TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes take on the Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics affiliate) tonight in the first game of a three-game series. Tonight is Team Card Giveaway and Kids-Eat-Free Sunrun Sunday! 1,500 fans through the gates will score a free set of Quakes Baseball Cards. It's also a Kids-Eat-Free Sunrun Sunday, where kids 12 and under will get a voucher for a free hot dog, soda and bag of chips! Prior to the home stand, Rancho started a seven-game road trip by winning two-of-three in San Jose last week before dropping three-of-four in Inland Empire. After taking three-of-four from San Jose to start the home stand, it concludes with this three-game set with Stockton.

VS STOCKTON: The Ports have dominated the season series between the two this season. Stockton took three-of-four to begin the season at home and three-of-four in their one trip to Rancho from May 26th through May 29th, to total a 6-2 lead. Tonight's game will be the ninth of 14 meetings for the Quakes and the Ports.

RANCHO DROPS SERIES FINALE TO GIANTS: Rancho's rally came up just short last night in a 7-5 loss to the San Jose Giants. Trailing 3-1 in the fourth, Ibandel Isabel launched his 19th home run of the season to tie teammate DJ Peters for the most in the Cal League. The solo shot put the Quakes behind by one and they took the lead on a Johan Mieses two-run double in the fifth inning. The bullpen could not hold the lead late as the Giants scored the go-ahead run in the eighth inning. Rancho made it close by scoring a run in the ninth and bringing the potential go-ahead run to the plate, but they could not complete the comeback. Tony Gonsolin (3-3) was handed the loss in relief, but Yadier Alvarez was not sharp in his start. He allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits over four innings in a no-decision. Entering the game, the Quakes were going for a four-game sweep, but could not complete their second four-game sweep of the second half.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: On Friday, catcher Brant Whiting was transferred from Double-A Tulsa to Rancho Cucamonga and catcher Garrett Hope (.375 with a home run and two RBIs in two games with the Quakes earlier this season) was transferred to Short-Season Ogden from Rancho. On Thursday, catcher Garrett Kennedy (.264 with four home runs and 14 RBIs in 36 games with Rancho this season) was transferred to Double-A Tulsa from Rancho Cucamonga and Hope was added to the Quakes' roster. RHP Yadier Alvarez was also taken off the Temporary Inactive List and RHP Isaac Anderson was placed on the DL.

OFFENSE STARTING TO HEAT UP IN JULY: Throughout the season, it has been the Quakes' pitching staff that has carried the offense, but in July, Rancho has seen the roles reversed. This month, Rancho is hitting .285 (the highest of any month this season) while the pitching staff has a 4.60 ERA (also the highest out of any month this season for the Quakes). The Quakes do still lead the league in home runs with 106 and nothing has changed in that regard this month. Rancho has the most home runs in July out of any Cal League team with 21 in 14 games. DJ Peters and Ibandel Isabel pace the league with 19 home runs.

GOOD IMPRESSION, YOUNG MAN: In his first taste of Cal League action, Quakes' catcher Keibert Ruiz is impressing. After going 2-for-4 two nights ago with his first home run as a Quake, he is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with a double, a triple and a home run in four games. Between his last six games in Great Lakes and first four in Rancho, the 18-year-old Ruiz has hit safely in nine out of his last 10 games. After a day-off yesterday,

RALEY STAYS HOT: Luke Raley extended his hitting streak to 15 games with a 2-for-4 night yesterday. During the streak, he is hitting .381 (24-for-63) with three doubles, three triples, two home runs, 13 RBIs and 17 runs. The hitting streak is the longest by a Quake this season (Peters hit in 14 consecutive games from June 25th to July 9th).

FERGUSON TO TAKE THE HILL FOR THE QUAKES: All-Star Caleb Ferguson will make the start in game one for the Quakes. In his last start, Ferguson went five innings against Inland Empire on July 10th, giving up three runs (two earned) on three hits while striking out nine and walking three. Ferguson, who was Rancho's opening day starter, is making his 17th start on the year. Ferguson, a 38th-round draft pick of the Dodgers in 2014 out of high school in West Jefferson, OH, spent most of last season with Great Lakes. He made 10 out of his 12 starts in 2016 there, going 1-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 50 and a third innings for the Loons.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Kyle Friedrichs will make his fourth start of the season for the Ports today. Friedrichs started the season in Double-A Midland, but struggled, going 1-4 with a 6.00 ERA in 18 games. In his last start for Stockton, he allowed three runs in four innings against Lancaster on July 10th. The San Diego, CA native was drafted by the A's in the seventh round of the 2015 draft out of Long Beach State. At LBSU, he went 6-4 in 15 starts as a senior with a 2.79 ERA. His junior season, he worked out of the bullpen, going 2-1 with a 4.10 ERA in 23 outings.
