### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**FACING THE EAST:** Beloit will wrap up a stretch of 12 consecutive games against Eastern Division opponents when they face Fort Wayne this weekend. The Snappers are 4-5 through the first 9 games of this stretch. Dayton & Bowling Green each took 2 of 3 against the Snappers at Pohlman Field while Beloit won their first road series of the season at Lake County to start their 6-game roadtrip. The Western Division is a combined 39-42 against the Eastern Division during the first half's swing of inter-division play.

**TRIP TIDBITS:** The current 6-game roadtrip is the longest the Snappers will be away from home during the first half. Due to an off-day on June 5, the Snappers will return to Beloit from Appleton before moving on to Burlington after their day off. With their 5th road victory on Wednesday, the Snappers have yet to win back-to-back games away from home. In fact the Snappers have not won consecutive games since the final 2 games of their season-best, 6-game winning streak.

**TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE:** The Snappers 42 double plays are 2nd-most among all of Minor League Baseball teams behind the 43 twin killers tuned by the Midland RockHounds, the Athletics Double-A affiliate in the Texas League. Beloit has turned at least 1 double play in 17 of their last 20 games.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Beloit hitters currently sit 3rd in the Midwest League in home runs with 25. The Snappers have hit the 2nd-most home runs at home among teams playing in their home ballpark. However, the Snappers 6 homers on the road are tied with Burlington & Clinton with the fewest home runs while playing on the road. Beloit entered play yesterday with the fewest homers hit on the road before **Jason Goldstein** clubbed his first pro homer yesterday.

**WORTH NOTING:** **Brendan Butler's** start Wednesday was the first quality start by a Snappers pitcher this season. Butler went 6.2 innings & allowed 0 earned runs to qualify. The Snappers played 37 games between quality starts back to August 28, 2016 at Kane County as **Dustin Hurlbutt** hurled an 8-inning complete game in which he took the 1-0 loss. The 2 hits allowed by Snappers pitching yesterday were the fewest Beloit pitchers have allowed in a game going back to Opening Day 2016 when the Snappers two-hit the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** The Snappers are now 12-1 when scoring 5 runs or more after bringing home 9 runs on Wednesday. Beloit is just 4-8 when they give up 5 runs or more. The Snappers have played in 5 games where both teams scored 5 runs. Beloit it 4-1 in games the Snappers & their opponents combine on 10 runs or more.

**TODAY'S PITCHERS:** On Thursday, the Snappers will go with the piggy-back tandem of **Ty Damron** & **Michael Murray**. In their first game as pitching partners on May 6 vs. Bowling Green, they held the Hot Rods to just 2 runs on 6 hits & fanned 13 batters over 8.1 innings of work. Damron has struggled in a limited sample size in road outings with a 9.53 ERA away from Pohlman Field versus an 0.93 ERA when pitching at home. Meanwhile, Murray has allowed 1 run or less when he logs at least 4 innings & has allowed 4 earned runs as the 2nd pitcher of the day.

**FACING THE TINCAPS:** The Snappers will get their first look at Parkview Field since July 23-25, 2014 over the weekend. All time at Parkview Field, Beloit is 7-5 going back to when the ballpark opened its doors in 2009. Last season in Beloit, Fort Wayne & the Snappers met in July to see the first game get rained out. Fort Wayne won the opener & then Beloit swept the doubleheader to complete the series including a 2-1 win where **Brendan Butler** out-dueled Padres top prospect **Anderson Espinoza** in his Snappers debut. On their 2017 roster, the TinCaps carry 5 of the Padres top-30 prospects according to MLB.com. Those position players are **Fernando Tatis Jr.** (#6), **Jorge Ona** (#7), **Hudson Potts** (#12), & **Eguy Rosario** (#30) in addition to pitcher **Logan Allen** (#17).
