**Last Game:** The Montgomery Biscuits broke a 1-1 tie with a three-run sixth inning on the way to a 5-1 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 2,258 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Monday night. Seeking to keep at least a tie for first place in the North Division, the Biscuits (32-25) opened the scoring in the first inning against right-hander Joe Gunkel (0-2). Center fielder Braxton Lee led off with a single to center field, stole second base and scored on right fielder Cade Gotta's two-out RBI double to left field. Designated hitter Justin Williams hit a single to right field, but Jacksonville right fielder John Norwood threw to catcher Austin Nola to retire Gotta for the final out of the inning. The Jumbo Shrimp (24-33) tied the game in the fourth inning against Biscuits right-hander Mike Franco (5-0). With two outs, designated hitter Cam Maron walked, and shortstop Alex Yarbrough hit an RBI double to left-center field. Gunkel had retired 12 consecutive batters before the pivotal sixth inning, but he began by walking second baseman Riley Unroe and allowing Lee's single to left field. Gunkel was removed for right-hander Andy Beltre, whose outing began with shortstop Andrew Velazquez's two-run triple to left-center field, followed by a wild pitch scoring Velazquez to give the Biscuits a 4-1 lead. Gunkel allowed three earned runs on four hits and one walk with four strikeouts in five innings, while Beltre allowed one earned run on two hits and two walks without a strikeout. The Biscuits added their final run against right-hander Esmerling De La Rosa in the eighth inning, as Gotta walked, stole second base and scored on Williams' RBI single. De La Rosa finished two innings with three strikeouts, before right-hander Tyler Higgins' scoreless ninth inning. After Franco finished six innings, allowing one earned run on four hits and three walks with a career-high nine strikeouts, Biscuits left-hander Kyler Bird, right-hander Brad Schreiber worked a perfect seventh and eighth innings, respectively. Right-hander Kyler Winkler worked around a leadoff walk in a scoreless ninth inning to finish Montgomery's 5-1 win.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Roster Moves:** The Miami Marlins announced a series of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster. Chris Diaz has been acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Pittsburgh Pirates for cash considerations and has been assigned to Double-A Jacksonville. Diaz was playing for the Eastern League's Double-A Altoona Curve, where he was hitting .375 (9-for-24) with no homers and 3 RBI in 10 games for the Curve in April and May. Diaz had been on the Single-A West Virginia Black Bears roster but had not appeared in a game. Diaz was originally selected by the Pirates in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2012 draft out of North Carolina State. In a corresponding move, infielder Cal Tovey has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Tovey played in 26 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .177 with a home run and 11 runs batted in. Tovey began the season on the New Orleans disabled list. Additionally, left-handed pitcher James Buckelew has been transferred from Jacksonville to Marlins extended spring training. Buckelew has pitched in 14 games and made one start for Jacksonville, and is 0-4 with a 3.27 ERA with 28 strikeouts in his 33 innings of work. In a corresponding move, right-handed pitcher Clayton Mortensen has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Mortensen has pitched in 16 games for the Baby Cakes, going 3-0 with a 8.46 ERA with 28 strikeouts in 22 and a third innings of work. Mortensen was signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on April 4, 2017. Mortensen, 32, is in his 11<sup>th</sup> season of professional baseball, and pitched in the major leagues for parts of five seasons with the St. Louis Cardinals (2009), Oakland Athletics (2009-10), Colorado Rockies (2011), and Boston Red Sox (2012-13). In his big league career he is 6-11 with a 4.58 ERA in 74 appearances with 13 games started.

**Homers at Home:** The Jumbo Shrimp have loved hitting home runs at the Baseball Grounds this year. 24 of Jacksonville's 40 homers have been hit at the Baseball Grounds in 26 games so far this year, compared to 14 homers in 30 road games so far this season. Brian Anderson homered last night against the Biscuits, and so far five of his nine homers have been hit in Jacksonville this year. Anderson is tied with John Norwood for the team lead in homers, and Norwood also prefers hitting the long ball at home, with seven of his nine homers also at 301 A. Philip Randolph Blvd.

**Bring on the Biscuits:** I've got a hunger, you've got a hunger. So Bring on the Biscuits. Yeah Bring on the Biscuits. And Let's Cook! Foodies across Minor League Baseball have eagerly awaited this first ever matchup between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and the Montgomery Biscuits from Sunday through Thursday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. However this will be the only trip that the North Division Biscuits make to see the South Division Shrimp. Jacksonville's lone visit to Montgomery will be from July 4-8 at Riverwalk Stadium. Last year in Jacksonville, the club was 5-5 against the Biscuits and 7-8 against Montgomery overall.

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**18 – MATT TOMSHAW, LHP**

**5-2, 2.66 ERA, 11 games and 11 starts**

**2017:** 5-2, 2.66 ERA (19 ER/64.1 IP) in 11 G and 11 GS.  
**CAREER:** 40-35, 3.65 ERA (273 ER/673.2 IP) in 157 G and 102 GS.

**2017 vs. MTG:** First Start.  
**CAREER vs. MTG:** 1-1, 2.76 ERA (4 ER/13.0 IP) in 4 G and 2 GS.

**LAST START:** Tomshaw took a loss in his start on Thursday June 1 against the Blue Wahoos in Pensacola. He worked six innings where he gave up four runs on nine hits with a walk and six strikeouts as Shrimp lost 5-2.

**GENERALS WIN:** Tomshaw earned his fifth win of the year with a victory against the Jackson Generals in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader on Friday May 26 at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw worked six innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville won 6-4.

**M-BRAVES START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start against Mississippi on Saturday May 20 at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw worked six innings where he allowed a pair of runs on seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts. Tomshaw left the game with Jacksonville up 3-2, only to see the M-Braves tie the game with a solo homer by Connor Lien in the top of the ninth, then John Norwood hit a walk-off homer in the bottom of the ninth to win the game 4-3.

**BAYBEARS WIN:** Tomshaw earned the win in his start on Mother's Day Sunday May 14. Tomshaw worked six and two-third innings where he allowed a run on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp ended a six-game losing streak with a 3-1 win.

**#18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28**

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

**2016 Highlights:** Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

**2015 Highlights:** Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. In his first season as reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

**2014 Highlights:** He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

**2013 Highlights:** He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

**2012 Highlights:** Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

**2011 Highlights:** After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

**Personal:** Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1."
