SNAPPER SNIPPETS

1 IS THE LONELIEST NUMBER: After nearly being no-hit by **Mike O'Reilly** in May, he clamped down on the Snappers again with a 1-0 shutout. Out of the 7 total times the Snappers have been held off the scoreboard, 4 of those happenings have been 1-0 ballgames. The Snappers have not had a more lopsided shutout score of greater than a 4-0 defeat.

CLOSE GAMES: The Snappers have played 54 games this year decided by 3 runs or fewer & they are 26-28 in those contests. Last night's 1-0 loss in Peoria was the 29th one-run game for the Snappers, tied with Kane County for the most in the Midwest League.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: Beloit's offense has played their last 6 games without reaching the 5-run mark. The Snappers are 27-6 this season when they score at least 5 runs in a game. Their longest stretch this season without getting a handful was 9 games at the end of the First Half & the first game of the new half. When both the Snappers & their opponent score 5 runs, Beloit is 9-6.

CLEAN DEFENSE: The Snappers have now played 4 consecutive games without committing an error, their longest string of error-less baseball this season. They previously had gone back-to-back games just 4 times this year. Wednesday's contest was the 8th game of the Second Half that the Snappers have played without an error.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: **Mike Martin** nearly produced a run all on his own in the first inning on Wednesday when he led off the game with a single & swiped 2nd & 3rd base. Martin has stolen 2 bases in each of his last 2 games & now leads the Athletics minor league system with 12 this year (3 with Short-A Vermont). He now owns 5 career games with 2 stolen bases & 3 of them occurring this season.

PERSICO KEEPS PRODUCING: After driving in his 9th RBI of the Second Half on Tuesday, **Luke Persico's** team-leading 44 RBI are 10th in the Midwest League. Persico has had at least one RBI in his last 4 games at Dozer Park.

SLASHIN' SHELBY: Despite an 0-for-2 night at the plate, **JaVon Shelby** did walk last night. Shelby is now slashing .333/.434/.578 against Peoria, leading the team in all 3 categories along with 3 homers.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Thursday night will be the Midwest League road debut for **Miguel Romero** on the mound. The Cuban signing by the A's in February has progressed upward through the system over the last month. He will be back up by **Seth Martinez**, who threw a career-high 6 innings out of the bullpen on July 1 behind Romero's first start. Martinez has struck out 15 hitters over his last 11 innings of work with Beloit.

FACING THE CHIEFS: Beloit & Peoria have had 9 of their 13 meetings this season separated by 3 runs or fewer including 6 one-run games. These 2 squads will wrap up 11 consecutive games at Dozer Park on Thursday before returning the series to the Stalene next month. Peoria has now out-homered the Snappers 11-10 with 9 different Chiefs going deep. Peoria carries 4 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects with pitchers **Jordan Hicks** (#18) & **Ronnie Williams** (#24) in addition to hitters **Dylan Carlson** (#16) & **Nick Plummer** (#22).
