TRENTON SINKS 'DOGS IN 10: Pinch-hitter **Trey Amburgey** hit a grand slam with one-out in the 10th inning, leading the Trenton Thunder to an 8-4 win in 10 innings on Saturday...Portland tied the game in the sixth inning on a two-run homer by **Jordan Betts** over the Maine Monster...**Caleb Frare** (3-1) worked two scoreless frames without allowing a hit to earn the win...**Jordan Weems** (1-1) suffered the loss, allowing four runs (three earned) over two innings pitched.

WELCOME TO MAINE: RHP **Matthew Gorst** made his Double-A debut on Friday night and worked two scoreless frames on one hit, one walk and one strikeout...Gorst was assigned from High-A Salem, where he was a Carolina League All-Star.

BASE-HIT BETT: Betts extended his hitting streak to five games: 6-for-15 (.400), HR, 5 RBI, 2B, 3 BB...The Wilmington, NC native has reached base safely in 13 of 18 games with Portland.

TEDDY BACK: RHP **Teddy Stankiewicz** made the start on Saturday night and took a no-decision...Stankiewicz pitched five innings on eight hits, three runs (two earned), one walk and four strikeouts...The righty stranded five runners, escaping a bases-loaded jam in the first.

MORE ON THE THUNDER 'PEN: Frare and **Stephen Tarpley** combined for five scoreless innings on just two hits and six strikeouts.

LOOK BACK AT 2017: Went 8-7 with a 3.81 ERA (57 ER/134.2 IP) in 26 starts between Low-A Greenville and High-A Salem, the 7th-lowest ERA among Red Sox minor leaguers...Led the organization with 169 SO, the 4th-most in Class-A...Struck out a career-high 12 on May 6th vs. Augusta and 11 on May 24th at Kannapolis...Named Boston's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month for May (5 GS, 3.30 ERA, 11 ER/30.0 IP, 46 SO)...Promoted to High-A Salem on June 4th...Went 5-3 with a 3.07 ERA (24 ER/70.1 IP), a .202 opponent AVG (51-for-252), 80 SO, and 30 BB in his final 13 High-A starts.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Left the University of Maryland holding career records in wins (30), strikeouts (307), and innings (307.1)...As a junior in 2016, set the program's single season records in wins (13) and strikeouts (138)...Named to the 2016 Big Ten All-Tournament Team...Struck out 16 batters in his postseason outing vs. Indiana, including each of the first six he faced, both records for TD Ameritrade Park in Omaha, NE.
