Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Trevor Richards struck out seven batters in five innings, but Birmingham Barons right-hander Michael Kopech struck out 11 batters in seven innings of a 2-1 Barons win over the Jumbo Shrimp in front of 7,231 on Saturday of Superhero Weekend at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Following ceremonial first pitches that included one by former Jacksonville Jaguars quarterback Mark Brunell as the American Civility Association 2017 Kindness Hero of the Year, Richards (3-4) kept a scoreless start until the top of the second inning. Barons left fielder Courtney Hawkins doubled to right field, and third baseman Trey Michalczewski hit a two-run home run to center field, giving Birmingham (18-24 second half, 44-67 overall) a 2-0 lead. Kopech (8-7) retired the first eight Jacksonville batters, before left fielder Kyle Barrett singled to right field with two outs in the third inning. A wild pitch, walk to center fielder Braxton Lee and right fielder Austin Dean's infield single loaded the bases. But third baseman David Vidal lined to second baseman Toby Thomas to end the threat. In the top of the fourth inning, Richards allowed baserunners on a wild-pitch strikeout and single before two strikeouts, an intentional walk, and his fourth strikeout of the inning – one shy of the 53-year-old Southern League record. He pitched one more inning before right-hander Tyler Higgins went three shutout innings and right-hander Clayton Mortensen pitched one. Jacksonville (20-22, 50-62) scored in the fifth inning, as catcher Rodrigo Vigil hit a leadoff single, went to second base on a passed ball and scored on Lee's two-out single. Kopech retired the next seven batters, including three strikeouts in the seventh. Left-hander Colton Turner got one out, and right-hander Jack Charleston got the final five outs for his second save.

NEWS AND NOTES

The Dean: Austin Dean is in charge of school at the Baseball Grounds these days. Dean carries a nine-game hitting streak into tonight's game. During the course of his longest hitting streak of the season, Dean is hitting .429 (15-for-35) with two doubles, two triples, and eight runs batted in. The high water mark of his hit streak came on Sunday against the Barons, putting together an impressive 4-for-4 performance with two doubles and a triple, coming only a homer shy of hitting for the cycle. Dean also has scored four runs during this stretch at the plate, playing an important role near the top of Randy Ready's batting order. Dean overall this season is hitting .316 for the Jumbo Shrimp with two homers and 17 RBI in 35 games played, missing two and a half months from mid-April to early July with a right wrist injury. Dean is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 8 prospect for 2017.

Lee at the Top: Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with his .316 batting average. Lee is also hitting .316 in his last 10 games, and is doing well at the plate against Birmingham, going 3-for-10 in the first three games of the series. Lee is also the Southern League hit king with 122 this season, and is second in the league in runs scored with 67. Lee was honored as a Southern League Midseason All-Star for his work with the Montgomery Biscuits in the first half of the season, and he joined the Jumbo Shrimp on June 27 after he was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the Miami Marlins for Adeiny Hechavarria.

Take Me Home, Baseball Grounds: Almost heaven, Baseball Grounds, Bragan Field, St. Johns River. The Shrimp play well there, better than on the road. 30-22, 8-2 in series victories. Forgive me John Denver, but being at home is going to be really nice for the Jumbo Shrimp. The 31-22 record is proof of this, and the Shrimp have loved being back in Jacksonville in the second half, going 16-5 in that time, winning all three series. 20 of the final 30 games will be at home. After this 10-game homestand against the Barons (August 4-8) and Mississippi Braves (August 10-14), the Shrimp will host the Barons again from August 21-25, then Blue Wahoos from August 31 to September 4 to finish the season.

Where We Stand: There are 27 games left to go in the 2017 regular season, and the Jumbo Shrimp are still alive and well in the Southern League playoff picture. While the Jumbo Shrimp would not be in the postseason if the season were to end today, Jacksonville is still in striking distance to go dancing in September. As of Sunday August 5, the Jumbo Shrimp are two games back of the Mobile BayBears for first place in the second half South Division standings. If the Pensacola Blue Wahoos were to win the second half like they did the first half, then it would come down to the second best overall record to determine the South Division Wild Card winner. Right now Jacksonville would be six and a half games behind Biloxi in that category, and two and a half games behind Mobile in the Wild Card standings. Jacksonville hasn't appeared in the Southern League playoffs since 2014 when the club won the second half crown and then league title.

LAST START: Gunkel suffered the loss in his start on Wednesday August 2 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Gunkel worked four innings where he allowed five runs (four earned) on nine hits with no walks and four strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 13-0.

M-BRAVES START: Gunkel had a no decision in his start on Friday July 28 at Mississippi. Gunkel worked seven innings where he allowed two unearned runs on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts. After he allowed the pair of unearned runs in the third inning, his final four innings were in perfect fashion. The Shrimp later won 4-3 on a ninth inning homer by David Vidal. For his efforts, Gunkel was named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week.

SMOKIES START: Gunkel had a no decision in his start on Friday July 21 against Tennessee at the Baseball Grounds. Gunkel worked six scoreless innings allowing three hits with no walks and three strikeouts. Jacksonville would walk off a winner 3-2.

2017 EARLY ON: Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27. Gunkel entered the 2017 season as the Baltimore Orioles No. 20 prospect according to Baseball America.

2017 Highlights: Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

2016 Highlights: Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5/1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5/22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts. Tossed an 8.0-inning complete game on 6/9 at Durham, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, with four strikeouts and suffered the loss. Was the only Norfolk pitcher to have a complete game...Tossed a season-high 100 pitches in his complete game on 6/9. Had a streak of 25.2 innings in which he allowed only one run, 7/22-8/13. Left-handers hit .260 (57-for-219) with four home runs off of him, while right-handers hit .294 (99-for-337) with 10 home runs. Entered 2016 as the Orioles No. 23 prospect, according to MLB.com
