TONIGHT'S GAME: The Sounds and cross-state rival Memphis Redbirds (AAA-Cardinals) wrap up a four-game series with tonight's finale. It is the fourth of 16 meetings between the clubs in this year's I-40 Cup Series; Memphis leads the season series, 2-1. The Sounds hold a 139-118 lead in the all-time series between the clubs, which began in 1998. This evening's game will be broadcast live on 102.5-FM "The Game" as well as via an internet webcast available at www.nashvillesounds.com. Jeff Hem is on the call.

MILLS MAKES SPOT START: Left-hander **Brad Mills** takes the hill tonight for his second start of the year for the Sounds, filling in for the injured **Ariel Pena**. The southpaw earned a win in his last appearance on Saturday against Omaha, when he took over after Pena left the contest due to a forearm injury suffered on a comebacker and allowed one run in three frames of relief in Nashville's 5-2 victory. In his career, Mills is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (5er/17.0ip) in three starts versus Memphis.

DEALIN': The Sounds' 4.22 team ERA is 6th-best in the Pacific Coast League. Nashville hurlers have surrendered nine home runs, tied for 2nd-fewest in the league, and have issued only 41 walks this season, 3rd-fewest in the PCL.

AWAKENING THE LUMBER: In the past five games, the Sounds are hitting .274 (46-for-168) with 20 extra-base hits. However, Nashville's season .243 team batting average is 4th-lowest in the PCL and the club has drawn only 28 walks, the fewest in the circuit. The Sounds have scored 45 runs in 14 games this season, 49 less than league-leading Oklahoma City (94).

VELEZ PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: Utilityman **Eugenio Velez** -- who went 4-for-5 last night to match his career high for hits in a game (12th occurrence) -- leads the Pacific Coast League with his .474 batting average. The 31-year-old has hit safely in each of his 10 starts, has six multi-hit games this season, and is riding his second five-game hit streak of the year (9-for-20, .450). He also ranks 3rd in the PCL with a .535 on-base percentage and is 6th with a .737 slugging mark. Velez is tied for 3rd in the league with five stolen bases. The veteran closed out the 2013 campaign by reaching base safely via hit or walk in his final 36 games, including a season-ending 22-game hit streak.

ARMED AND DANGEROUS: Nashville outfielders have combined for five assists this season, 3rd-most in the PCL (El Paso & Reno have six each). Three of the five Sounds assists have come at home plate, including one by **Eugenio Velez** in last night's win.

ORR DRILLING: Infielder **Pete Orr** is hitting .320 (11-for-29) with four extra-base hits in his last eight games.

HALTON HEATING UP: Outfielder **Sean Halton** has recorded a hit in six of his last seven starts at a .321 clip (9-for-28). He has rapped an extra-base hit in three of his last six games (two doubles, triple).

RED-HOT ROBINZON: Catcher **Robinson Diaz** had the Sounds' longest hitting streak of the season snapped at six games last night. He is batting .286 (8-for-28) in his last seven contests.

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES: The Sounds are batting a league-low .188 with runners in scoring position (22-for-117), including a .161 mark with RISP and two outs. Nashville is just 9-for-61 (.148) with RISP over the past five games.

IT'S A THREE-FOR-ALL: Nashville batters have legged out a triple in three of the last five contests. The Sounds rank 4th in the PCL with five three-baggers this season (Salt Lake leads with nine).

SOUND BYTES: A victory tonight would give Nashville a winning opening homestand ... The Sounds are 1-2 in series finales (1-0 at home, 0-2 on the road) ... Each of the Sounds' six victories have come by three runs or less ... Infielder **Taylor Green** has been plunked by opposing pitchers four times, tied for 2nd-most among PCL batters ... The Sounds' nine home runs are tied for 4th-fewest in the PCL ... Six of Nashville's nine home runs have been solo shots ... The Sounds are just 1-5 this season when the opposition homers ... Outfielder **Jeremy Hermida** has hit safely in each of his last six starts, batting .333 (7-for-21) with three doubles over that span ... Nashville relievers have converted all six of their save opportunities ... The Sounds are one of four PCL clubs to not be involved in a shutout this season (Albuquerque, New Orleans, Tacoma) ... Nashville relievers have stranded 16 of their 21 inherited runners this season.

ON DECK: The Sounds embark upon their second road trip of the year tomorrow when they head to Omaha to face the Storm Chasers (AAA-Royals) for the third time in their first five series. Omaha leads the season series, 4-3. Nashville concludes the trip with a four-game stop in Oklahoma City (AAA-Astros) before returning to Greer Stadium on Monday, April 28 against New Orleans.

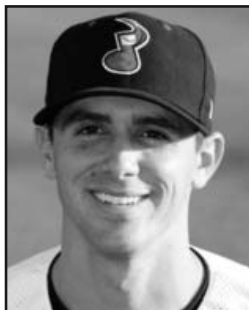

MILLS QUICK HITS: 8th professional season ... Brewers are his 4th organization ... 2011 Pacific Coast League midseason All-Star (starting pitcher in Triple-A All-Star Game) ... In 2011, was voted by PCL managers as having the circuit's best control and best changeup in *Baseball America's* annual best tools survey ... Ranked among Toronto's top 10 prospects by *Baseball America* prior to the 2008 & 2009 seasons ... In 2008, ranked 5th in the minors with a 1.95 ERA ... Graduated with a civil engineering degree from the University of Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned a win on Saturday against Omaha after taking over for injured starter Ariel Pena. Allowed one run in three innings during Nashville's 5-2 victory.

AGAINST THE REDBIRDS: Makes his 4th career start versus Memphis. Is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (5er/17.0ip) in his three previous outings, including a pair of starts last season for Round Rock (1-0, 2.45 ERA, 3er/11.0ip). Also had a losing quality start against the 'Birds for Las Vegas in 2009 (6.0 IP, 2 R, 9 K).
