**Tonight's Game...** The San Jose Giants return home this evening to open a four-game series against the Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics affiliate). Jason Bahr is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight. Bahr was added to San Jose's roster from Augusta (A) today and will be making his California League debut.

**Rancho Review...** The Giants opened the second half by dropping three out of four games at Rancho Cucamonga in a series that concluded yesterday afternoon. San Jose earned a come-from-behind 6-5 win in the opener last Thursday – their league-leading fifth victory this season when trailing after seven innings. The Quakes then posted three straight wins of 5-4 on Friday, 5-2 on Saturday and 6-2 yesterday to take the series. Rancho Cucamonga hit eight home runs in the series while Giants batters struck out 53 times during the four-game set.

**The Giants...** San Jose (35-39) fell a season-high four games below .500 overall following yesterday's loss. The Giants are 5-14 in their last 19 games. San Jose has only one series victory in June (won two of three games at Modesto from June 8-10). The Giants have gone just 13-24 (.382) since they were a season-high seven games above .500 on May 13 (22-15).

**Home Woes...** The Giants enter today's contest having lost seven out of their last eight home games. San Jose has lost their last three series' at Municipal Stadium. The Giants are 18-17 at home overall this season.

**Hitting Streaks...** Heath Quinn saw his hitting streak end at 15 games following an 0-for-4 night at the plate on Saturday. The Giants boast three of the seven longest hitting streaks in the California League this season: Jonah Heim – Stockton (19 games), Matt Winn – Giants (16 games), Heath Quinn – Giants (15 games), Colton Welker – Lancaster (15 games), Wander Franco – Giants (13 games), Luke Persico – Stockton (13 games) and Evan White – Modesto (13 games).

**Heath Quinn...** Since returning from the disabled list on June 10, Heath Quinn is batting .382 (13-for-34) with two home runs in nine games played. Quinn has hit safely in 16 out of his last 17 games and is hitting .331 overall this season (37 games) – a 103-point improvement from his .228 mark with the San Jose Giants last year (75 games).

**Versus The Ports...** The Giants are 6-8 against Stockton this season (3-4 at Municipal Stadium, 3-4 at Banner Island Ballpark). San Jose has lost six out of their last seven games to the Ports. The Giants are batting only .230 as a team against Stockton pitching. San Jose will play 14 games versus the Ports in the second half.

**League Leaderboard...** Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is second in hits (83), second in runs scored (47), tied for eighth in doubles (18) and tied for ninth in RBI's (39). Gio Brusa is tied for fourth in the league in home runs (11), tied for ninth in RBI's (39) and eighth in slugging (.498). Wander Franco is second in doubles (24) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for fourth in stolen bases (21).

**On The Mound...** The Giants' 5.00 team ERA in June is second-to-last in the California League (Lancaster 5.06). San Jose fashioned a 3.34 ERA in April and a 3.60 ERA in May. Despite giving up eight homers in the Rancho Cucamonga series, the Giants have still allowed the fewest home runs in the league (44). San Jose has issued the most walks in the league this season (304, 4.1 per game).

**Turn Two...** The Giants have turned a league-leading 72 double plays this season.

**Close Calls...** The Giants have played the most one-run games (27 games, 12-15 record) and extra-inning games (10 games, 6-4 record) in the league this season.

First six appearances were as a reliever (6.23 ERA) before making seven straight starts to end the season (2.59 ERA) ... Did not give up a home run for the entire season.

### #39 Kelvin Beltre (.179, 0 HR, 5 RBI, 1 SB)

**Current Hit Streak: 0**

- \* Infielder is in his fifth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2013 at age 16.
- \* Currently ranked the #21 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com* ... Third-highest infielder on list.
- \* Joined San Jose from Extended Spring Training on June 7 ... Suffered fractured leg from a foul ball during spring training.
- \* Spent the last two seasons with Augusta (A) ... Batted .253 with 6 HR, 37 RBI's and 15 SB in 118 games last year.
- \* Was a second baseman last year after playing primarily third base in 2016. Began pro career as a shortstop.

### #26 Gio Brusa (.254, 11 HR, 39 RBI, 3 SB)

**Current Hit Streak: 2 games**

- \* First baseman is in his third professional season ... Selected in the 6th round of the 2016 draft.
- \* Hit for the cycle on April 11 at Lancaster joining teammate Jalen Miller in accomplishing the feat that night.
- \* Was an outfielder in his first two seasons before transitioning to first base this year.
- \* Spent the entire 2017 season with San Jose ... Batted .237 with team-high tying 17 home runs and 55 RBI's in 113 games.
- \* Earned Northwest League All-Star honors with Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016.
- \* Led the Northwest League with 10 home runs in '16 ... Hit .264 with 42 RBI's in 53 games ... Won All-Star home run derby.
- \* Attended the University of the Pacific ... Finished career second in school history in doubles, fourth in HR and fifth in RBI's.

### #54 Sandro Fabian (.226, 6 HR, 23 RBI, 1 SB)

- \* Outfielder is in his fourth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2014 at age 16.

- \* Spent the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Batted .277 with 11 home runs and 61 RBI's in 122 games.
- \* Led the GreenJackets in hits (133), doubles (30) and RBI's ... Hit .311 in the second half last year (.243 first half).
- \* Hit .340 for the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2016 (42 games).

### #49 Johneshwy Fargas (.274, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 21 SB)

- \* Outfielder in his sixth professional season ... Selected in the 11th round of the 2013 draft out of the Puerto Rico Academy.
- \* Was named a midseason California League All-Star.

- \* Spent first six years of his career in the Kansas City Royals system ... Acquired in minor league phase of Rule 5 draft last Dec.
- \* Spent the last two seasons playing for the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A) of the Carolina League.
- \* Batted .279 with four home runs and 46 RBI's in 129 games last year (.220 AVG, 5 HR, 47 RBI in 2016).
