Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp second baseman Isan Diaz homered for a third straight game while driving in a season-high four runs, and right-hander Jordan Yamamoto earned his first Southern League win in a 7-4 victory over the Biloxi Shuckers in front of 8,044 fans. The Jumbo Shrimp (10-13 second half, 38-53 overall) took the lead in the bottom of the first inning against Biloxi right-hander Marcos Diplan (0-1). Left fielder Braxton Lee led off with a walk and scored on Diaz's one-out home run to right field. In the bottom of the second inning, Diplan walked right fielder John Norwood, and third baseman Brian Schales hit an RBI double to left field. After an error and strikeout, Lee drove in Schales with a sacrifice fly to make it 4-0. Yamamoto (1-0) held the Shuckers (11-11, 52-40) hitless for the first three innings. In the top of the fourth inning, Biloxi third baseman Lucas Erceg hit a leadoff single to right field, stole second base and scored on a two-out single by Shuckers right fielder Trent Grisham. Catcher Max McDowell reached on an error by shortstop Joe Dunand, and Diplan hit a two-run double to left-center field. Yamamoto retired center fielder Corey Ray to preserve the 4-3 lead. In the bottom of the third inning, Diplan walked Schales, catcher Rodrigo Vigil singled, and Yamamoto walked. Left fielder Braxton Lee hit an RBI single to left field to chase Diplan, and Diaz added a one-out, two-run single down the first-base line against right-hander Cody Ponce to extend the lead to 7-3. Diplan allowed seven runs – six earned – in three-plus innings. Ponce followed with three scoreless innings. Biloxi first baseman Jake Gatewood hit a fifth-inning solo home run to trim the lead to 7-4. Yamamoto allowed four runs – two earned – in five innings, before right-hander Kolton Mahoney pitched three scoreless innings, and left-hander Dylan Lee pitched a scoreless ninth inning for his third save.

NEWS AND NOTES

I See You Isan: Jumbo Shrimp second baseman Isan Diaz has homered in the past three games against the Biloxi Shuckers, and for Jacksonville has hit safely in the last five games. In that stretch, Diaz is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with the four home runs and ten runs batted in along with six runs scored. Last year with High-A Carolina, Diaz homered in back-to-back games on two occasions from April 30 to May 2. Diaz is regarded by MLB.com as the Marlins No. 7 prospect in 2018.

Shrimp Homering to the Top: Jumbo Shrimp sluggers Monte Harrison and Peter O'Brien are tied for the Marlins organizational lead with 12 home runs in the 2018 season. The Jacksonville pair are even with High-A Jupiter's John Silviano who also has 12 home runs to lead the organization. Isan Diaz is now tied for fourth in the organization with Triple-A New Orleans' Jonathan Rodriguez, also with 10 home runs.

Homestand of Dreams: How are things at home? Very well thank you. Since the Jumbo Shrimp returned home last Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 6-1 in games against Chattanooga and Biloxi, sweeping the Lookouts series before taking two of the first three of this series with the Shuckers. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 6-7 in home games during the second half, and 21-25 in home games overall this season. Jacksonville is 1-1 in second half home series, and 4-5 in home series overall in 2018.

Hello Benjamin Hill: The Jumbo Shrimp are proud to host MiLB.com's Benjamin Hill at the Baseball Grounds today. Ben writes about the business and culture of America through Minor League Baseball, and he is currently on an eight-team tour that has included trips this weekend to the Florida Fire Frogs and Daytona Tortugas. Hill last visited Jacksonville in 2015, and this is his first visit with the team under Ken Babby ownership as well as with the "Jumbo Shrimp" identity.

Shuckers are Back: This is the third of four series this season between Jacksonville and Biloxi. Earlier this season, the Jumbo Shrimp were swept by the Shuckers in early May at MGM Park in Biloxi, and then the Shuckers took three of five games against the Jumbo Shrimp in Jacksonville in mid-June. The next series will be a return trip to Biloxi until August 6-12. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Shuckers played five series, with Jacksonville going 9-15 in those games. That included a 6-9 record in Biloxi, and the Shrimp were 3-6 against the Shuckers in Jacksonville.

LAST START: Dugger earned a win in his start on Tuesday July 10 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Dugger worked a season-long seven innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts as Jacksonville won 7-2.

BISCUITS START: Dugger had a no decision in his start in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader with the Montgomery Biscuits on Sunday July 1 at the Baseball Grounds. Dugger worked two and a third innings, allowing five runs on four hits with four walks and a strikeout. Jacksonville originally led 7-0 after the first inning, but lost 18-9.

LAST SHUCKERS START: Dugger earned his first Double-A win in his start on Tuesday June 12 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds. Dugger turned in six innings where he allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts as Jacksonville won the series finale 3-2.

PROSPECT: Dugger is regarded by MLB.com as the Marlins No. 22 prospect for the 2018 season. He is one of nine top 30 Marlins prospects that are on Jacksonville's pitching staff, along with rotation mates Nick Neidert (8), Merandy Gonzalez (13), and Jordan Yamamoto (19).

2018 WITH JUPITER: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Florida State League with the Jupiter Hammerheads where he was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seen walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, DUGger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walks per nine innings ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

#12 ROBERT DUGGER | 6-2, 180 lbs | Born: July 3, 1995 in Tucson, Arizona. 23 Years Old.

From Mariners with RHP Nick Neidert, INF Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for IF/OF Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

2018 Highlights: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Florida State League with the Jupiter Hammerheads where he was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seen walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, DUGger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walks per nine innings ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

2017 Highlights: Split the season between Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League and High-A Modesto in the California League. With the Clinton Lumberkings, Dugger was 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 22 appearances and nine starts. As a starter, went 3-0 with a 1.18 ERA in nine starts after starting the season in the bullpen. With Clinton, he was honored as a 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star. Finished the season with the Modesto Nuts, going 2-5 with a 3.94 ERA in nine starts.

2016 Highlights: After he was selected by the Mariners in the 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech, Dugger spent time at three different levels of the Mariners system. He started with the AZL Mariners where he made four appearances in relief, with no wins or losses and a 1.04 ERA. In late July he was sent to Triple-A Tacoma, where he worked two games in relief, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA. He finished the season with the Everett AquaSox in the Short Season Class A Northwest League, where he was 2-1 with a 5.47 ERA in six starts.

College: Spent the 2016 season at Texas Tech, where he was 6-1 with a 2.67 ERA in 30 relief appearances with three saves. Struck out 54 batters in 60 and twothird innings of work. Dugger spent the 2015 and 2014 seasons at Cisco Junior College. In 2015, finished 3-2 overall with a 4.37 ERA ... struck out 55 hitters while issuing just 18 walks over 70.0 complete innings. In 2014 he was one of Cisco's top starting pitchers ... appeared in 12 games, finishing 5-5 overall with a 5.40 ERA ... led the team with 63.1 innings pitched ... tossed three complete games which ranked second on the team.

Personal: Helped lead Tomball High School to the Texas Class 4A state title as a senior ... played under head coach Doug Rush ... Tomball closed the 2013 season with an impressive 35-4 overall record ... marked the first state championship for any team sport in Tomball history ... team also finished the year ranked among the top 10 programs in the country ... was a first team All-District honoree as a senior ... first team All-State selection by the Texas Sports Writers Association ... also honored on the All-Houston area team and the All-State Tournament team ... recognized for work in the classroom as an academic All-State honoree ... member of the school's National Honors Society. Son of Ronnie and Anna Dugger ... has a younger brother, Cody ... mother is a teacher and University of Arizona alum.
