Giants Conclude Series Against Modesto... The San Jose Giants play the rubber game of a three-game series against the Modesto Nuts this afternoon at Municipal Stadium. The Giants earned a 4-0 victory in the series opener on Friday before Modesto rallied for a 7-4 win yesterday. Logan Webb (1-2, 1.59 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound today.

Homestand Update... The Giants are currently in the midst of a season-high 10-game homestand. San Jose is 4-2 thus far on the homestand having taken three out of four from Visalia before splitting the first two games of the current series against Modesto. The Giants have fashioned a 2.21 ERA during the homestand, but are batting only .220 as a team.

Streak Ends... Modesto scored four runs in the top of the ninth inning last night to rally for a 7-4 victory over San Jose. The defeat snapped a streak of 78 consecutive wins for the Giants when leading after eight innings dating back to August 30, 2016. San Jose had been 21-0 this season when leading after eight innings after going 55-0 last year. The Giants were the only team in the league last season to own a perfect record when leading after eight.

First Half Race... Last night's loss dropped the Giants (30-26) to a season-high five games behind first-place Stockton (35-21) in the first half North Division race. 14 games remain in the first half. After today's contest, San Jose will play seven out of their next ten games against the Ports.

Muni Magic... At 17-11, the Giants boast the top home record in the California League. San Jose has lost only one home series this season (May 15-17 vs. Modesto). The Giants own six walk-off wins this year with the most recent coming on May 29 against Visalia (2-1 win in 11 innings). San Jose possesses a sparkling 2.84 team ERA at home this season (4.10 ERA on the road).

Familiar Foe... Today marks the 19th game of the season between San Jose and Modesto. The Giants are 9-9 against the Nuts overall (5-4 at Municipal Stadium, 4-5 at John Thurman Field). The teams are scheduled to play 22 games against each other in the first half (over a 49-game span from April 19-June 10). Today's San Jose starter Logan Webb is making his fifth start of the season against Modesto. Nuts starter Ljay Newsome will also be facing the Giants for a fifth time already in 2018.

Miller Surging... Jalen Miller is 8-for-21 (.381 AVG) at the plate during the homestand with two home runs and five RBI's (six games played). Miller smacked two home runs in the homestand opener on Monday against Visalia – the first multi-homer game of his career. He also delivered a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th inning on Tuesday. He currently ranks seventh in the California League in batting average (.310) and second in hits (65).

On The Mound... The Giants' team ERA of 3.45 ranks second in the California League (Visalia leads at 3.31). San Jose picked-up their sixth shutout of the season on Friday – one off the league lead (Inland Empire). The Giants have also allowed the fewest home runs in the league (26) this year. However, San Jose pitchers have issued the most walks of any staff in the league (220, 3.9 per game).

30 Wins... At 30-26 overall, the Giants have already equaled their first half win total from last season (30-40).

* Is in his fifth professional season ... Selected by the San Francisco Giants in the fourth round of the 2014 draft (118th overall pick).

* Scheduled to make his 11th start and 12th overall appearance of the season in this afternoon's game ... Has pitched 34 innings this year and allowed just six earned runs (1.59 ERA) ... Has yet to pitch more than four innings in an outing ... Has pitched past the third inning only three times in ten starts.

* Has not given up a run in his last four starts (14 IP, 5 H, 5 BB, 12 SO, .116 opponents batting average) ... Last run surrendered came during May 8 start at Modesto ... Has not allowed an earned run in eight out of his ten starts.

* Most recent start came on May 29 against Visalia ... Pitched four scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts ... Matched his longest start of the season ... Needed only 46 pitches to get through four innings ... Received a no-decision (Giants eventually won 2-1 in 11 innings).

* Today marks his fifth start against Modesto (0-1, 3.46 ERA) ... Most recent start versus the Nuts came on May 24 at John Thurman Field ... Fired four scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and two strikeouts ... Needed only 44 pitches to get through four innings ... Was tagged for a season-high four runs (all earned) on eight hits over three innings in his previous start against Modesto on May 8.

* Has thrown 14 innings at home this season and allowed just five hits and one unearned run (four starts).

* Has a 0.69 ERA (2 ER/26.0 IP) after the first inning ... Seven of the 12 runs he's allowed this season have come in the first inning.

* Owns a .220 opponents batting average (.204 vs. left, .232 vs. right) ... Has limited the opposition to a .118 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs (2-for-17) ... Has yet to give up a home run this season.

* Prior to this season, hadn't made a start since May 31, 2016 (with Class-A Augusta).

* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching out of the bullpen for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Made 15 relief appearances for the Volcanoes and was 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA ... Struck out 31 and walked seven over 28 innings ... Had a 2.47-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio last season – the highest groundout rate on the Salem-Keizer staff ... Made his 2017 season debut on June 15 – over 12 months since his last game action.

* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2016 before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his right elbow in June ... Was 2-3 with a 6.21 ERA in nine starts for the GreenJackets ... Worked as a starting pitcher for Salem-Keizer in 2015 (14 GS, 3-6, 4.92 ERA) ... Began his professional career with the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2014.

* Drafted by the SF Giants out of Rocklin High School (Rocklin, CA) ... Posted a 0.49 ERA over 57 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 to earn Sierra Foothill League MVP honors ... Was also a quarterback on the football team in three varsity seasons.

* Had committed to play college baseball at Cal Poly prior to signing with the Giants.

Current Hit Streak: 2 games

- * First baseman is in his third professional season ... Selected in the 6th round of the 2016 draft.
- * Hit for the cycle on April 11 at Lancaster joining teammate Jalen Miller in accomplishing the feat that night.
- * Was an outfielder in his first two seasons before transitioning to first base this year.

- * Tied for the team lead in home runs last year ... Was also second on the club in doubles.

- * Led the Northwest League with 10 home runs in '16 ... Hit .264 with 42 RBI's in 53 games ... Won All-Star home run derby.
