LOOKING FOR NUMBER ONE: The Portland Sea Dogs seek their first series win at Hadlock Field this season, hosting the Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies affiliate) in the middle game of a three-game set...Portland is 1-2 on the homestand, dropping a two-game series to Trenton from April 18-19 (series finale postponed)...The 'Dogs and Yard Goats wrap-up their series tomorrow night...Portland travels to Hartford next Monday-Wednesday (April 29-May 1).

FIVE WILL DO: RHP **Tanner Houck** (2-1) fired a one-hit shutout and tied a career-high with nine strikeouts, as Portland beat Hartford 7-0 in a five-inning, rain-shortened contest...The Sea Dogs went to work against losing pitcher **Brandon Gold** (1-1) in the second inning, scoring three two-out runs...**Luke Tandler** socked an RBI double for the first run...In the third, **Tate Matheny** delivered a two-run single and **Bobby Dalbec** launched a two-run homer over the Monster in the fourth.

WHEN WAS THE LAST?: LHP **Kyle Hart** had Portland's last complete-game shutout previous to Houck's on Monday...Hart threw seven scoreless on August 1, 2016, against Erie at Hadlock Field.

CLUBBING DOUBLES: **C.J. Chatham** went 2-for-3 with his league-leading ninth double in the third inning...Chatham is leading the Sea Dogs with a .347 average, which ranks eighth in the Eastern League...Hartford's **Alan Trejo** is seventh in the E.L. with a .357 mark.

GREAT START: **Brett Netzer** went 0-for-3 last night, snapping his hitting streak to 11 games...Dalbec extended his on-base streak to 13 games and has both homers over the Maine Monster.

WELCOME TO PORTLAND: **Marcus Wilson** made his debut in the Red Sox system, going 0-for-2 with a walk in last night's contest...Wilson was part of the **Blake Swihart** trade with Arizona.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland has lost all three season-series to the Hartford Yard Goats...Hartford joined the Eastern League in 2016 after moving from New Britain.
