TODAY: Following yesterday's series tying 6-4 loss to the Dash, the Mudcats continue a six game, seven day, road trip today with the finale of a three game series at BB&T Ballpark versus the Winston-Salem Dash... The Dash leveled the series at a game apiece with a 6-4 victory in yesterday's middle game of the three game series... The Dash lead the overall season series 6-4, having gone 4-2 versus the Mudcats in Winston-Salem and 2-2 versus Carolina in Zebulon this season... Today's game is the third of six second half meetings between the two teams and the 11th of 14 total meetings between the two Southern Division rivals this season.

ICYMI: Brice Turang went 2-for-4 with two runs batted in, Mario Feliciano drove in a run while going 1-for-3 and Wes Rogers went 2-for-4 with a double, but the Dash scored six early runs while holding off the Mudcats with a series tying 6-4 victory on Saturday at BB&T Ballpark in Winston-Salem. The Dash scored early and often in Saturday's middle game of the three-game series as they scored four times in the first before scoring two more runs in the second while taking an early 6-0 lead against starter Matt Smith and the Mudcats. Carolina eventually rallied back with two runs in the fifth and two runs in the eighth while scoring four unanswered runs before eventually falling 6-4.

ABOUT THE LAST ONE: The Mudcats were outscored 6-0 over the first two innings of yesterday's loss to the Dash in Winston-Salem. Carolina has additionally been outscored 15-6 in the first inning and 32-18 over the first three innings of their last 23 games (since 7/10, overall Carolina is 6-17 in that same span).

**OF LATE:** The Mudcats have gone just 6-17 since 7/10 and since starting the second half at 12-8 over their first 20 games following the All-Star break (6/20-7/9)... The Mudcats have also combined to hit just .201 with 2.7 runs/game and a run differential of -22 runs since 7/10.

IN JULY: Carolina started July at 6-3 while batting .275 with 5.6 runs/ game and a staff ERA of 2.92 between 7/1 & 7/9. They went on to finish July, however, at just 4-16 with a team batting average of .184, 2.4 runs/game and a 3.75 ERA between 7/10 & 7/31.

WHERE THEY RANK: Mario Feliciano is 1st in the CL in home runs (16), 2nd in RBI (71), 2nd in slugging (.463), 8th in OPS (.784), 7th in hits (105), 1st in extra-base hits (40) and tied for 1st in total bases (180)... Payton Henry is tied for 8th in the CL in home runs (10) and 6th in RBI (61)... Tristen Lutz is tied for 8th in the CL in home runs (10), tied for 6th in XBH (33) and 3rd in runs (56)... Matt Hardy is currently tied for 7th in the CL in wins (7) and tied for 8th in games (32)... Cody Beckman is currently 2nd in the CL in games (34)... J.T. Hintzen and Michael Petersen are tied for 5th in the CL in games (33)... Noah Zavolas is currently 2nd in the CL in ERA (2.93), 1st in innings pitched (129.0) and 1st in WHIP (1.11). Zavolas is also 1st in the CL in FIP (3.12), 2nd in xFIP (3.34), 1st in BB/9 (1.47) and 2nd in K/BB (4.67)... Matt Smith is currently 3rd in the CL in ERA (3.69), tied for 4th in K/BB (2.81) and 2nd in LOB% (74.2%).

**ROAD WOES:** The Mudcats had lost nine straight road games before Friday's 2-1 victory in Winston-Salem. Carolina is, however, just 2-14 over the club's last 16 road games. They are also just 5-15 away from home since the All-Star break... Carolina started the season 16-11 over their first eight road series, but have gone 7-18 since. Overall Carolina is 24-30 on the road this season.

