**TODAY'S GAME:** Game two of a three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets (NYM) from First Data Field (1-0)...Game five of a six-game road trip, with three against the Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET) and three against the Mets (3-1)...Clearwater is coming off a 2-1 series victory against the Flying Tigers at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...Second of four sets (16 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Philadelphia Phillies split the four-game series at Spectrum Field from June 10-13 to end the first half, alternating wins and losses...Clearwater finished 2018 with a 4-2 mark in Port St. Lucie.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** 20-year-old Kyle Glogoski makes his second start at the Advanced-A level on Saturday night in game two of the three-game series at First Data Field...The 6-foot-1 hurler earned his first win as a Clearwater Thresher in the combined no-hitter against the Daytona Tortugas on June 22...The right-hander walked two and struck out five across five frames on 64 pitches - 45 strikes...Saturday will be Glogoski's first career start against the New York Mets affiliate.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Clearwater Threshers used late offense to take down the St. Lucie Mets, 3-1, in 10 innings to start the three-game series at First Data Field on Friday night...Ethan Evanko tossed seven innings with just one run allowed in the no-decision...Clearwater scored all three runs in the ninth and 10th innings...Madison Stokes came up with the clutch two-out, two-run single with the bases loaded in the extra frame.

**FINDING WAYS:** Clearwater's offense had been averaging 6.5 runs/game through the first eight games of the second half, but managed only six tallies over the last three nights...Despite the lower output, the Threshers still trail only the Dunedin Blue Jays for the top spot in the Florida State League (348-330), and still hold the lead in batting average over the Blue Jays and Charlotte Stone Crabs (.253-.252)...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate also holds the league lead with a .384 slugging percentage thanks to 132 doubles, 20 triples and 55 home runs.

**BULLPEN BITES:** The Threshers' continued its dominance in the month of June with three more scoreless innings in the winning effort on Friday...Clearwater's relievers have been outstanding in the month of June, posting a record of 7-2 record with a 1.60 ERA (16er/90.0ip)...Relievers have struck out 111 batters during the third month of the season, while posting a season-low walk number of 33.

**WEEKLY ACCOLADE:** Jhailyn Ortiz was named the Florida State League Player of the Week for the week of June 17-23...The slugger hit .333 (9-27) with five home runs and 11 RBI, including his first career grand slam on June 20 against the Daytona Tortugas...The right-handed batter also drew five walks to give the 20-year-old an OBP of .455, while also posting a slugging percentage of .889 and OPS of 1.344.

**STRIKEOUT KINGS:** Ethan Evanko (2) and Oscar Marcelino (1) combined for just three strikeouts in the series-opening victory over the St. Lucie Mets on Friday night...Despite the minimal amount of strikeouts, Clearwater still leads the Florida State League with 762 punch outs - 66 more than the Fort Myers Miracle for the top-spot in the league.

**PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS:** The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzziotti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzziotti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee...The Threshers have added two more top-30 prospects since the start of the season, with Alec Bohm (1) and Jhailyn Ortiz (11) joining the club...Bohm was promoted to Double-A Reading on 6/21.
