**Last Game:** Pensacola Blue Wahoos right-hander Keury Mella pitched seven scoreless innings, and left fielder Brian O'Grady hit an eighth-inning home run for a 1-0 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp before 5,762 saw NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Friday night. In the first game of his rehab assignment in Jacksonville, Miami Marlins shortstop JT Riddle – a 2016 Southern League Postseason All-Star – played seven innings at shortstop and went 1-for-3 with a first-inning single off the right-field wall. Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Pablo Lopez matched Mella (3-0) for the first five innings, scattering four hits and one walk with three strikeouts. Lopez has begun his Double-A career with two scoreless starts for nine combined shutout innings. Pensacola (10-12) came closest to scoring in the top of the third inning, when second baseman Shed Long hit a two-out single and went to second base when the ball got past right fielder John Norwood. Shortstop Luis Gonzalez singled to left field, and Long tried to score but was out on left fielder Austin Dean's throw to catcher Rodrigo Vigil. Long left the game in the bottom of the fourth inning – a switch that brought O'Grady into the game in left field. After Lopez, Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Jorgan Cavanerio (0-1) pitched scoreless sixth and seventh innings, but O'Grady hit the first pitch of the eighth inning to the right-field bleachers, homering for the second straight game against Jacksonville (9-12). Cavanerio allowed four total hits in 2 2/3 innings, walking two batters and striking out five. Right-hander Marcus Crescentini allowed one hit in 1 1/3 scoreless innings. Mella held Jacksonville (9-12) to three hits and no walks with nine strikeouts. Blue Wahoos right-hander Carlos Navas pitched a perfect eighth inning and worked around a ninth-inning, one-out single for his first save.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Riddle Joins Shrimp on MLB Rehab Assignment:** Miami Marlins shortstop JT Riddle joins the Jumbo Shrimp on a transfer of a major league rehab assignment from High-A Jupiter. Yesterday Riddle played seven innings in his first game with the Jumbo Shrimp, going 1-for-3 with a single in his first at-bat. Riddle played in two games for the Hammerheads on Tuesday and Wednesday, going 1-for-6 (.167) with his lone hit being a double Wednesday night against the Palm Beach Cardinals. Riddle started the season on Miami's disabled list with right shoulder tendinitis. Riddle first made it to the majors last season with Miami, hitting .250 with three homers and 31 RBI in 70 games before his season was cut short due to injury. Riddle starred for Jacksonville in 2015 and 2016, and was a 2016 Southern League Postseason All-Star, hitting .278 with three home runs and 51 RBI in 101 games played.

**Dean Southern League Hitter of the Week:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp outfielder Austin Dean has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for April 16-22, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Over the past week in seven games, Dean hit .520 (13-for-25) with two home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles, and six runs scored. Dean in 21 games is hitting .442 (34-for-77), which is the third-best batting average in all of Minor League Baseball entering Saturday's games, and the best batting average in the Southern League and Double-A. He also is second in MiLB lead behind Triple-A Albuquerque's Daniel Castro with 34 hits, Castro has 35. In 21 games played, Dean has hits in 18 of them (one game no official at-bat), with 11 of those games being multi-hit games.

**Shrimp Roster Move:** Right-handed pitcher Brandon Barker has been placed on the voluntarily retired list. Barker pitched in six games and made one start for the Jumbo Shrimp, with no wins or losses and a 10.45 ERA in 10 and a third innings pitched, with 11 strikeouts and 11 walks.

**Poteet Starts Tonight:** Tonight right-hander Cody Poteet starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Blue Wahoos. Poteet earned his first Double-A win in his last starter on Sunday April 22 against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Poteet pitched six innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts, as Jacksonville won 11-5. Overall Poteet is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in his four starts for Jacksonville.

**Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry Resumes:** This is the first of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. The Shrimp will also host the Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds from May 29 to June 2. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, with all games played in Pensacola due to Hurricane Irma. The Wahoos swept the South Division Championship Series 3-0 to earn a share of the Southern League championship with Chattanooga.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp had five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16) (recalled April 19 by the Marlins to Miami), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who began the year on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

**LAST START:** Poteet earned his first Double-A win on Sunday April 22 against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Poteet pitched six innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts, as Jacksonville won 11-5.

**LOOKOUTS START:** Poteet had a no decision in his start on Tuesday April 17 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field. Poteet worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned on solo HRs) on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Poteet left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-1, and the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Lookouts 3-2 on a walk-off homer by Zander Wiel in the bottom of the ninth.

**BAYBEARS START:** Poteet had a no decision (was one out shy of qualifying for a win) in his start on Wednesday April 11 at the Baseball Grounds against the Mobile BayBears. In front of an Opening Night crowd of 6,960 fans, Poteet worked four and two-third innings while allowing two runs (both earned) on three hits with four walks and seven strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-5.

**GENERALS LOSS:** Poteet suffered a loss in his Double-A debut on Thursday April 5 against the Jackson Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. As Jacksonville's Opening Night starter, Poteet worked five and a third innings where he allowed five runs (all earned) on eight hits with two walks and six strikeouts, as well as two home runs allowed.

**PROSPECT BUZZ:** Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

## #20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

**2017 Highlights:** Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

**2016 Highlights:** Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

**College:** Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

**Personal:** Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.
