TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a five-game road series on Wednesday night against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. This marks the second of five series meetings this season against the Blue Wahoos. The South Division foes will meet 23 total times in 2019.

M: The M-Braves dropped three of five to the Blue Wahoos at Trustmark Park, May 6-10. All-time, the M-Braves are 69-73 against the Wahoos and 30-36 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. This is the first season that Pensacola has been a Twins affiliate.

LAST TIME OUT: Pensacola hit five home runs and shut out the M-Braves in Tuesday's series opener, 7-0 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. The five home runs allowed matched a club record that was set on April 15, 2010, vs. West Tenn. LHP **Joey Wentz** gave up three home runs and five total runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts. 3B **Riley Unroe** recorded his second-straight two-hit game, finishing 2-for-3. The M-Braves left nine runners on base and went 1-for-10 with RISP.

THE ATLANTA BRAVES TOP PROSPECT: OF **Cristian Pache** had a season-high four hits on Friday and two more hits on Saturday, his 17th multi-hit game of the season. Pache ranks among the top four in the Southern League in eight different offensive categories. He is 8-for-15 over a current four-game hitting streak with two doubles, two runs and two walks.

NOW THAT'S WHAT I CALL HIGH QUALITY H20: OF **Drew Waters** has recorded seven three-hit games this season and logged his 17th multi-hit game on Saturday night against Jacksonville. Waters leads all of Double-A baseball with 16 doubles and 202 at-bats. Waters has hit in five straight games, going 6-for-20 with six runs scored, two triples, a double, and three RBI.

MULLER NAMED SOUTHERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: LHP **Kyle Muller** made two starts this past week going 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA, giving up just one run on six hits in 12.2 innings, walking four and striking out 17. The back-to-back wins last week continues Muller's dominant month of May so far, going 3-0 with a 0.81 ERA (3 ER/33.1 IP), 11 walks, 33 strikeouts in five starts. Opposing batters are hitting just .186 against the 6'7" lefty. Through 10 starts with the M-Braves this season, Muller is 3-1 with a 1.89 ERA (11 ER/52.1 IP). Muller ranks among the Southern League leaders in ERA (1.89, 6th), strikeouts (57, T-7th), innings pitched (52.1, 8th), and opponents' batting average (.180, 2nd).

DEALING DAVIDSON: LHP **Tucker Davidson** ranks 2nd in the Southern League with a 1.68 ERA through nine starts and is T-3rd inking opponent's batting average at .188. Over his past three starts Davidson has allowed just four earned runs in 18.1 innings with four walks and 15 strikeouts.

THROWING UP THE ZEROES: The M-Braves pitchers have posted seven shutouts this season and have a team-ERA of 3.04, third-best in the Southern League. In May, the M-Braves have 12 quality starts and a 2.55 ERA, 217 strikeouts, 71 walks in 229.2 innings pitched and .219 opponents' batting average.

MADE IN MISSISSIPPI: 22-year-old INF/OF **Austin Riley**, a native of Hernando, MS was promoted to Atlanta on May 15. Riley became the 143rd M-Braves alum since 2005 to make his debut. Riley joins C **Alex Jackson** (4/7/19) and RHP **Jacob Webb** (4/16/19) as MLB debuts this season for alums. Over 75 games with the M-Braves in 2017 and 2018, Riley hit .321 with 19 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 47 RBI and a .391 OPS.

DON'T LET THE NAME FOOL YA: RHP **Jeremy Walker** has made 10 appearances, including one start this season. Over 44.2 IP, Walker has 37 strikeouts and just two walks.

PACHE IS NEW #1 PROSPECT FOR BRAVES: In the May 14 MLB Pipeline ranking update, OF **Cristian Pache** is the new No. 1 prospect for the Braves and No. 17 prospect in their top 100. There are 10 total top 30 prospects on the M-Braves roster: RHP **Ian Anderson** (3, #31 overall), OF **Drew Waters** (6, #66 overall), LHP **Joey Wentz** (11), LHP **Kyle Muller** (12), LHP **Thomas Burrows** (17), LHP **Tucker Davidson** (20), INF C.J. **Alexander** (IL - 21) RHP **Jasseel De La Cruz** (25), and INF **Ray-Patrick Didder** (29).

YOUNG GUNS: The roster contains seven players that are 21-years-old, or younger. OF **Drew Waters** is the youngest (20, 12/30/98), followed by OF **Cristian Pache** (20, 11/19/98), RHP **Ian Anderson** (21, 5/2/98), LHP **Kyle Muller** (21, 10/7/97), LHP **Joey Wentz** (21, 10/6/97), OF **Shean Michel** (21, 9/26/97) and RHP **Jasseel De La Cruz** (21, 6/26/97).

- Atlanta's No. 21 prospect according to MLB.com, Tucker Davidson makes his 10th start of 2019 and second start against the Blue Wahoos in game two of the series on Wednesday night.
- Davidson ranks 2nd in the Southern League with a 1.68 ERA and 3rd in opponents' batting average at .188.

LAST TIME OUT

- Davidson suffered his third loss last Thursday in Mississippi's 5-2 loss against Jacksonville at Trustmark Park. Davidson gave up five runs, but just one earned over 4.2 innings with one walk and five strikeouts. All five runs were scored in the top of the 5th inning.

- Braves' 19th round pick in 2016

- Earned the win in big league spring training on 2/28 at STL pitching a scoreless 7th inning in Atlanta's 4-0 shutout of the Cardinals in Jupiter.
- Enters the 2019 season as the No. 22 prospect in the organization according to MLB.com and No. 21 prospect according to Baseball America.
- Matched a career high with eight strikeouts on May 3 vs. Jacksonville.
- Recorded the best start of his career on Saturday, May 18 at Birmingham, logging a career-high 8.0 innings of shutout baseball with five hits, two walks and four strikeouts.

2018 SEASON

- Spent the full season with High-A Florida, and went 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA (55 ER/118.1 IP) in 24 starts.
- Went 6-6 with a 2.99 ERA over his final 17 starts, after opening the season 1-4 with an 8.04 ERA in his first seven turns.
- Named by the Braves as Florida's Pitcher of the Month for May after a perfect 3-0 record and a 3.22 ERA over four starts.
- Ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta farmhands in wins (T8th, 7) and innings (10th, 118.1 IP). Set a career-high with eight strikeouts against the Daytona Tortugas on July 13.
- Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning of the same game before the bid was broken up by a Tyler Stephenson single.
- Set a career-high with 7.1 scoreless innings against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on 8/19.

- Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome, and went 5-4 with a 2.60 ERA (30 ER/103.2 IP) and 101 strikeouts over 31 games (12 starts).
- His 2.60 ERA tied for the second-best mark among Atlanta's starting pitcher prospects (min. 75.0 IP).
- Logged a 1-2 record and a 2.38 ERA in 19 relief appearances, and a 4-2 mark with a 2.76 ERA in 12 starts.
