Giants Continue Series Against Modesto... The San Jose Giants play the second game of a three-game series against the Modesto Nuts this evening at Municipal Stadium. The Giants earned a 4-0 victory over the Nuts in the series opener last night. Melvin Adon (1-3, 4.85 ERA) is slated to make the start tonight.

Homestand Update... The Giants are currently in the midst of a season-high 10-game homestand. San Jose is 4-1 thus far on the homestand taking three out of four games from Visalia before defeating Modesto last night. The Giants are batting .221 as a team (4.4 runs per game) with a 1.69 ERA during the homestand.

In Search Of Three Straight Wins... The Giants have won back-to-back games for the second time on their homestand. San Jose last won three straight games overall from May 9-11.

First Half Race... The Giants (30-25) are four games behind first-place Stockton (34-21) in the first half North Division race. 15 games remain in the first half. All 15 games will be played against North Division opponents (seven games vs. Stockton, five games vs. Modesto, three games vs. Visalia).

Muni Magic... At 17-10, the Giants boast the top home record in the California League. San Jose has lost only one home series this season (May 15-17 vs. Modesto). The Giants own six walk-off wins this year with the most recent coming on May 29 against Visalia (2-1 win in 11 innings). San Jose possesses a sparkling 2.76 team ERA at home this season (4.10 ERA on the road).

Familiar Foe... Tonight marks the 18th game of the season between San Jose and Modesto. The Giants are 9-8 against the Nuts overall (5-3 at Municipal Stadium, 4-5 at John Thurman Field). The teams are scheduled to play 22 games against each other in the first half (over a 49-game span from April 19-June 10). San Jose is batting .286 as a team versus Modesto – their highest AVG against an opponent this season.

Miller Surging... Jalen Miller is 8-for-18 (.444 AVG) at the plate during the homestand with two home runs and five RBI's (five games played). Miller smacked two home runs in the homestand opener on Monday against Visalia – the first multi-homer game of his career. He also delivered a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th inning on Tuesday. He's now hit safely in 21 out of his last 23 games and currently ranks seventh in the California League in batting average (.314) and second in hits (65).

On The Mound... The Giants' team ERA of 3.42 ranks second in the California League (Visalia leads at 3.28). San Jose picked-up their sixth shutout of the season last night – one off the league lead (Inland Empire). The Giants have also allowed the fewest home runs in the league (26) this year. Stetson Woods and Norwith Gudino last night became the 27th and 28th pitchers to see action with San Jose this season.

C.J's Back... C.J Hinojosa was added to San Jose's roster on May 30 from Extended Spring Training. The #16 prospect in the SF organization according to *MLB.com* was recovering from an Achilles injury earlier this year while also serving a 50-game suspension to begin the season (violation of Minor League Baseball drug policy). Hinojosa was a midseason California League All-Star in 2016 (.296 AVG, 6 HR, 34 RBI in 69 games).

30 Wins... The Giants became the second team in the California League this season (Stockton) with 30 wins following last night's victory. San Jose had 30 wins for the entire first half last year (30-40 record).

- * Tonight marks his 11th start and 12th overall appearance with San Jose this season ... Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in six out of his ten starts ... Has struck out 52 batters in 55 2/3 innings ... Owns a 1.70-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio the highest groundout rate on the Giants staff.
- * Has pitched at least six innings in four starts ... Rest of Giants staff has combined to pitch at least six innings only five times.
- * Will be making his fourth start against Modesto (1-0, 4.11 ERA) ... Picked-up his first win of the season in his most recent start versus the Nuts on May 23 at John Thurman Field ... Tossed 5 1/3 innings with one run and three hits allowed ... Walked two and struck out five ... Giants won the game 4-1.
- * Last pitched on May 28 against Visalia at Municipal Stadium (opener of current homestand) ... Worked 4 1/3 innings with five runs (four earned) and seven hits allowed ... Walked two and struck out five ... Three of his charged runs scored after he left the game ... Received a no-decision (Giants eventually won 9-6).
- * Took a shutout into the seventh inning of his May 1 start against Visalia ... Pitched a season-high seven innings with two runs (one earned) allowed ... Struck out a career-high nine batters over six innings on April 25 against Lake Elsinore (two runs allowed).
- * Has fared better against right-handed hitters (.256 AVG, 2 HR) compared to versus left-handed batters (.306 AVG, 2 HR) this season.
- * Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Was 3-11 with a 4.35 ERA in 23 games (19 starts) ... Struck out 89 and walked 35 over 99 1/3 innings ... Allowed one or no earned runs in 10 out of his 19 starts last season ... Allowed only five home runs for the entire season ... Had a .253 opponents batting average against right-handed hitters compared to a .299 AVG versus left-handed batters.
