Giants Continue Series Against Rancho Cucamonga... The San Jose Giants play the second game of a five-game series against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes this evening at Municipal Stadium. The Quakes earned a 3-1 victory over the Giants in the series opener yesterday. San Jose was held to a season-low tying two hits in last night's contest. Jason Bahr (2-0, 0.00 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

Four Straight Losses... The Giants enter tonight's contest on a four-game losing streak. San Jose has been outscored by a 30-13 margin during the losing skid. The Giants' longest losing streak of the season is five games (June 2-7). Yesterday's loss dropped San Jose (39-45) to a season-high six games below .500 overall.

Hitting Woes... San Jose has managed a total of just five hits and one run over their last two games. The Giants have been shutout five times in their last 19 games.

Second Half Stats... The Giants are off to a 5-9 start in the second half. San Jose is batting only .207 as a team in the second half with a 4.55 ERA. The Giants have hit 16 home runs in 14 second half games.

Power Surge... The Giants have hit seven home runs over their last four games. San Jose's 67 home runs this year lead all North Division clubs and rank third in the California League.

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is fourth in hits (92), fourth in doubles (22) and fifth in runs scored (48). Gio Brusa is tied for third in the league in home runs (13), tied for fifth in RBI's (46) and fifth in slugging (.513). Wander Franco is third in doubles (24) and tenth in hits (86) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for second in stolen bases (25).

Heath Quinn... Since returning from the disabled list on June 10 (hamstring), Heath Quinn is batting .359 (23-for-64) with five home runs in 17 games played. Quinn has hit safely in 22 out of his last 25 games and is batting .331 overall this season (45 games) – a 103-point improvement from his .228 mark with the San Jose Giants last year (75 games).

At Muni... The Giants are 3-10 in their last 13 home games after starting the season with a 17-10 record at Municipal Stadium. San Jose's overall home record for the year now stands at 20-20. The Giants own a 3.37 team ERA at home this year compared to 4.44 ERA on the road. San Jose hasn't won a series at Muni since taking three of four against Visalia from May 28-31.

Score First... San Jose is 28-14 (.667) when they score first in a game compared to 11-31 (.262) when their opponent scores first.

Last Series Win... The Giants haven't won a series since taking two of three at Modesto from June 8-10.

Versus The Quakes... The Giants are 1-4 against the Quakes this season (0-1 at Municipal Stadium, 1-3 at LoanMart Field). San Jose is batting only .182 as a team and averaging three runs per game against Rancho Cucamonga this year. The Giants have also struck out 60 times in the five games. San Jose will play 18 games versus the Quakes in the second half (all during a 47-game stretch from June 21-August 8).

Tough Schedule... San Jose's first 29 games of the second half (June 21-July 20) will be played against the only three teams in the California League currently with winning overall records (Rancho Cucamonga 12 games, Visalia 9 games, Stockton 8 games).

* Most recent outing came on June 30 at Visalia ... Tossed six shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts ... Threw 51 out of his 74 pitches for strikes.

* Tossed six scoreless innings in his California League debut on June 25 against Stockton ... Gave up four hits, walked one and struck out five ... Retired 18 out of the 23 batters he faced ... Threw 77 pitches.

* Was 6-4 with a 2.75 ERA in 13 starts for Augusta this season ... Struck out 88 batters and walked 21 over 68 2/3 innings ... Limited the opposition to a .211 batting average (.200 vs. right, .220 vs. left) ... Allowed two runs or fewer in 11 out of his 13 starts ... Won four straight starts from May 10-31.

* Ranked second in the South Atlantic League in strikeouts at the time of his promotion to San Jose ... Struck out 11 in back-to-back starts on May 10 versus Rome (6 IP) and May 18 at Greenville (6 IP).