HEATING UP: Zach Clark has hit safely in five straight and is batting .368/.429/.368 with a .797 OPS during that same span (7-for-19, 1 R, 2 RBI, 2 BB, 4 SO)... Tristen Lutz has hit safely in four of his last six games and is batting .360/.385/.480 with a .865 OPS over that same span (9-for-25, 3 R, 1 HR, 3 RBI). Lutz has also totaled seven hits over his last three games after going 4-for-5 on 8/1 and 3-for-5 on 8/2... Mario Feliciano has hit safely in six of his last seven games and is batting .370/.433/.556 with a .989 OPS over that same span (10-for-27, 7 R, 2 2B, 1 HR, 3 BB, 7 SO).

STREAKS OF NOTE: Phil Bickford has pitched through 10.0 consecutive scoreless innings (4 BB, 15 SO) and six straight scoreless appearances... Rob Henry started the season with 6 home runs over his first 16 games, but has not homered since 4/19 in Salem while going 57 games without a home run. Henry has also gone 18 straight and 51 AB without a RBI (last RBI on 7/7 vs. LYN)... Devin Hairston has played through 45 straight games without an error.

KINGS OF THE NORTH: The Mudcats are currently 35-22 versus Carolina League Northern Division teams this season. They have also gone 17-8 versus Northern Division teams since 6/11 (at FRE)... The Mudcats are, however, just 7-25 vs. Southern Division teams since 5/24 (vs. DE, 3.5 G back of first before 5/24) and had suffered nine straight losses in games versus Southern Division teams (6/16 vs. WS - 7/3 at MB) before defeating the Pelicans 3-2 on 7/19 in Zebulon.

BACK STOP SPLITS: Payton Henry and Mario Feliciano have split catching duties this season with Henry starting 56 games behind the plate and Feliciano starting 53 games at catcher... The Carolina pitching staff is 31-26 and has totaled a 3.51 ERA (2.9 BB/9, 8.7 SO/9) in games started by and caught by Henry... Carolina's pitchers are 25-28 with a 4.17 ERA (3.1 BB/9, 7.9 SO/9) in games caught by Feliciano.

ALL THE Ks: The Carolina offense has combined to total a Carolina League high 1,130 strikeouts this season (6th most in MiLB). The Mudcats are on pace to set both a CL and franchise record for most strikeouts for the third straight season. Carolina batters combined to total a CL and franchise record 1,311 strikeouts last season; breaking the previous CL and franchise record of 1,245 SO set by Carolina in 2017.

THE TOP 30: The Carolina roster currently features five of Milwaukee's Top 30 prospects (as rated by MLBPipeline.com) including No. 1 INF Brice Turang, No. 2 OF Tristen Lutz, No. 8 LHP Aaron Ashby, No. 9 C Mario Feliciano and No. 16 C Payton Henry.

#### NOTES

AN APRIL TO REMEMBER: Carolina's 16-10 record in April was the club's best since 2008 when the then-Southern League and Florida Marlins affiliated Mudcats opened the year with a record of 17-10. Just three years earlier, the 2005 Marlins affiliated Mudcats opened the season going 18-4 in April. The 2005 and 2008 Mudcats both went on to reach the Southern League playoffs in their respective seasons... Carolina's 25 home runs hit in April were a new franchise high for most home runs hit by a Mudcats team in April since the 2004 squad hit 24 homers in the first month of their season.

**FIRST QUARTER:** The Mudcats went 21-14 over their first 35 games, or first quarter, of the 2019 season. That 21-14 (.600) matches the 1994 Mudcats for the fourth best first 35-game record in team history. The 1995 and 2005 Mudcats own the franchise's best first 35-game team record in franchise history after both clubs started their respective seasons at 24-11.

**FOR THREE:** Tristen Lutz's first inning triple on 5/3 in Wilmington was the first for the Mudcats during the 2019 season. Lutz's triple came in club's 29th game of the season making the Mudcats the last affiliated Minor League Baseball team to record a triple in 2019 (29th game).

