Yesterday's Game: The River Cats came out swinging on Wednesday night, piling up 18 total hits in their 12-2 thrashing of the Fresno Grizzlies. Four different Sacramento hitters had at least three hits, and the first four batters in the lineup combined to go 12-for-20 with eight runs scored and eight RBI. Included in that were leadoff hitter **OF Peter Bourjos** who went 4-for-6 with a double and three runs scored, and **OF Mac Williamson** who went 2-for-5 with a home run and four batted in. **INF Jerry Sands** oined the party with three hits and he launched his first two home runs since joining Sacramento on July 12. Amongst the offensive explosion, **RHP Casey Kelly** also tossed a gem, notching his team-leading ninth victory with seven 1-run innings on three hits, two walks, and 10 strikeouts.

Today's Starter: RHP Shaun Anderson (0-0, No ERA) will make his much anticipated Triple-A debut on Thursday, fresh off an appearance in the MLB Futures Game on Monday. Anderson is the San Francisco Giants' 7th ranked prospect according to MLB.com. Prior to his promotion, Anderson compiled a 6-5 record with a 3.45 ERA in 94.0 innings at Double-A Richmond. He also carried an impressive 8.9 K/9 rate with just 22 walks compared to his 93 strikeouts. the right-hander was aquired by the Giants along with **RHP Gregory Santos** in the trade which sent **INF Eduardo Nunez** to the Boston Red Sox in 2017.

Offensive Explosion: The River Cats' offense broke out on Wednesday to a degree they have not in quite a while. Their 18 total hits were the most since they racked up 19 back on April 11 against the Reno Aces. Their 12 runs was the most they have scored in a game since April 14 against the Tacoma Rainiers. The River Cats improved to 4-1 when they score at least 10 runs in a game. **OF Peter Bourjos's** four-hit game was the 10th time a Sacramento hitter has had at least four hits in a game this season. Also, **INF Jerry Sands** joining **INF Chase d'Arnaud** and **OF Chris Shaw** (twice) as the only players to hit two home runs in a game this season.

Kelly Gem: RHP Casey Kelly put it all together on Wednesday, going seven strong and striking out 10 Fresno Grizzlies. It has been an up-and-down season for Kelly thus far, but last night was certainly among his best starts of the season. Wednesday was the sixth time he went at least seven innings in a start, but he set a season-high in strikeout with 10, and allowed just three hits. The right-hander also threw a season-high 111 pitches.

Defense Improving?: While there has been some improvement in the Month of July, the River Cats are still at or near the bottom of the league in just about every defensive category. They rank last in the Pacific Coast League in total errors (91), third-to-last in double plays turned (73), and last in total assists (824). The errors/game have improved in July for Sacramento, however, from 1.01/game from April-June, to 0.73/game in July.

*ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY

PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY*

TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching

Same as FIP, but it normalizes a pitcher's home runs allowed based on their fly ball rate rather than simply using the raw number of home runs allowed.
