Last Game: Montgomery Biscuits right-hander Greg Harris pitched six scoreless innings to help the visitors to a 5-2 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 4,304 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Sunday night. The Biscuits (31-25) opened the scoring in the fourth inning against Jumbo Shrimp left-hander James Buckelew (0-4). Three straight singles by first baseman Joe McCarthy, designated hitter Cade Gotta and right fielder Justin Williams led to the first run. With one out, third baseman Grant Kay added an RBI single to center field for a 2-0 lead. Catcher Nick Ciuffo hit a sacrifice fly to left field, extending the lead to 3-0. Buckelew finished four innings, allowing three earned runs on five hits and no walks with five strikeouts. Harris (3-4) worked around at least one baserunner in each of the first six innings. Catcher Nick Ciuffo threw out second baseman KC Serna on a steal attempt in the first inning, and the Biscuits turned a double play in the second inning. He stranded six total runners on base, including five in scoring position in the third through fifth innings. He scattered three hits and three walks with six strikeouts to win his second straight start. In the fifth inning, Biscuits shortstop Andrew Velazquez hit a solo home run – his fourth of the season – to the right-center field bleachers against Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Omar Bencomo to make it 4-0. The Biscuits tallied their final run in the eighth inning, when McCarthy scored on Bencomo's two-out wild pitch in the eighth inning for a 5-0 lead. Jacksonville (24-32) reached the scoreboard in the eighth inning, when Serna singled, and third baseman Brian Anderson hit a two-run home run to left field against right-hander Edwin Fierro to tie for the Southern League lead with 38 RBIs. Right-hander Ian Gibaut struck out the side in the ninth inning for his second save.

Roster Moves: d The Miami Marlins announced a pair of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to tonight's game against the Montgomery Biscuits at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville at 7:05 p.m. Infielder KC Serna has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Serna has played in 27 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .177 with three homers and six runs batted in. Serna recently played with the Baby Cakes in mid-May, playing in eight games where he hit .313 with a homer and four runs batted in. In a corresponding move, infielder Rehiner (pronounced Ray-ner) Cordova has been transferred from Marlins extended spring training to Double-A Jacksonville. Cordova played in one game for the Jumbo Shrimp on May 12, going 0-for-2 at the plate against the Biloxi Shuckers.

Homers at Home: The Jumbo Shrimp have loved hitting home runs at the Baseball Grounds this year. 24 of Jacksonville's 40 homers have been hit at the Baseball Grounds in 26 games so far this year, compared to 14 homers in 30 road games so far this season. Brian Anderson homered last night agains the Biscuits, and so far five of his nine homers have been hit in Jacksonville this year. Anderson is tied with John Norwood for the team lead in homers, and Norwood also prefers hitting the long ball at home, with seven of his nine homers also at 301 A. Philip Randolph Blvd.

Foodies across Minor League Baseball have eagerly awaited this first ever matchup between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and the Montgomery Biscuits from Sunday through Thursday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. However this will be the only trip that the North Division Biscuits make to see the South Division Shrimp. Jacksonville's lone visit to Montgomery will be from July 4-8 at Riverwalk Stadium. Last year in Jacksonville, the club was 5-5 against the Biscuits and 7-8 against Montgomery overall.

Claimed by the Marlins off waivers from the Los Angeles Dodgers on April 29, 2017. **2017 Highlights:** Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27. 2016 Highlights: Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5 1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5 22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts.
