



Grand Junction Rockies **Media Regulations**

Credential Requests

Season and single-game credentials must be requested through the Grand Junction Rockies Media Relations Department by emailing jarah@gjrockies.com or by calling 970-255-7625 at least 48 hours prior to the date your outlet is planning to attend. Only legitimate news-gathering outlets, at the discretion of the Grand Junction Rockies, will receive credentials. Season credentials are only issued to media whose coverage of the Grand Junction Rockies included publishing and producing at least four pieces of content a month. If the media outlet has not been given credentials in previous seasons, the outlet must provide a link to original content that is similar to the intended coverage. All credentials are non-transferable and should be visible at all times. Credentials will not be issued to anyone under 18 years of age. Credentials are issued to working members of the press. No spouses, guests, or children of press members will be issued passes and are not allowed in the press box. The Grand Junction Rockies reserve the right to revoke credentials at any time. Anyone seeking autographs, player memorabilia, etc. will have their credentials revoked immediately.

Suplizio Field

Media members may use the south entrance of Suplizio Field and park in the south parking lot. Due to limited parking, no media members will be allowed to park in either parking lot on the north side of the stadium. You must present a Grand Junction Rockies media credential to gain access to the ballpark and press box. Single-game credentials will be available for pick up at the ticket office at the south entrance of the park. The outfield bleachers are closed to both media and the public for the duration of the season. Those seats are not used for Grand Junction Rockies games. Anyone in the bleachers is considered trespassing and will have their credentials revoked.

Clubhouse Access

Media members are not allowed in either clubhouse at any time. Both clubhouses are to be considered closed unless prior arrangements have been made.

Field Access

Access to the field will be granted to photographers with Grand Junction Rockies media credentials. Media members wishing to conduct post-game interviews will be allowed on the field but must wait until a Grand Junction Rockies staff member is there to help facilitate those interviews before going onto the field. Please report to the home plate gate for post-game interviews.

Interviews

Any interviews outside of the pre-game media session or post-game interviews, must be scheduled through the Grand Junction Rockies media relations staff. At no time will starting pitchers be made available for interviews on days they are starting.

Rehab Assignments

Players on minor league rehab assignments for the Colorado Rockies will be made available to the media when possible with their schedule. All interview requests with rehabbing players must be authorized by a member of the Grand Junction Rockies media relations staff.

Photographers/Videographers

Due to limited space on the field, all photographers and videographers must make arrangements with the Grand Junction Rockies media relations staff if they wish to shoot on the field.

Press Box

Limited space in the Suplizio Field press box is available for working media only. This is a work environment so please treat it as such. No guests, spouses, or children will be issued credentials and are not allowed in the press box. Individuals who violate press box rules will be removed and have their credentials revoked upon the discretion of the Grand Junction Rockies media relations staff.
