Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp catcher Sharif Othman hit a ninth-inning, walk-off single to right field for a 4-3 win and series-clinching victory over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in front of 6,470 on National Shrimp Scampi Day, Youth Sports Day and Baptist Health Sunday Family FUNday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. On a rehab assignment in Jacksonville, Miami Marlins right-hander Elieser Hernandez made his Double-A debut, going the first five innings. He struck out four batters and walked one, allowing three hits. The only run against him was Blue Wahoos left fielder Brian O'Grady's first-inning leadoff home run down the right-field line. The Jumbo Shrimp (11-12) overcame the 1-0 deficit in the bottom of the fourth inning against Pensacola right-hander Jesus Reyes. Second baseman Isan Diaz walked, center fielder Monte Harrison reached on a bunt single, and first baseman Eric Jagielo hit a one-out RBI single to right field. After Reyes hit third baseman Brian Schales with a pitch to load the bases, left fielder Kyle Barrett lined a sacrifice fly to left field to make it 2-1. Harrison led off the sixth inning with a home run to the left field berm – his second home run of the season and in the first four games of the series. Reyes lasted seven innings, allowing three earned runs on four hits and one walk with five strikeouts. Jacksonville right-hander Kolton Mahoney pitched scoreless sixth and seventh innings and began the eighth inning with a 3-1 lead. Pensacola third baseman Taylor Sparks hit a leadoff single, and O'Grady tied the game with a one-out, two-run home run to right field. O'Grady has hit four home runs in the series, each one tying a game or giving Pensacola the lead. After Jacksonville right-hander Marcus Crescentini (1-2) pitched a scoreless top of the ninth inning, right fielder John Norwood and Jagielo hit consecutive singles to put runners at first and third bases in the bottom of the inning with no outs against right-hander Robinson Leyer (1-1), whose wild pitch moved Jagielo to second base. An intentional walk to Schales loaded the bases. Left-hander Brennan Bernardino struck out Barrett before Othman's fly-ball single to the right field wall.

NEWS AND NOTES

Norwood Gets On Base: Saturday night's home run hero John Norwood went 2-for-3 at the plate, and continued what is now the longest active consecutive game on-base streak in the Southern League. Norwood dating back to April 9 has reached base safely in his last 18 games entering Sunday's games, hitting .333 in that stretch with three home runs and seven runs batted in, and his on-base percentage in that time is .351. Norwood had been 0-for-3 before he signed in the ninth inning to spark Jacksonville's rally to earn the win. In 22 total games, Norwood has been on base in 21 of them, with the lone exception being his game on Sunday April 8 at Jackson when he went 0-for-4 at the plate. Norwood carries a six-game hitting streak into today's game, and he is 10-for-24 during that stretch that began on April 24.

Harrison Heating Up: Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Monte Harrison is having one of his best stretches of the young 2018 season at the plate. Harrison has homered twice in the last four games for Jacksonville, and Sunday went deep to left field despite a howling wind at the time. Harrison has hit safely in eight of the last nine games for the Jumbo Shrimp, and over his last 10 games is hitting .300 with two home runs and three runs batted in. Harrison is now regarded as Miami's No. 1 prospect according to MLB.com.

Home is Where the Shrimp Win: That's certainly the case in 2018, with the Jumbo Shrimp posting a 6-2 record through the first eight home games of the season. Jacksonville has also won both series played at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville, twice winning three of the first four games of the five-game set. Last year Jacksonville was a rich home field advantage for the Shrimp, with the club posting a 43-27 record at the Baseball Grounds. The second half especially featured a home field advantage for the Shrimp, going 25-10 while losing only one home series in the second half en route to a second half South Division title. The Jumbo Shrimp were also 11-3 in home series last year at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

Duval Day: We know you've been waiting for it. Today Max DUUUUUUVALLLLL starts for the first time at the Baseball Grounds, making his Duval County debut. Duval was scheduled to pitch on Sunday April 15 against the Mobile BayBears at home before the game was postponed due to severe weather on what was interestingly enough his birthday. Duval has relished hearing the DUUUUVALLL chant at Jumbo Shrimp games so far in 2018.

Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry Wraps Up Series One: Today's game wraps up the of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. The Shrimp will also host the Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds from May 29 to June 2. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, with all games played in Pensacola due to Hurricane Irma. The Wahoos swept the South Division Championship Series 3-0 to earn a share of the Southern League championship with Chattanooga. All three games have been decided by one run in the first series between the clubs since their meeting in the 2017 Southern League South Division Championship Series.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp had five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16) (recalled April 19 by the Marlins to Miami), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who began the year on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

LAST START: Duval suffered his second straight loss in his start on Monday April 23 at Tennessee against the Smokies. Duval turned in six innings where he allowed two runs (all earned) on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts. The only runs allowed were on a first inning two-run home run by Jeffrey Baez, and the final five innings for Duval were scoreless, as Jacksonville lost 2-1.

LOOKOUTS LOSS: Duval suffered a loss in his start on Wednesday April 18 in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader at Chattanooga. Duval worked four innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits with a walk, three homers allowed, and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 12-4

GENERALS START: Duval had a no decision in his Double-A debut on Monday April 9 against the Jackson Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. Duval worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Duval also had a single in his first professional at-bat, and had a sacrifice bunt in his first pro plate appearance. Duval left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-1, only to see the Shrimp tie the game in the sixth, and lose in the bottom of the 10th 3-2.

MINOR LEAGUE CAMPING PROJECT: During this past offseason, Duval lived in an RV given to him by his mom to use as a home, he was trying to avoid signing a lease for the offseason. Duval lived in the RV with his friend and trainer Kevin Mixon, with the 29-foot motorhome parked just outside of Salinas, California and near their training facility. #43 MAX DUVAL RHP | 6-5, 235 lbs | Born: April. 15, 1991 in San Luis Obispo, California. 27 years old.

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 28, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League. With Evansville, Duval went 8-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 14 starts, striking out 113 batters in 87 innings of work and he won the 2017 Frontier League Brian Tollberg Award for Most Valuable Pitcher, and he was also a Frontier League All-Star. After he signed with the Marlins on July 28, he went 4-0 with a 2.09 ERA in six starts for the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. Came within two outs of a seven inning perfect game on August 9, 2017. He retired the first 19 batters he faced before ultimately allowing a run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a complete game win.

2016 Highlights: Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League, where he was 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA in seven starts. Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on June 23, 2016. Pitched at four different levels of the Diamondbacks organization, making one relief outing with High-A Visalia where he was 1-0 with a 9.64 ERA, going 2-6 with a 3.02 ERA in 10 starts for the Single-A Kane County Cougars, then with Short Season Class A Hillsboro had no wins or losses and a 7.36 ERA in two appearances and one start, then also two appearances and a start for the AZL Diamondbacks, going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in two appearances and one start. All of his moving around different affiliates mainly happened in a 14-day span in late June and early July.

2015 Highlights: Split the season pitching in the Frontier League, making four appearances with the Schaumburg Boomers where he had no wins or losses and a 13.50 ERA. He also pitched for the Frontier Greys, where he was 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts. The Greys were a team that played strictly road games in the Frontier League, hence the name Greys after the traditional road jersey color.

2014 Highlights: Duval made his professional baseball debut pitching for the Schaumburg Boomers in the independent Frontier League, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA in three relief outings.

College: Started college career at Cuesta College before transferring to Hawaii for his junior season. At Hawaii in 2012 he hit .186 with one home run and 18 RBI as an infielder. At the plate in 2013, Duval hit .192 with no homers and 3 RBI. He also pitched that season, with no wins or losses and a 6.48 ERA in six games in relief. After college considered quitting baseball but mom encouraged him to keep playing, which landed him in independent baseball to give pitching a real chance.
