**Last Game:** The Mississippi Braves first baseman Carlos Franco hit a fifth-inning grand slam among three hits to lift the visitors to a 6-4 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 6,071 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville on Mavericks Live and Budweiser Thirsty Thursday night. Opening a 10-game homestand, the Jumbo Shrimp (15-26) took the lead in the first inning. Shortstop Alex Yarbrough reached on an error by second baseman Travis Demeritte and later scored on third baseman Brian Anderson's RBI fielder's choice. Jacksonville loaded the bases against right-hander Mike Soroka (4-3) before first baseman Cal Toweey lined out. In the third inning, Anderson walked, right fielder John Norwood singled, and left fielder Alex Glenn drove a two-run triple into right-center field for a 3-0 Jumbo Shrimp lead. In the fourth inning, second baseman David Vidal hit his third home run of the season out of the Baseball Grounds to left field to make it 4-0. Jacksonville right-hander Joe Gunkel kept the lead until the fifth inning. With one out, right fielder Connor Lien reached on Anderson's throwing error. After Soroka's sacrifice, third baseman Luis Valenzuela hit an RBI double to right field. After consecutive walks to load the bases, left-hander James Buckelew (0-3) entered, and Franco drove his Southern League-leading 11th home run to the right-field bleachers, giving Mississippi (22-19) a 5-4 lead. Soroka pitched a scoreless fifth inning, before right-handers Jason Hursh and Bradley Roney each worked two scoreless innings out of the Braves bullpen. Mississippi got an insurance run from shortstop Dylan Moore's ninth-inning solo home run off Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Tyler Higgins.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Locke Joins Jumbo Shrimp on Rehab Assignment:** Miami Marlins left-handed pitcher Jeff Locke has had his major league rehab assignment transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville, and will start for the Jumbo Shrimp tonight against the M-Braves. Locke is recovering from left biceps tendinitis that first affected him early in Spring Training, and he hasn't pitched for the Marlins in a major league game in 2017. Locke made two rehab starts for the Hammerheads, where he had no wins or losses and an ERA of 1.00 in his nine innings of work. In his first start on May 8, Locke worked four scoreless innings against Bradenton where he allowed two hits with no walks and three strikeouts. In his last start on Saturday May 13, Locke pitched five innings against St. Lucie, where he gave up a run on five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. Locke is in his first season in the Marlins organization, signing with Miami as a free agent on Dec. 16, 2016. Locke is a six-year major league veteran, with all of his previous work in the major leagues with the Pittsburgh Pirates from 2011 to 2016. Locke in his major league career is 35-38 with a 4.41 ERA in his 123 appearances and 110 games started. Last season, Locke spent the full year in Pittsburgh, with a 9-8 record and a 5.44 ERA. In 2013 Locke was a National League All-Star, however did not pitch due to lower back tightness in the 2013 All-Star Game at Citi Field in New York. Locke was originally selected by the Atlanta Braves in the second round of the 2006 draft from A. Crosby Kennett HS in Conway, N.H. He was traded by the Braves to the Pirates on June 3, 2009 with Charlie Morton and Gorkys Hernandez in exchange for Nate McLouth. Locke is the second Marlin to join the Jumbo Shrimp on a rehab assignment this season, with shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria playing for Jacksonville in Pensacola on April 18.

**Welcome M-Braves:** Tonight marks the second series of the season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the M-Braves. The clubs started the 2017 season facing each other at Trustmark Park in Pearl, Mississippi, with the M-Braves winning 3 of 5 games. Mississippi is currently tied for second in the Southern League South Division standings, one game back of Pensacola. The Shrimp and Braves will next face each other from July 25-29, and the M-Braves return to Jacksonville from August 10-14.

**JEFF LOCKE LHP | 6-0, 191 lbs | Born: North Conway, N.H. Nov. 20, 1987. Age: 29**

**2017 Highlights:** Spent full season in Majors for third time in career, going 9-8 with a 5.44 ERA (127.1 ip/77 er) in 30 appearances (19 starts). First 17 appearances were starts; posted 8-5, 5.38 marks in that time. Four of 15 appearances after July 1 were starts; went 1-2, 9.92 (16.1/18) in starts, and 1-1, 3.38 in relief. Between May 19 and July 1, factored in decision in all nine starts, going 7-2, 4.92 (56.2/31). That span included season-long four-game winning streak from May 19-June 4. On May 30 at Miami, set new career high with 9.0 innings pitched in 10-0 win (3 h, so); was first career complete game and shutout. Posted 5-2, 3.63 record in 15 games (eight starts) at home, and 4-6, 7.16 mark in 15 games (11 starts) on road. Overall, went 8-7, 5.86 (106.0/69) as starter and 1-1, 3.38 as reliever (21.0/8).

**MAJOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS:** Set career highs in innings pitched and strikeouts in **2015**, and tied career high in starts. Recorded his first career extra-base hit (double) and RBI on April 10 at Milwaukee. Tied career high with 8.0 inning and retired 23 of last 25 batters faced while winning second start on April 18 vs. Milwaukee. Retired last 19 batters faced while giving up just two hits in 8.0 innings of 1-0 victory vs. Cleveland on July 4. Charged with two earned runs or less in six straight starts from June 12 to July 9 and posted 1.59 ERA (34.0 ip/6 er) in that time. Had an RBI-single while losing a 6-1 decision on July 19 at Milwaukee. In 10 starts in June & July, posted 3-3 record with 3.12 ERA (57.2/20). Began **2014** season on 15-day disabled list with a right oblique strain. Made rehab start with High-A Bradenton on April 9 and struck out 10 batters. Was reinstated from DL and optioned to Triple-A Indianapolis on April 10. Went 0-1, 5.68 ERA (19.0/12) in four Triple-A starts before being recalled by Pittsburgh on May 5. Optioned back to Indianapolis on May 6 and went 3-0, 2.57 ERA (28.0/8) in five starts during May. Recalled by Pittsburgh on June 8 and made start that afternoon vs. Milwaukee; gave up three hits and just one run in 7.0 innings but lost a 1-0 decision. Pitched career-high 8.0 innings (2 r) in a no-decision on June 13 at Miami. Won first decision with Pirates on June 24 at Tampa (7.1 ip/3 er). Tied career high with 8.0 innings pitched on July 1 vs. Arizona. Pitched 8.0 innings for a third time while winning a 6-2 decision over Phillies on July 6. Won four straight decisions from August 6-27 and went 4-0, 2.90 (31.0/10) in five starts during August. Pitched 7.1 innings and gave up just one run to earn win on Aug. 27 vs. St. Louis; also went 2x3 for first career multi-hit game. Optioned to Indianapolis on Aug. 30, but was recalled on September 2. Tied career high (second time) with nine strikeouts while winning seventh and final decision on Sept. 8 at Philadelphia (7.0 ip/1er). Named to the National League All-Star team in **2013**, first full season in the Majors; did not pitch in ASG due lower back tightness. Posted 2.15 ERA (83.2/20) in 14 road starts; second-best road ERA in NL behind Clayton Kershaw (2.14). Posted 2.15 ERA (83.2/20) in 14 road starts; second-best road ERA in NL behind Clayton Kershaw (2.14). Shared team lead in starts and ranked second on staff in innings pitched. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings and extended scoreless innings streak to 13.0 frames with his third win, on April 28 at St. Louis. Had scoreless innings streak snapped at 15.0 after giving up three runs in 5.0 ip on May 4 vs. Washington. Pitched career-high 21.1 consecutive scoreless innings from May 14-June 4; was 2-0, 1.80 (30.0/6) in five starts during streak. Walked career-high seven batters, but held the Cubs to one hit in 5.2 ip in no-decision on June 9. Won seventh-straight decision on June 25 at Seattle; first Pittsburgh lefty to win seven in a row since John Smiley in 1991. Pitched 23.1 consecutive scoreless innings at PNC Park from May 14 to July 3; longest scoreless streak at home for a Pittsburgh starting pitcher since Jerry Reuss (34.0) in 1975. Won eighth-straight game on July 3 vs. Philadelphia while also setting Club record for most consecutive starts (16) in a season without losing a game (previous mark of 15 was set by Dock Ellis in 1971). Career-long winning streak lasted eight decisions from April 13 to July 3; was second-longest streak in the NL in 2013 and most by a Pittsburgh lefthander since John Candelaria won eight straight in 1983. Streak ended on July 8 at PNC Park in 2-1 loss to Oakland (3 h, 2 r). Missed last scheduled start prior to All-Star break on July 12 due to lower back tightness. Attended All-Star festivities at Citi Field in New York, but was inactive for ASG. Struck out career-high nine batters on July 26 at Miami, but lost a 2-0 decision. Surrendered four runs in 4.0 ip in a no-decision vs. St. Louis on July 30, snapping streak of 17 straight tarts with three earned runs or fewer. Optioned to Double-A Altoona on Aug. 28, but did not appear in any games. Gave up one run in 7.0 ip and posted 10th victory, a career-high, on Sept. 12 vs. Chicago. Went 8-2, 2.15 (109.0/26) in 18 starts prior to All-Star break and 2-5, 6.12 (57.1/39) in 12 starts after break. Made **2012** debut with Pirates on August 9 and retired all seven Arizona batters faced while making first Major League relief appearance. Suffered 5-1 loss in first start with Pirates on Sept. 3 vs. Houston (5.0 ip, 5 er). Went 0-3 with a 7.50 ERA (24.0/20) and gave up six home runs in his first five starts with Pittsburgh. Won first Major League game while making final start on October 1 vs. Atlanta. Went 1-3 with a 6.30 ERA in six starts with Pittsburgh. Singled off Chris Rusin for first big league hit on Sept. 9 vs. Chicago-NL. Made Major League debut in 2011; recalled by Pittsburgh on Sept. 4 and started and lost big league debut (5.0 ip/3 r) on Sept. 10 vs. Florida.
