Giants Conclude Series In Modesto... The San Jose Giants play the rubber game of their three-game series against the Modesto Nuts this evening at John Thurman Field. Modesto earned a 12-1 victory in the series opener on Tuesday before the Giants bounced back with a 4-1 win yesterday. Logan Webb (1-2, 2.08 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for San Jose tonight.

Road Warriors... The Giants are in the midst of a season-high nine-game road trip (3-2 record thus far). San Jose opened the trip last weekend by taking two out of three in Stockton before splitting the first two games of the current series against Modesto. The Giants are 8-4 in their last 12 road games overall. San Jose next travels to Lake Elsinore for a three-game series beginning tomorrow night.

In Search Of Fourth Straight Road Series Win... A victory tonight would give the Giants their fourth consecutive road series win. San Jose won two out of three at Lancaster from May 4-6, won two out of three at Modesto from May 8-10 and then won two out of three games in Stockton to open the current road trip. The Giants haven't won four straight road series' since they claimed seven consecutive road series' to open the 2013 season.

By-The-Numbers... Through the first five games of the current road trip, the Giants are batting .225 as a team and averaging just 2.8 runs per contest. San Jose is hitting only .150 (6-for-40) with runners in scoring position. On the mound, the Giants own a team ERA of 2.82 (14 ER/44.2 IP) during the road trip. 12 out of the 18 runs allowed by San Jose on the trip came in Tuesday's loss to Modesto.

First Half Race... The Giants (26-20) are one game behind first-place Stockton (27-19) in the first half North Division race. 24 games remain in the half. San Jose was most recently in first place on May 13. The Giants haven't held sole possession of the top spot since April 26. San Jose has seven games remaining against the Ports this half. The Giants last won a first half title in 2013.

Familiar Foe... This series marks the Giants' third trip to Modesto already this season. San Jose is 8-7 against the Nuts overall in 2018 (4-3 at Municipal Stadium, 4-4 at John Thurman Field). The Giants will play 22 games versus Modesto in the first half (all in a 49-game span from April 19-June 10).

Miller Hit Streak At Nine Games... Jalen Miller brings a nine-game hitting streak into tonight's action. Miller is batting at a .368 clip (14-for-38) during the hit streak with five doubles and five RBI's. It matches the second-longest hit streak by a Giants player this season (Matt Winn - 16 games). Miller is hitting .303 overall this year after batting just .227 in 117 games with the Giants last season.

Pitching And Defense... The Giants are second in the California League with a team ERA of 3.51 (Visalia leads at 3.14). San Jose has allowed the fewest home runs in the league (19) while they're tied for second with five shutouts. The Giants have issued the most walks of any staff in the league this year (187, 4.1 per game). Additionally, San Jose has committed a league-high tying 60 errors through their first 46 games.

Holding Leads / Late Comebacks... The Giants are a perfect 19-0 this season when leading after seven innings. Only San Jose and Lake Elsinore are unbeaten this year when holding a lead after the seventh. Conversely, the Giants have won a league-high four games this season when trailing after seven innings.

* Is in his fifth professional season ... Selected by the San Francisco Giants in the fourth round of the 2014 draft (118th overall pick).

* Scheduled to make his ninth start and tenth overall appearance of the season in this evening's game ... Has pitched 26 innings this year and allowed just six earned runs (2.08 ERA) ... Walked 14 and struck out 24 ... Has yet to pitch more than four innings in an outing ... Has pitched past the third inning only once in eight starts.

* Has not allowed an earned run in six out of his eight starts.

* Most recent start came on May 18 at Stockton ... Pitched three scoreless innings with two hits allowed, two walks and three strikeouts ... Fired three hitless innings with a season-high four strikeouts in his previous start on May 13 against Lancaster.

* Will be making his fourth start against Modesto ... Is 0-1 with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP) and a .359 opponents batting average versus the Nuts ... Last faced Modesto on May 8 at John Thurman Field ... Gave up a season-high four runs (all earned) on eight hits over three innings.

* Owns a .242 opponents batting average (.222 vs. left, .259 vs. right) ... Has limited the opposition to a .125 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs (2-for-16) ... Has yet to give up a home run this season.

* Prior to this season, hasn't made a start since May 31, 2016 (with Class-A Augusta).

* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching out of the bullpen for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Made 15 relief appearances for the Volcanoes and was 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA ... Struck out 31 and walked seven over 28 innings.

* Had a 2.47-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio last season – the highest groundout rate on the Salem-Keizer staff ... Limited right-handed hitters to a .174 batting average (12-for-69, 26 SO) compared to a .359 batting average against left-handed hitters (14-for-39).

* Made his 2017 season debut on June 15 – over 12 months since his last game action.

* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2016 before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his right elbow in June ... Was 2-3 with a 6.21 ERA in nine starts for the GreenJackets.

* Worked as a starting pitcher for Salem-Keizer in 2015 (14 GS, 3-6, 4.92 ERA) ... Began his professional career with the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2014.

* Drafted by the SF Giants out of Rocklin High School (Rocklin, CA) ... Posted a 0.49 ERA over 57 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 to earn Sierra Foothill League MVP honors ... Was also a quarterback on the football team in three varsity seasons.

* Had committed to play college baseball at Cal Poly prior to signing with the Giants.

#54 Sandro Fabian (.227, 3 HR, 16 RBI, 0 SB)

- * Outfielder is in his fourth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2014.
- * Currently ranked the #6 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com*. Rated the #9 prospect by *Baseball America*.
