Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (5-7) fell to the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (9-3) by a 7-4 score in the second game of the five-game series at Blue Wahoos Stadium on Tuesday night. Miami Marlins shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria, in the first game of his major league rehab assignment with the Jumbo Shrimp, went 1-for-4 with a run scored, and singled in his final at-bat of the night in the seventh inning. A bases-loaded walk to Brian O'Grady from Jumbo Shrimp reliever Tyler Kinley broke a 4-4 tie with two outs in the bottom of the eighth, before the Blue Wahoos added two more runs in the inning to get the three-run victory. After rallying to tie the game with a four-run sixth inning, Jacksonville left eight men on base in the final four innings of the game. Wahoos reliever Geoff Broussard (1-0) earned the win by getting the final out in the top of the eighth inning, as Jacksonville stranded the bases loaded in that inning. Jumbo Shrimp reliever Tyler Bremer (0-1) took the loss, as he left the game with injury in the eighth and Kinley allowed the inherited runners to score. Jimmy Herget worked the ninth inning in scoreless fashion to get his Southern League-best sixth save of the young season. After a scoreless first, the Wahoos scored a pair of runs in the bottom of the second. First Aristides Aquino delivered an RBI single, before their starting pitcher Luis Castillo had a sacrifice fly to score Aquino to put Pensacola ahead 2-0. An inning later in the bottom of the third, Aquino hit his second RBI single, making it 3-0 Pensacola. Wahoos center fielder Brian O'Grady homered in the second straight night, as he had a one-out solo homer in the bottom of the fourth to grow the lead to 4-0. After Castillo worked the first five innings in scoreless fashion, he ran into trouble in the sixth. Adeiny Hechavarria reached on a fielding error by the shortstop Blake Trahern to start the inning, and then Brian Anderson followed with an RBI double to cut Pensacola's lead to 4-1. John Norwood would follow with a two-run homer to make it a 4-3 ballgame, and end Castillo's time on the mound. Jacksonville tied the game on a pinch-hit RBI single by Alex Yarbrough to make it a 4-4 game. The game remained tied until the bottom of the eighth. Pensacola pinch-hitter Leon Landry hit a line drive off Bremer on the mound to load the bases. After Bremer was taken out due to injury, Kinley walked O'Grady to give Pensacola a 5-4 lead. Josh VanMeter followed with a two-run single to left to put Pensacola's lead at 7-4, which would be the final.

NEWS AND NOTES

Hechavarria with Jumbo Shrimp: Miami Marlins shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria is with the Jumbo Shrimp on a major league rehab assignment. Hechavarria started for the Jumbo Shrimp last night, going 1-for-4 with a single in his last at-bat in the seventh inning. Hechavarria (Etch-a-va-ree-a) has been on the Marlins disabled list since April 9 with a left oblique strain. Hechavarria started his rehab assignment with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads last night in Lakeland, where he was 0-for-3 with a strikeout at the plate. With the Marlins in five big league games this season, Hechavarria is hitting .200 (4-for-20) with no homers and one RBI. Hechavarria is a six-year major league veteran, and is a career .258 hitter in the big leagues with 14 home runs and 178 RBI. Hechavarria came up through the minor leagues with the Toronto Blue Jays, and made his big league debut by playing in 41 games for the Blue Jays in 2012. That offseason he was traded from the Blue Jays to the Marlins with RHP Henderson Alvarez, RHP Anthony DeSclafani, INF Yunel Escobar, C Jeff Mathis, OF Jake Marisnick and LHP Justin Nicolino from Toronto in exchange for OF Emilio Bonifacio, C John Buck, LHP Mark Buehrle, RHP Josh Johnson, INF Jose Reyes and cash on November 19, 2012. Hechavarria has been Miami's everyday shortstop since 2013, and is regarded as one of the best defensive shortstops in the National League. Last season for the Marlins he hit .236 with three home runs and 38 RBI over 155 games. Hechavarria, 28, is a native of Santiago de Cuba, Cuba

Vidal Returns to Pensacola: Jacksonville second baseman David Vidal is making a homecoming of sorts this week in Pensacola. Vidal played for the Blue Wahoos in parts of the 2012 and 2013 seasons. In 2012 after starting the season at High-A Bakersfield, Vidal played in 97 games for the Blue Wahoos in their inaugural season, hitting .230 with 11 home runs and 39 runs batted in. In 2013 Vidal played in 46 games for the Blue Wahoos, hitting .206 with a home run and nine runs batted in. Counting his time in Jacksonville to start the season, Vidal is a career .229 hitter in the Southern League with 12 home runs and 50 runs batted in during 154 games. Vidal shined at the plate Monday for the Jumbo Shrimp, collecting two of Jacksonville's three hits. He also drove in Jacksonville's lone run in the top of the first on an RBI single, as the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Blue Wahoos 3-1 in the opening game of the series. Vidal also had a big performance Tuesday going 2-for-5 with a run scored, as he had his sixth multi-hit game of the season.

Gonzalez Joins Jumbo Shrimp: Right-handed pitcher Severino Gonzalez, a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, has had a transfer of option from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Gonzalez has been a member of the Baby Cakes pitching staff all season, going 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA in three appearances and two starts. Gonzalez was acquired by the Marlins from the Philadelphia Phillies on January 24, 2017 in a trade for a player to be named later. Gonzalez has pitched for the Phillies in the big leagues in parts of the last two seasons, and in his MLB career he is 4-5 with a 6.68 ERA in 34 appearances and seven starts. Gonzalez, 24, is a native of Santiago, Panama.

Record Attendance in Jacksonville: With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

LAST START: Bencomo won in his first start in Jacksonville in 2017 on Friday April 14 over the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo worked six scoreless innings where he only allowed four hits with a walk and six strikeouts in a game that the Jumbo Shrimp won 4-0.

BRAVES WIN: Bencomo won his 2017 and Marlins organization debut with a victory on Saturday April 8 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Bencomo turned in five scoreless innings where he allowed three hits on a walk and four strikeouts in a game the Jumbo Shrimp won 6-1.

2016 with CHATTANOOGA: Bencomo began the 2017 season in the Southern League with the Chattanooga Lookouts, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Bencomo went 4-6 with a 3.86 ERA in 19 appearances and seven starts. That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds.

2016 with ROCHESTER: Bencomo closed out 2016 with the Rochester Red Wings in the Triple-A International League. With the Red Wings he was 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

VENEZUELAN WINTER LEAGUE: Following the 2016 season, Bencomo pitched in the Venezuelan Winter League for Bravos de Margarita from October to November. There he was 4-3 with a 4.21 ERA in his 14 starts, with 48 strikeouts in his 68 and a third innings of work.

INDEPENDENT BASEBALL TIME: Following time in the Tampa Bay Rays system from 2007-2011, Bencomo did not pitch professionally in the United States from 2012-14. In 2015 he pitched for the Wichita Wignuts and the Laredo Lemurs in the independent American Association. With Laredo he went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA in four starts while with Wichita he was 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA in his nine starts for the Wignuts. He was later signed that season by the Minnesota Twins and closed out the year at High-A Fort Myers.

Bencomo closed out 2016 with the Rochester Red Wings in the Triple-A International League. With the Red Wings he was 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

2015 Highlights: Following time in the Tampa Bay Rays system from 2007-2011, Bencomo did not pitch professionally in the United States from 2012-14. In 2015 he pitched for the Wichita Wignuts and the Laredo Lemurs in the independent American Association.