WALK-OFF BIG FLIES: Mario Feliciano's walk-off home run to defeat Lynchburg on 5/20 was his second walk-off of the season and third overall walk-off homer of the year for the Mudcats. Feliciano also hit a walk-off, three-run blast on 5/11 to defeat the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Dallas Carroll, meanwhile, hit the first walk-off homer of this season (one month earlier) on 4/11 versus Wilmington. Carroll's walk-off earlier this year was Carolina's first since Keston Hiura hit a walk-off homer on 5/25/18 versus Myrtle Beach. Before Hiura's walk- off big fly last year, the last walk-off home run in Mudcats history came in 2013 when Bryson Myles delivered a game-winning blast to beat the Winston-Salem Dash in the 14th inning at Five County Stadium on 7/18/13... Mario Feliciano is also the only player in recorded Mudcats history to total multiple walk-off home runs in the same season.

STREAKING: Ryan Aguilar reached base safely in a team and Carolina League best 26 straight games from 4/14 through 5/13. The streak came to an end when he entered an extra-innings game on 5/14 in Lynchburg as a defensive replacement in the tenth and later struck out in his only at bat of the game in the eleventh. Aguilar hit .278/.420/.356 with a .775 OPS during the streak (25-for-90, 18 R, 4 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 19 BB, 3 HBP, 28 SO).

TO THE SHOW: Former Mudcats OF Trent Grisham (2017), INF Keston Hiura (2018), RHP Jordan Yamamoto (2017) and INF Dylan Moore (2016) have all been called up to the big leagues this season. Grisham and Hiura both made their MLB debuts with the Brewers and did so on 8/1 at Oakland (Grisham) and 5/14 at Philadelphia (Hiura) respectively. Yamamoto made his debut with the Miami Marlins on 6/12 vs. St. Louis and Moore made his with the Seattle Mariners on 3/28 in Japan versus the Oakland Athletics... Grisham and Hiura, meanwhile, joined RHP Corbin Burnes and RHP Freddy Peralta as the three four former Mudcats to debut with the Brewers since Carolina became Milwaukee's High-A affiliate in 2017.

**BIG LEAGUE CAMP:** Devin Hairston played in 13 MLB Spring Training games for the Brewers in 2019 (2-for-8, 3 R, 2B, 3 RBI, 2 BB, 6 SO). Hairston also traveled with Milwaukee to Montreal for an exhibition game versus Toronto on 3/25 and scored a run... Tristen Lutz played in 17 MLB Spring Training games (1-for-18, 4 R, 3 BB, 10 SO)... Rodrigo Benoit appeared in five MLB Spring Training games (5 G, 3.2 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 HR, 4 SO)... Matt Hardy appeared in one MLB Spring Training game and earned a victory on 3/24 vs. ARI (1-0, 0.2 IP, 1 BB)... Additional MLB Spring Training appearances: Mario Feliciano (2 G, 0-for-4, R, RBI, BB, SO), Payton Henry (11 G, 1-for-12, R, 2B, RBI, BB, 3 SO), Ryan Aguilar (1 G, 1 PA, 1 HBP), Julio Garcia (1 G, 0-for-1), Zach Clark (1 G, 0-for-2, 2 SO), Rob Henry (2 G, 0-for-1, SO), Joantgel Segovia (1 G, 1-for-1, R).

PLAYOFF DROUGHT: The Mudcats failed to reach the playoffs again in 2018, stretching their current playoff drought to seven (7) consecutive Carolina League seasons. Carolina has additionally failed to reach the playoffs in 10 consecutive seasons overall between their time in the Carolina League (2012-Present) and Southern League (1991-2011). The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 when they lost to the Mississippi Braves in the Southern League Championship Series... Current post-season droughts in MiLB (full-season teams): Buffalo (AAA)/Delmarva (A-): 13 seasons, New Orleans (AAA): 11 seasons, Iowa (AAA): 10 seasons, Hartford (AA): 9 seasons, Louisville (AAA): 8 seasons
