THIS SERIES -- The Jackson Generals (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks) will face with the Biloxi Shuckers (Milwaukee Brewers) in the best-of-five 2018 Southern League Championship Series. This is Jackson's first berth as an Arizona affiliate, and it's second in the space of three seasons, following their 2016 run to the franchise's second crown.

ABOUT LAST GAME --- BILOXI, Miss. – The Jackson Generals, the Double-A affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks, moved within one game of a championship on Friday with a 12-7 victory over the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. The Generals (2-1) need one more win in the BC Powder @ Southern League Championship Series in order to take down Biloxi (1-2) for the league title.

Entering Friday, Justin Donatella (1-0, 3.00 ERA) had pitched 21.0 consecutive scoreless innings, and he continued his late-year success by tossing six more shutout frames against the South Division champions, holding Biloxi without a run until the seventh inning. Donatella retired 18 men on 98 pitches, departing with two men on base and the Generals ahead 8-0 in his sixth consecutive quality start. The 23-year-old escaped a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the second inning and worked through a two-on, no-outs pickle in the fifth inning, demonstrating pinpoint command to both sides of the plate. When Donatella finally exited, Jared Miller, Bud Jeter, and Sam Lewis came on to lock down the Game 3 win.

Offensively, the Generals sprang for five runs in the third inning, knocking out Biloxi right-hander Thomas Jankins (0-1, 15.00 ERA) after 63 pitches. The inning turned on a three-run blast off the scoreboard by Jackson second baseman Domingo Leyba, his second postseason home run in 2018. First baseman Rudy Flores followed immediately with a solo home run to right-center, launching his first dinger of the playoffs to put Jackson on top 5-0. A four-run eighth inning gave Jackson added breathing room in the late stages of the contest, as Leyba finished 4-for-6 with a quartet of RBI and a run scored, notching his 14th playoff hit in the process. Dominic Miroglio and Galli Cribbs each added two-hit nights for Jackson, as Shelley Duncan and the West Tennessee crew piled up seven or more runs for the fourth time in their last five games.

PITCHING PRIMER -- SATURDAY: Jackson RHP Emilio Vargas did not fare well against Montgomery in his most recent start (3.1 IP, 6 ER, 3 HRA allowed), giving up three dingers in the tumultuous third inning of an eventual 10-7 loss in NDS Game 4. However, Vargas' performance on the road at Double-A overall (2.89 ERA in 19.2 IP) was way better in the regular season than his performance against Montgomery specifically (12 ER in 9.1 IP, 2018 playoffs & reg. season = 11.57 ERA). Biloxi RHP Trey Supak pitched slightly worse at home in the regular season than on the road (3.08 ERA vs. 2.77 ERA), but he's allowed just 4 earned runs in his last 32 IP (1.12 ERA).

POSTSEASON UPDATE -- NOTES ON THE BC POWDER (R) SOUTHERN LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES:

- *Every SL champion over the last 4 years has scored 4+ runs per game in August. Neither Jackson nor Biloxi did that this year.
- >>>JXN has scored 7+ runs in four of their last five games. Biloxi has scored 7+ runs in three of their seven playoff games.
- *3 pitchers in this series ranked in the SL's top 10 in ERA: Zack Brown (2.44), Taylor Widener (2.75), and Justin Donatella (3.46). >>>Only Donatella stayed beneath his regular season ERA in both of his playoff starts.
- *Both teams feature the Minors Pitcher of the Month (August) winners for their systems: Braden Webb (MIL) and Kevin Ginkel (ARI).
- *BLOXI swept the SL Awards: MVP (Corey Ray), Most Outstanding Pitcher (Zack Brown), Manager of the Year (Mike Guerrero).
- *BLOXI led the league in team ERA in the regular season (3.47) and postseason ERA (2.31) entering the LCS.
- *JACKSON led the league in team batting average in the regular season (.262) and hit a league-best .298 in the NDS.
- *JACKSON RHP Justin Donatella recorded his last out in 2018 on 9/14 to stretch his scoreless IP streak to 27.

Dominic Miroglio will be on the taxi squad.
