### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**WINNING WAYS:** The Snappers won their 5th straight game on their 8th walk-off victory of the year to clinch the series against Burlington. Beloit won 14 of their final 18 games in July & are riding a season-long 7-game home winning streak. The Snappers are one win shy of matching their longest overall winning streak of the campaign.

**SWEEP STAKES:** Beloit has an opportunity to sweep their 2nd home series in a row with another victory on Tuesday. The Snappers have completed just 2 sweeps this season (South Bend, July 22-24 & Clinton, April 24-26) & have not swept a 4-game series since June 8-10, 2013 at Burlington.

**PITCHING PROWESS:** The Snappers finished July with the best ERA during the month with a 2.57 mark to aid the first winning month of professional baseball since June 2013. Three Beloit bullpen arms went the entire month without allowing a run: **Yordys Alejandro** (8 games, 12 IP), **Heath Bowers** (6 games, 15.1 IP), & **Sam Sheehan** (6 games, 7.1 IP). Eight out of 27 starts were quality starts (6 IP, 3 or less ER) with 3 by each **Xavier Altamirano** & **Matt Milburn** while **Zack Erwin** had 2 quality starts & 3 scoreless starts.

**MIGHTY MARTIN:** Before **Mike Martin** beat a potential inning-ending double play that won the game, he entered Monday's game as a pinch-runner & stole his 5th base of the series against Burlington. Martin finished the month of July with 11 stolen bases, one shy of the league lead behind Fort Wayne's **Fernando Tatis Jr.** with 12. Martin's 19 total stolen bases this season lead the Athletics minor league system.

**NOW WE'RE TALKING:** **Kyle Nowlin** homered & walked twice on Monday, 2 things he has done at a high rate lately. Nowlin became the 3rd Snapper to reach double digits in homers & finished July with 5 roundtrippers. He now has 17 RBI in his last 17 games. His 2 walks give him 51 on the season, 3rd in the Midwest League, & he trails only Fernando Tatis Jr. for the most walks in the league since June 1. Nowlin had a career-best month by slashing .338/.446/.610 in July.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** **Luke Persico** leads the Midwest League with 14 outfield assist as the Snappers league the league as a team with 40. Beloit has turned 106 double plays to lead the Low-A level. Beloit has also not committed an error in 3 games.

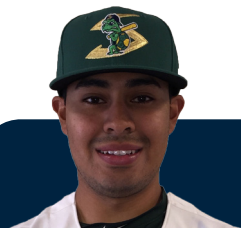

**CLOSE GAMES:** The Snappers have played a total of 67 games decided by 3 runs or fewer & Beloit has a record of 33-34 in those contests. Additionally, Beloit's 37 one-run games are 2nd-most in the league.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** The Snappers are 37-7 this season when they score at least 5 runs. Beloit is 12-7 in ballgames.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** **Xavier Altamirano** gets the start for the Snappers on Tuesday with the Midwest League's 7th-best ERA (2.81) while winning his last 3 starts. Altamirano is coming off a dominant one-hit performance against Kane County to match a career-high 7 innings pitched & began Beloit's 5-game winning streak.

**FACING THE BEES:** The Snappers have won 5 straight over Burlington at Pohlman Field dating back to April 22. Beloit will visit the Bees one more time this season to begin the final road trip of the season. Burlington has one of the Angels top-30 prospects in RHP **Joe Gatto** (#27).

**ALTAMIRANO QUICK HITS:** Third professional season...A 27th round draft pick by Oakland in the 2015 First-Year Player Draft... Pitched all of 2015 with the AZL A's & split 2016 between Beloit & short season Vermont...Opened college career at Cochise College in his hometown of Douglas, AZ where he played for 2 seasons before finishing college career at Oral Roberts

- Carried a scoreless streak of 27.1 innings spanning 8 consecutive appearances from May 15 through June 16
- Struck out a professional career-high 8 batters vs. Quad Cities on June 16 over 4 innings of relief work

**2016:**

- Opened the season with Beloit & made 8 outings (5 starts, 3 in relief); had a 0.71 ERA through his first 4 games with the Snappers
- Placed on the disabled list on May 24 after allowing 10 runs in his final 2 appearances (7.1 IP)
- Joined Short-A Vermont in June to finish the year where he was a New York-Penn League All-Star; Pitched perfect 2nd for North in ASG
- Finished the season 5th in ERA (2.48) among NYPL qualifiers; Allowed 3 runs or fewer in all but 2 starts for Vermont & had a 1.13 ERA in relief

- Hurlled 4 complete games in 2014, a season he helped the Cochise College Apaches to the NJCAA Division I World Series; team finished 3rd at the NJCAA Division I World Series in 2013
- Threw 3 no-hitters at Douglas HS (Douglas, AZ) where he also owns the school record for strikeouts in a game (19)
- A 2-sport standout in high school; team MVP awards in baseball & basketball
