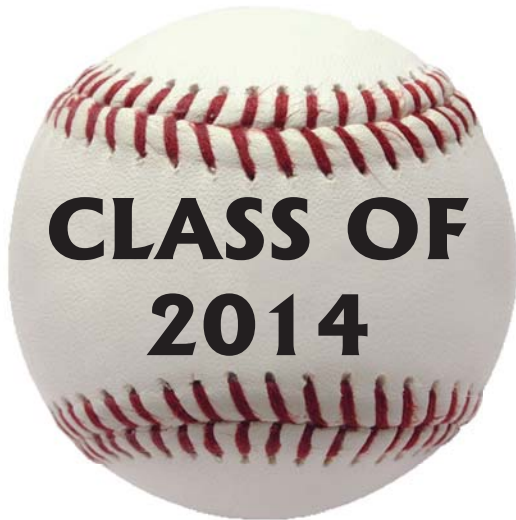


WATT POWELL

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

-  Spent 12 seasons playing Minor League Baseball (1905-1916)
-  Managed the Charleston Senators in 1916 & 1933
-  Instrumental in the construction of 2 ballparks in Charleston
-  Helped build Kanawha Park in 1917 which was destroyed by fire in 1944
-  After the fire, Mr. Powell helped with construction of a new park on the former site of Kanawha Park in 1948
-  This ballpark would become known as "Watt Powell Park" & opened in 1949
-  Baseball would be played there until 2004 & Watt Powell Park hosted the Charleston Teams Senators, Marlins, Indians, Charlies, Wheelers, & Alley Cats
