Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (12-15) fell to the Biloxi Shuckers (18-10) by a 6-4 score in the third game of the five-game series at MGM Park on Friday night. Jacksonville left-handed relief pitcher Jose Quijada (0-2) took the loss, allowing the go-ahead homer to the Shuckers in the bottom of the seventh. Biloxi right-handed relief pitcher Jon Olczak (2-0) earned the win by escaping a bases-loaded jam in the top of the seventh inning. Biloxi right-handed relief pitcher Nate Griep recorded the final four outs of the game to pick up his Southern League-best 10th save of the season. The game was scoreless until the top of the third inning. Monte Harrison gave the Shrimp a 2-0 lead with a two-run double that was ripped down the left field line. Three batters later, Brian Schales added a two-run single that grew the lead to 4-1. The Shuckers got back in the game thanks to a solo homer by Wendell Rijo in the bottom of the third, then his two-run home run in the fourth inning made it a one-run game at 4-3. Jacksonville's lead remained until the bottom of the seventh inning, when Lucas Erceg blasted a two-run homer to right field off Quijada to give the Shuckers a 5-4 lead. Later in the inning Biloxi's Jake Gatewood added an RBI double to grow the lead to 6-4, which would be the final. John Norwood finished the game 0-for-5 at the plate, and saw his 21 consecutive game on-base streak, which had been the longest in the Southern League this season, come to an end.

NEWS AND NOTES

Harrison Heating Up: Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Monte Harrison is having one of his best stretches of the 2018 season at the plate. Harrison has homered twice in the last eight games for Jacksonville, and Sunday went deep to left field despite a howling wind at the time. Harrison has hit safely in 12 of the last 13 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, and over his last 10 games is hitting .375 with two home runs and five runs batted in. Harrison had one of his best games at the plate on Friday, driving in two runs with a double against the Biloxi Shuckers. Harrison has hit safely in the last six games for the Jumbo Shrimp, matching his longest hitting streak of the season. Harrison is now regarded as Miami's No. 1 prospect according to MLB.com. Harrison is also facing his former organization, as he was traded from the Brewers to the Marlins along with teammate Isan Diaz and Lewis Brinson, Jordan Yamamoto in exchange for outfielder Christian Yelich in January 2018.

Culver and Buckelew Join Shrimp: Yesterday the Jumbo Shrimp made a series of roster moves. Infielder Cito Culver has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Culver has played in 18 games for the Baby Cakes, hitting .155 with no home runs and five runs batted in with a pair of doubles. Additionally, left-handed relief pitcher James Buckelew has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Buckelew pitched in six games for the Baby Cakes, going 1-1 with a 3.38 ERA, striking out nine batters in 13 and a third innings of work. Utility player Mason Davis has been transferred from Jacksonville to High-A Jupiter. Davis has played in 14 games for the Jumbo Shrimp this season, hitting .295 (13-for-44) with six doubles, three triples, and six runs batted in.

Norwood's Streak Ends: John Norwood went 0-for-5 at the plate Friday, seeing his 21 consecutive game on-base streak end come to an end, which had been the longest in the Southern League. That streak stretched back to April 9, and it was just the second time in 26 games he hadn't gotten on base.

Shrimp and Shuckers: This is the first of four series this season between Jacksonville and Biloxi. The next two meetings will be in Jacksonville from June 8-12 and in the second half from July 12-16. The Jumbo Shrimp will not make a return trip to Biloxi until August 6-12. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Shuckers played five series, with Jacksonville going 9-15 in those games. That included a 6-9 record in Biloxi, and the Shrimp were 3-6 against the Shuckers in Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp did win their last series here in late August, including a key doubleheader sweep on August 30 that shrunk Jacksonville's magic number to clinch the second half South Division title from five to one, and the Shrimp clinched a playoff berth the next day with a win at home against the Blue Wahoos.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by MLB.com as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months. Today Neidert starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Shuckers in Biloxi, and he carries a 2-1 record with a 4.12 ERA into his fifth start of the season.

LAST START: Poteet earned his second straight victory in his start on Saturday April 28 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Poteet turned in a season-long seven innings, allowing a run on two hits with two walks and four strikeouts. The lone run he allowed was a top of the second inning solo homer to Aristides Aquino. The Shrimp won a tight contest 2-1 off homers by Brian Schales and John Norwood.

SMOKIES START: Poteet earned his first Double-A win on Sunday April 22 against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Poteet pitched six innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts, as Jacksonville won 11-5.

LOOKOUTS START: Poteet had a no decision in his start on Tuesday April 17 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field. Poteet worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned on solo HRs) on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts. Poteet left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-1, and the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Lookouts 3-2 on a walk-off homer by Zander Wiel in the bottom of the ninth.

BAYBEARS START: Poteet had a no decision (was one out shy of qualifying for a win) in his start on Wednesday April 11 at the Baseball Grounds against the Mobile BayBears. In front of an Opening Night crowd of 6,960 fans, Poteet worked four and two-third innings while allowing two runs (both earned) on three hits with four walks and seven strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-5.

PROSPECT BUZZ: Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

#20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

2017 Highlights: Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

2016 Highlights: Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

2015 Highlights: After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

College: Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

Personal: Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.
