TODAY'S GAME: Rubber match of a three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets (NYM) at First Data Field (1-1)...Clearwater is coming off a rain-shortened, two-game sweep at the hands of the Bradenton Marauders (PIT)...The Threshers suffered their third sweep of the month after being swept only one time leading into July...Third of four series (13 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Threshers swept the Mets at First Data Field from June 28-30, which included two come-from-behind victories.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 21-year-old Andrew Brown makes his 18th appearance - 15th start - of the season in the rubber match of the three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets at First Data Field...The 6-foot-1 hurler allowed five runs in two innings of relief against the Bradenton Marauders (PIT) on July 16...The right-hander gave up three hits, walked three and struck out a pair of batters on 40 pitches - 21 strikes...Sunday will be the Alpine, Calif. native's second career start against the New York Mets affiliate...Brown took the loss against the Mets on June 11, surrendering three runs on five hits, three free passes and a punch out across five frames.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers snapped a seven-game losing streak with a 3-0 shut out over the St. Lucie Mets on Saturday night at First Data Field...All three runs for the visitors came across in the fifth inning...Spencer Howard earned his first win since April 10 with six scoreless stanzas.

HOWARD'S HYPE: Spencer Howard continued his dominance of the Florida Fire Frogs on Saturday night, picking up his second quality start of the season with six scoreless innings against the Mets...The California native has not allowed a run with Clearwater since surrendering two tallies against the Florida Fire Frogs on April 16, a span of 22.1 consecutive innings...The Philadelphia Phillies fifth-ranked prospect followed up his Florida State League Pitcher of the Week with just two hits allowed and four strikeouts...The right-hander has punched out 56 batters across 40.1 innings of work in 2019, while holding opponents to a .168 average.

SIMÓN SAYS: Simón Muzziotti extended his on-base and hitting streaks with a 1-for-3 performance at the dish on Saturday night...The 20-year-old has picked up 10 hits in 30 at-bats during his eight-game hitting streak...The native of Venezuela is tied for the second longest on-base streak for the Threshers this season at 13 games, in which the left-handed batter is hitting .283 by going 13-for-46 at the plate.

PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS: Spencer Howard (4), Keylan Killgore (2) and Zach Warren (1) picked up seven strikeouts in the victory over the St. Lucie Mets on Saturday night...Clearwater continues to be the only team in the Florida State League with at least 900 punch outs, ending the night with 916...The Threshers lead the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) by 58 for the top-spot in the league.

HOME SWEET HOME?: With the 2-8 start to the month of July, Clearwater continues to stay below .500 with a 22-26 record at Spectrum Field in 2019...The discrepancy in stats between home and road games is not that different for the Threshers...The club has a .258 average at home compared to .237 on the road, and has scored the same amount of runs (197-197)...Clearwater has a .704 OPS at Spectrum Field, but has posted a .670 on the road...On the mound, the pitching staff does have a higher ERA on the home bump (3.88-3.16), and has a higher average against (.238-.231)...The Threshers have been swept four times this season, with three coming at home...Clearwater is currently in the midst of a four-game losing streak at Spectrum Field, the second streak of at least four games in the second half in 14 contests.

LEAVING MEN ON BASE: After plating 47 runs through the first seven games of the second half (6.7 runs/game) to lead to a 5-2 start, the Clearwater offense has managed 75 runs the last 24 contests (3.1 runs/game) to go 10-14 ever since...Over the stretch, Clearwater has managed just a .222 average with a chance to drive a runner home (40-for-180)...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate has 164 hits over the 24-game stretch, with 51 going for extra bases (31 percent)...The Threshers did finish 3-for-6 with runners in scoring position on Saturday night, with two of the hits manufacturing runs.

NO JUNE SWOON: Everything went the way of the Clearwater Threshers in the month of June, as the club posted a league-best, 18-7 record during the third month of the season...The offense had a dip in production in average (.246 in June to .277 in May), on-base percentage (.310 in June to .326 May) and OPS (.690 in June compared to .737 in May), but excelled in the pitching department...The arms dropped their ERA by more than a point from 3.69 in May down to 2.56 in June, and had 28 less walks with 68 in June compared to 96 in May...The bullpen took a step forward in June as well, going 9-2 and 10-for-11 in save opportunities...Relievers also posted a 1.58 ERA (17er/97.1ip), while collecting 119 strikeouts (one shy of tying April's season-high).
