**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (5-10) fell to the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (12-3) by a 2-0 score in the fifth game of the five-game series at Blue Wahoos Stadium on Friday night. After the game was scoreless through the first seven innings, the Wahoos scored a pair of runs in the eighth to complete their sweep of Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have now lost seven games in a row, while Pensacola has won seven straight. Jacksonville reliever Tyler Higgins (0-2) took the loss, allowing the two runs in the eighth inning. Wahoos reliever Ariel Hernandez (1-0) worked a scoreless eighth to get the win, while Pensacola reliever Jimmy Herget worked a scoreless ninth to earn his Southern League-best seventh save of the season. Jacksonville's starting pitcher Chris Mazza turned in his second consecutive scoreless start, working seven scoreless innings where he only allowed three hits with a walk and six strikeouts. Wahoos starter Austin Ross also went seven scoreless innings where he gave up three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts. Higgins took over on the mound in the eighth with the game scoreless. After a walk to Leon Landry, a throwing error by Jacksonville third baseman Brian Anderson put two men in scoring position with no one out. Blake Trahan followed with a sacrifice fly to left to score Landry to give Pensacola a 1-0 lead. Later in the at-bat of Josh VanMeter, Higgins threw a wild pitch that scored Joe Hudson from third base to put the score at 2-0, which would be the final.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Vidal Returns to Pensacola and Plays Well:** Jacksonville second baseman David Vidal is making a homecoming of sorts this week in Pensacola. Vidal played for the Blue Wahoos in parts of the 2012 and 2013 seasons. In 2012 after starting the season at High-A Bakersfield, Vidal played in 97 games for the Blue Wahoos in their inaugural season, hitting .230 with 11 home runs and 39 runs batted in. In 2013 Vidal played in 46 games for the Blue Wahoos, hitting .206 with a home run and nine runs batted in. Counting his time in Jacksonville to start the season, Vidal is a career .229 hitter in the Southern League with 12 home runs and 50 runs batted in during 154 games. Vidal shined at the plate Monday for the Jumbo Shrimp, collecting two of Jacksonville's three hits. He also drove in Jacksonville's lone run in the top of the first on an RBI single, as the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Blue Wahoos 3-1 in the opening game of the series. Vidal also had a big performance Tuesday going 2-for-5 with a run scored, as he had his sixth multi-hit game of the season. Vidal went 1-for-4 on Wednesday, driving in the go-ahead run with an RBI single in the eighth inning. Vidal's homecoming hit a high note on Thursday, going 2-for-3 with his first home run of the season, and he also had an RBI double to total a pair of runs batted in on the night. Vidal went 1-for-3 in Friday's game to continue his hitting streak to seven games. Vidal is currently in the midst of a seven-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team, and tied for the longest for any Jumbo Shrimp batter this season.

**Galloway Returns:** Outfielder Isaac Galloway has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Galloway has played in 13 games for the Baby Cakes, and he is hitting .172 with two home runs and six runs batted in to begin the season. Galloway has played in Jacksonville in parts of the 2013, 2014, and 2015 seasons, and was Jacksonville's starting center fielder when the club won the 2014 Southern League championship.

**Record Attendance in Jacksonville:** With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

**Gonzalez Starts for Shrimp:** Tonight marks the first start for Severino Gonzalez in a Jumbo Shrimp uniform. Gonzalez is a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, and started the season at New Orleans where he was 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA in three appearances and two starts. Gonzalez was acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for a player to be named later on January 24, 2017.

**TONIGHT – FIRST SHRIMP START:** Tonight marks the first start for Severino Gonzalez in a Jumbo Shrimp uniform. Gonzalez is a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, and started the season at New Orleans where he was 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA in three appearances and two starts. Gonzalez was acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for a player to be named later on January 24, 2017.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Gonzalez worked an inning of relief for Jacksonville on Wednesday, allowing a run on one hit against the Blue Wahoos in Pensacola.

**2017 with NEW ORLEANS:** Gonzalez began the season in the starting rotation for Triple-A New Orleans. Gonzalez there was 0-2 with a 9.35 ERA, allowing nine earned runs in his eight and two-thirds innings of work. Gonzalez lost his first two starts to Memphis on April 7 and at Iowa on April 12, with his I-Cubs start being his toughest outing. In that game he worked three and a third innings allowing 10 runs (9 earned) on 10 hits with two walks and two strikeouts. Gonzalez then turned in a scoreless relief outing on April 16 at Omaha, working just a third of an inning.

**BIG LEAGUE TIME with PHILLIES:** Gonzalez pitched in parts of the last two seasons in the majors with the Philadelphia Phillies. In 2015 he made seven starts, going 3-3 with a 7.92 ERA. In 2016 he worked exclusively out of the bullpen, going 1-2 with a 5.60 ERA. As a major league pitcher, Gonzalez is 4-5 with a 6.68 ERA in 34 appearances and seven starts.

**#29 SEVERINO GONZALEZ RHP | 6-2, 155 lbs | Born: September 28, 1992 in Santiago de Veragua, Panama Age: 24**

Acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Philadelphia Phillies on Jan. 24, 2017 for a player to be named later.

**2016 Highlights:** Combined a 3-3 record and a 4.09 ERA in 48 appearances between Double-A Reading, Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and Philadelphia. With Double-A Reading he was 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA in six relief outings. With Triple-A Lehigh Valley, he was 0-1 with a 3.31 ERA in 15 appearances and one start. With the Phillies he worked exclusively out of the bullpen, going 1-2 with a 5.60 ERA in 27 appearances.

**2015 Highlights:** With Triple-A Lehigh Valley he was 2-7 with a 5.11 ERA in 16 starts in 2015. With the Phillies in the majors he was 3-3 with a 7.92 ERA in seven starts, making his MLB debut on April 28 at St. Louis. On that day, combined with Carlos Ruiz to form first Panamanian-born battery to start a game in Major League history. At 22 years and 212 days, was youngest Phillies starter to make debut since Scott Mathieson in 2007 (22 years, 110 days).

**2014 Highlights:** Led Phillies Minor League system in starts (27) and innings pitched (158.2) in 2014 with Double-A Reading. Tied for Eastern League lead in starts, ranked second in inning and fourth in strikeouts (115).

**2013 Highlights:** Recipient of Paul Owens Award as best pitcher in Phillies Minor League system in 2013, posting combined 7-5 record and 2.00

ERA (103.2/23) in 25 appearances (14 starts) between Single-A Clearwater, Single-A Lakewood and Reading. Named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Week for July 1-7 after going 2-0 with 3.18 ERA. Appeared for La Guaira in Venezuelan Winter League following season.

**2012 Highlights:** In second season with Venezuelan Summer League Phillies in 2012, led VSL in ERA (1.65), strikeouts (86) and complete games (2),

while tying for lead in starts (14). Also ranked tied for third in wins (7).

**2011 Highlights:** Began professional career with VSL Phillies after signing with Phillies in 2011, going 1-1 with 2.11 ERA (42.2/10) in 17 appearances.
