4-0 on the road against the Salem Red Sox, but just 8-19 against all other Carolina League opponents away from City Stadium.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Hillcats will play two more double-headers in the first half, against the Keys on back-to-back days today and tomorrow. It ends a string of three double-headers in eight days for Lynchburg, although it was supposed to be four. Saturday's Game Two of a twin bill against Potomac was canceled due to rain.

**SIRI-OUSLY?:** Dalbert Siri has been a key piece at the back end of the bullpen this season for Lynchburg. Siri, signed by the Indians as an international free agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2014, has gone 1-2 with a 2.29 ERA in 16 outings out of the Hillcats bullpen. The 22-year-old right-hander has also notched two saves, and is averaging over one strikeout-per-inning with 28 punch outs in 19.2 frames. Dating back to April 25, Siri has allowed just two earned runs over 14 innings of work, good for a 1.29 ERA.

**DILLON DOING WORK:** Hillcats infielder **Dillon Persinger** has been on a roll offensively. The 22-year-old has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 games (reached base in 15 straight, May 10-June 7), and is batting .347 (24-for-69) during that span, and has raised his batting average 60 points. Persinger is the second Hillcats hitter to reach base in 15 consecutive games, joining **Mitch Longo** (26). The Fountain Valley, Calif. native has played both shortstop and second base for Lynchburg this season, and has seen consistent playing time after beginning the season in Single-A Lake County.

**SCORING FIRST IS KEY:** One major point of emphasis this season for Lynchburg has been to score the first run of the ballgame. When the Hillcats plate the first run, they are 21-12. When the opponent scores first, Lynchburg is just 6-20 this season.

**ROLLER COASTER RIDE:** The Hillcats have enjoyed high peaks and suffered through low valleys throughout the season. They won 8 of 10 games April 16-26, hitting .262 and posting an ERA of 3.07. They followed it up however by losing 9 of their next 11 games from April 27-May, hitting .205 with a 5.59 ERA. Lynchburg would then win 8 of their next 9 from May 9-20, hitting .340 as a team with 6 home runs. Most recently, the Hillcats have dropped 9 of 12 after being swept in the previous series against Wilmington and dropping two of three to the Nationals.

**WAKA WARMING UP:** Hillcats SS **Luke Wakamatsu** is starting to heat up offensively. The switch-hitter is batting .296 (24-for-81) over his last 23 games. He has six extra-base hits and has eight RBI during that span, including his first home run of the season on May 22 in Myrtle Beach. On May 8, Wakamatsu's batting average was .162, and he has since raised that to .209 (47 points). He has also hit safely in 16 of his past 23 games, and had a go-ahead double in Saturday's win against the P-Nats.

**JAMES CHAK-ING OUT:** James Karinchak has been nearly perfect since being called up to the Hillcats on May 3. The Right-hander has tossed 12.0 innings without allowing a run. He has struck out 21, while allowing just 14 base runners. Combined with his time in Lake County this season, Karinchak has recorded 41 strikeouts in 23.1 innings, while opponents are hitting just .188 against him. A 9th round pick out of Bryant in 2017, Karinchak boasts an ERA of 0.39. The right-hander was a starting pitcher in college and for half of his first pro season last year, but has made the transition to the bullpen.

**TOP-30 IN LYNCHBURG:** **Conner Capel** (No. 12), **Sam Hentges** (No. 17), **Logan Ice** (No. 21), **Mitch Longo** (No. 27) and **Eli Morgan** (No. 28) are all Hillcats players that are ranked on the Indians Top-30 prospect list. Capel, an outfielder, batted .246 with 22 HR and 61 RBI in 119 games for the Single-A Lake County Captains last season. Hentges, a left-hander, missed the majority of last season while he was rehabbing from Tommy John surgery. He appeared in 11 total games (all starts) and went 0-4 with a 3.23 ERA between the AZL Indians and short-season Mahoning Valley. Hentges struck out 41 in 30.2 IP. Ice, a catcher, spent last season with Lake County and hit .228 with 11 HR and 42 RBI in 93 games. Longo, an outfielder, battled injuries last season and appeared in just 60 games. While he was healthy, he hit a combined .376 with 4 HR and 28 RBI between Lake County and Lynchburg. Morgan spent all of last season with Short-Season Mahoning Valley. He appeared in 13 games (8 starts) and sported a 3-2 record with a 1.03 ERA over 35 innings. He walked just nine and struck out 58. He played his college ball at Gonzaga and was drafted in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB draft.

## HILLCATS COACHING STAFF

**Rougie Odor**  
 Manager (1st Season)  
 Career Record: 238-260

Odor is entering his 18th year coaching in the Indians organization. He played in the minor leagues for the Indians & Brewers from 1988-1995. Odor brings a decade of skipper experience to Lynchburg. He led San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons from 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-2004, the Mahoning Valley Scappers for two years from 2005-2006 and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two campaigns from 2007-2008. He spent the past three seasons as the hitting coach for the Columbus Clippers, Cleveland's Triple-A affiliate.

**Tony Arnold**  
 Pitching Coach (2nd season)  
 26th overall

Arnold returns to Lynchburg after serving as the pitching coach for the Hillcats in 2015. The former right-handed pitcher played collegiately at the University of Texas and was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 10th round in the 1981 MLB Draft. The El Paso, Texas native played in parts of two MLB with the Orioles in 1986 and 1987. Arnold has coached in the Indians organization since 1992 and most recently was the pitching coach of the Akron Rubber-Ducks, Cleveland's Double-A affiliate, for the past two seasons.

**Justin Toole**  
 Hitting Coach (1st season)  
 3rd overall

2018 marks Toole's first year on Lynchburg's coaching staff and third in the Indians organization. The former infielder played in parts of seven minor league seasons with Cleveland from 2009-2015, reaching Triple-A Columbus. The Council Bluffs, Iowa native worked as the hitting coach last year for Single-A Lake County.

**Grant Fink**  
 Bench Coach (1st season)  
 2nd overall

Fink joins the Hillcats as bench coach for the first time in 2018, entering his second season as a coach in the Indians organization. The former infielder was drafted by Cleveland in the 23rd round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Missouri Western State University. A native of St. Joseph, Mo., Fink played in parts of three minor league seasons for the Indians from 2013-2015, reaching Single-A Lake County. Fink was the bench coach last season for Short-Season Mahoning Valley.

**Bobby Ruiz**  
 Athletic Trainer (4th season)  
 5th overall  
 Ruiz is in his eighth season in the Indians organization. He graduated from the University of La Verne in 2008. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer for the Huskies baseball team, while earning his Master's degree

**Eric Oretego**  
 Strength Coach (1st season)  
 2nd overall  
 Oretego is in his second season in the Indians Organization. He graduated from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in 2012. Following graduation, Oretego served as the Assistant Director of Strength and Conditioning at McNeese State.
