LAST TIME OUT: Top Toronto Blue Jay prospect Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit two homers and drove in five runs and Cavan Biggio also went deep as the Fisher Cats handled rival Portland 10-2 on Monday night at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium.

Sean Reid-Foley (5-0) struck out eight over five innings to earn the win. Nick Tepesch tossed three innings of scoreless relief for his first save. On the day he was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for the second time this season, the 19-year old Guerrero Jr. hit his first home run at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium in the first inning.

The three-run shot staked the Fisher Cats to a 3-0 lead. New Hampshire (18-9) tacked on three runs in the bottom of the fourth inning. Harold Ramirez walked and Connor Panas doubled. Ramirez scored on a single by Ryan Hissey and Panas came across on a wild pitch. Hissey would score on an error to make it 6-0. Portland (7-19) designated hitter Conrad Gregor hit a two-run home run in the top of the fifth inning to make it 6-2. Biggio led off the bottom of the fifth with his seven home run to make it 7-2.

With two outs in the sixth, Jonathan Davis doubled and Bo Bichette doubled him home. Guerrero Jr. then launched a 3-2 fastball off the hotel in left center for his second homer of the game and fifth of the season.

Kevin McAvoy (0-1) took the loss for Portland. Boston Red Sox reliever Tyler Thornburg did work a scoreless frame in his rehabilitation assignment on Monday. He walked one and struck out one.

SONS OF A BIG LEAGUER: A trio of big league progeny is on the Fisher Cats' Opening Day roster. #1 Blue Jays prospect and #3 overall prospect (MLB.com) Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. – son of 2018 Hall of Famer Vladimir Guerrero, Sr. – leads the way with #2 Blue Jays prospect and #13 overall (MLB.com) Bo Bichette alongside. Bichette is the youngest son of long-time big leaguer Dante Bichette. Cavan Biggio – son of Hall of Famer Craig Biggio – will see plenty of playing time on the right side of the infield.

STICK IT: New Hampshire leads the Eastern League with a .272 average, 15 points higher than the second place club and 31 points above the league average. The Fisher Cats' +41 run differential (145-104) and 145 runs scored are second in the circuit.

LATE NIGHT BATS: The Fisher Cats have outscored opponents 66-35 from the sixth inning on this season, compared to a 78-69 tally through the first five frames. A +16 run differential in the sixth inning is the largest of any stanza.

LEAGUE LEADERS: A Fisher Cat is represented amongst league leaders in 26 categories, with the top spot belonging to a 'Cat in batting average (Vlad Jr., .398), wins (Reid-Foley & Romano, 5), RBI (Vlad Jr., 35), hits (Vlad Jr., 39), strikeout (Sean Reid-Foley, 39), extra base hits (Biggio & Vlad Jr., 16), runs scored (Bichette, 25), triples (Bichette, 4) and batting average against (Romano, .154)

WE HAVE THE RUNS: The top three run scorers in the league are on New Hampshire's roster. Bo Bichette (25), Jonathan Davis (23) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (22) have most often touched home plate this season.

ADVANCED STAT OF THE DAY: We all know Vlad Guerrero Jr. is in rarified air when it comes to his offensive production, and his Weighted Runs Created Plus (wRC+) of 213 backs up that claim. wRC+ measures how a player's wRC (which quantifies a player's total offensive value and measure it by runs) compares with league average after controlling for park effects. League average for position players is 100, and every point above 100 is a percentage point above league average. Therefore, the 19-year-old slugger creates 213% more runs than the average Eastern League player.

ON THE HILL: #9 Blue Jays prospect T.J. Zeuch is set to make his Double-A debut for New Hampshire tonight. In six starts for Advanced-A Dunedin, the right-hander went 3-3 with a 3.47 ERA over 36.1 innings pitched. He struck out four and walked nine over that span. Zeuch is in the midst of his third professional season after he was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round (21st overall) of the 2016 draft out of Pittsburgh. From MLB.com: "Zeuch is a physical presence on the mound and knows how to use his 6-foot-7 frame to create a steep downhill angle to the plate. His fastball will touch 96-97 mph but typically sits in the 91-94 mph range, with outstanding late run and sinking action that helps him generate a plethora of weak ground balls." He's from Mason, OH.

RHP Travis Lakins will go for Portland in game two. Last time out, the #16 Red Sox prospect (MLB.com) went three shutout frames in Hartford and allowed one hit. He struck out five and walked one. Lakins, 23, began the season on the disabled list as he continued to work back from a stress fracture in his elbow last summer. The Franklin, OH native was a sixth round pick in 2015 out of Ohio State.
