**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (8-4, 38-44) defeated the Montgomery Biscuits (5-7, 42-39) by a 10-1 score in the first game of the five-game series at Montgomery Riverwalk Stadium in front of 7,082 fans on Independence Day, Tuesday night. Jacksonville right-handed starting pitcher Trevor Richards (2-0) earned the victory, working six innings where he allowed a run on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Montgomery right-handed starter Benton Moss (1-3) took the loss, allowing eight runs on eight hits with three walks and two strikeouts. Jacksonville started the scoring early with a five run first inning. Marlins No. 4 prospect Brian Anderson homered, his second in as many days and third in the last six games, with a three-run shot to right field to put the Shrimp up 3-0. Later in the first, Cam Maron delivered a two-run double to grow the lead to 5-0. The Shrimp also had a big fifth inning against Moss. David Vidal crushed a three-run homer to left field to grow the lead to 8-0, and then former Biscuit Braxton Lee added an RBI single to put the score at 9-0. The Biscuits scored their lone run in the bottom of the fifth with Nathan Lukes collecting an RBI single to put the score at 9-1. Jacksonville added its final run in the ninth inning with Taylor Ard hitting an RBI double to grow the lead to 10-1, which would be the final. After Richards turned in his six strong innings, Andy Beltre worked two perfect innings and Daniel Schlereth got the final outs in the ninth to preserve the win. John Norwood made his return to the lineup after leaving Sunday's game with injury by going 3-for-5 at the plate.

### NEWS AND NOTES

**We're Hitting Homers:** The Jumbo Shrimp have homered in six of the past seven games. Brian Anderson has been leading the charge for the Jumbo Shrimp, homering in the past two games and in three of the past six contests. Anderson now leads the Jumbo Shrimp with 14 homers this year, which is now tied for second in the Southern League.

**Best Baseball Grounds Crowd in Nine Years:** A sellout crowd of 11,398 attended the Jumbo Shrimp's homestand finale Monday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville, marking the ballpark's largest single crowd since 11,481 on July 3, 2008. Coming one year after a sellout of 10,238 at the July 3, 2016, game, it is the first time in the ballpark's 15-year history that it has hosted consecutive Independence Day celebration sellouts. The three 10,000-plus crowds in the Jumbo Shrimp's inaugural season are the most for Jacksonville since the same number in 2008. In 2017, they are the three largest single-game crowds at any Southern League game this season, occurring Wednesday, April 12 (10,477); Friday, April 14 (10,023); and Monday, July 3 (11,398). In the first two seasons of Fast Forward Sports Group's ownership, Jacksonville has hosted four 10,000-plus crowds – more than the previous seven seasons combined. They are also the four largest crowds to attend any 2016 or 2017 Southern League game.

**Lee SL Player of the Week:** Jumbo Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp center fielder Braxton Lee has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for the week of June 26-July 2, announced by the league office Monday morning. Over this past week in six games, Lee has hit .571 (12-for-21) with a home run, six runs batted in, two doubles, a triple, and six runs scored. Four of the six games for Lee have been multi-hit contests, including four of his five games played with the Jumbo Shrimp. Last Monday Lee was a Southern Leaguer for the Montgomery Biscuits, however that afternoon he was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays organization to the Miami Marlins along with right-handed pitcher Ethan Clark (now with Single-A Greensboro) in exchange for Marlins shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria. Overall, Lee is hitting .332 which is the top batting average in the Southern League. Lee has also hit three homers and driven in 22 runs.

**Anderson, Guerrero to Futures Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp third baseman Brian Anderson and right-handed relief pitcher Tayron Guerrero have been selected to play in the 2017 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on Sunday July 9 at 4 p.m. at Marlins Park in Miami, Florida. Anderson will be a member of the U.S. Team, while Guerrero, a native of Bocachica, Colombia, will be a member of the World Team, and the two are the only representatives for the Marlins at the game in their home ballpark.

**LAST START:** Kickham had his second complete game in a seven-inning game on Friday June 30 against the Mobile BayBears. Kickham turned in all seven innings where he allowed a run on four hits with two walks with three strikeouts as Jacksonville won 2-1.

**GENERALS START:** Kickham suffered his first loss since April 25 when he fell on Saturday June 24 at Jackson. Kickham worked six innings where he allowed three runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 3-1.

**WAHOOS WIN:** Kickham worked his second straight scoreless start in a winning effort against Pensacola in Game Two of a Doubleheader on Friday June 16 at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham worked five scoreless innings allowing just four hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Jacksonville won 1-0, thanks to a Brian Anderson RBI triple.

**LAST BISCUITS START:** Kickham was dominant in a complete game shutout against the Montgomery Biscuits in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader against them on Thursday June 8 at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham went all seven innings in scoreless fashion, scattering four hits with no walks and three strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 1-0 thanks to a first inning solo homer by Brian Anderson.

**2017 SOUTHERN LEAGUE ALL-STAR:** Kickham was named to the Southern League South Division All-Star roster. Kickham is an All-Star along with fellow left-handed pitcher Matt Tomshaw, and third baseman Brian Anderson, and outfielder John Norwood.

**#34 MIKE KICKHAM RHP | 6-4, 220 lbs | Born: St. Louis, Mo. Age: 28**

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent in the offseason (date not given).

**2016 Highlights:** Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016. Kickham spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

**2015 Highlights:** Kickham split the 2015 season between the Seattle Mariners and Texas Rangers organizations, pitching exclusively in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. He started the year with Triple-A Tacoma, where he was 0-2 with a 7.29 ERA in five starts before he was designated for assignment by the Mariners on May 4. He then was claimed off waivers by the Texas Rangers a day later, and then pitched for Triple-A Round Rock where he was 1-0 with a 6.00 ERA in seven relief appearances before he was released on June 11.

**2014 Highlights:** Kickham spent most of 2014 with Triple-A Fresno where he was 8-8 with a 4.43 ERA in 27 starts in the Pacific Coast League. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series.

**2013 Highlights:** Kickham split the 2013 season between Triple-A Fresno and the major leagues with the Giants. With Fresno he was 7-7 with a 4.31 ERA in 20 starts. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts.

**2012 Highlights:** Kickham spent all of 2012 in Double-A with the Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he was 11-10 with a 3.05 ERA in 28 appearances and 27 starts.

**2011 Highlights:** Kickham spent all of 2011 with the Single-A Augusta Greenjackets in the South Atlantic League. There he was 5-10 with a 4.11 ERA in 21 starts.

**2010 Highlights:** After he was drafted by the Giants, he made three relief appearances with the AZL Giants where he had no wins or losses and an 11.57 ERA.

**Personal:** Originally selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2010 draft out of Missouri State. Kickham played for Missouri State in 2010. He struck out 103 batters in 96.0 innings and won MSU's Dave Dickensheet Outstanding Pitcher Award.
