Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Mike Kickham pitched a season-long seven innings and hit his first professional home run in a 10-3 triumph and third straight win to clinch a series victory over the Mississippi Braves in front of 4,814 on Baptist Health Sunday Family FUNday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Kickham (1-3) did not allow a hit through the first three innings, while Jacksonville (18-26) built an 8-0 lead. He faced the minimum through 4 1/3 innings before Braves right fielder Keith Curcio hit a solo home run in the fifth inning. He only allowed one other baserunner into scoring position, allowing only two hits and one walk with four strikeouts. The Jumbo Shrimp opened the scoring in the second inning against Braves right-hander Matt Withrow (1-3). Left fielder Alex Glenn singled and went to second base on a groundout before center fielder Yefri Perez hit an RBI triple to left field. The 1-0 lead grew again when Jacksonville batted around in the third inning. Third baseman Brian Anderson walked with one out, and first baseman Cal Towey singled. With two outs, Glenn hit an RBI single to right field for a 2-0 lead. Catcher Cam Maron walked to load the bases, and Perez hit a two-run double to right field for a 4-0 edge. Kickham then hit a three-run homer to the right-field bleachers, and shortstop Alex Yarbrough followed with a solo home run to nearly the same spot to make it 8-0. Withrow allowed eight earned runs on nine hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 2 2/3 innings. Following three scoreless innings by Braves left-hander Michael Mader, left-hander Philip Pfeifer allowed seventhing singles to pinch-hitter Taylor Ard and second baseman David Vidal. Anderson's two-run double extended the lead to 10-1. Against Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Daniel Schlereth, Mississippi (22-22) tallied single runs in the eighth and ninth innings. Second baseman Luis Valenzuela hit an RBI single, and catcher Kade Scivicque hit a sacrifice fly, respectively. Schlereth finished the game to give J

Roster Moves: The Miami Marlins announced a pair of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to today's game against the Mississippi Braves at Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville at 11:05 a.m. Infielder KC Serna has been transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Serna played in eight games for the Baby Cakes where he hit .313 (5-for-16) with a home run and four RBI. Serna started the season in Jacksonville where in 16 games he he hit .176 (6-for-34) with an RBI. In a corresponding move, infielder Junior Arrojo has been transferred from Jacksonville to High-A Jupiter. Arrojo played in four games for the Jumbo Shrimp, going 0-for-9 at the plate with a walk and four strikeouts.

<u>Pitcher Who Rakes</u>: Yesterday featured an incredible performance from Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Mike Kickham. Not only did he earn his first victory of the year by working seven innings where he just allowed a run on three hits, but he did something that no Jumbo Shrimp pitcher has done this season. In the bottom of the third inning he delivered a three-run homer to grow Jacksonville's lead to 7-0. Kickham is the first Jumbo Shrimp pitcher to homer, and the blast was the first of his professional career.

S.L. Leaders: David Vidal is fourth in the league in hitting with a .316 average, third in the league with 11 doubles, and tied for third in the league with 48 hits. Vidal is in his first season in the Marlins organization after spending the past two seasons in the independent Atlantic League by playing with the Somerset Patriots.

Bon Voyage M-Braves: Today ends the second series of the year between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and the Mississippi Braves. The clubs started the 2017 season facing each other at Trustmark Park in Pearl, Mississippi, with the M-Braves winning 3 of 5 games. Mississippi is currently tied for second in the Southern League South Division standings, one game back of Pensacola. The Shrimp and Braves will next face each other from July 25-29, and the M-Braves return to Jacksonville from August 10-14.

He also gave up three hits with a walk and three strikeouts in a game that Biloxi would win 5-3.

SMOKIES START: Mazza returned to the Jacksonville rotation in game two of Jacksonville's doubleheader at Tennessee on Sunday May 7. Mazza turned in four scoreless innings, allowing four hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Reliever Hunter Adkins would get the win in the game as Jacksonville won 3-0 thanks to a 3-run homer by Brian Anderson in the first inning.

Signed by the Marlins as a Minor League Free Agent on August 4, 2015. **2016 Highlights:** Mazza began the season in the bullpen for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. Mazza was 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA in his seven relief outings, collecting eight strikeouts in his 15 innings of work. Mazza was called up to the Suns on May 1, and was the first player called up from High-A to Double-A for the Marlins in 2016. Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first Hammerhead to be called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June. Following his win against the Shuckers on June 15, Mazza was placed on the disabled list on June 16 with right shoulder tendinitis. Mazza had a rehab assignment in early July with the GCL Marlins, where he was 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA in four appearances and three starts. Mazza returned to the Suns on July 23. All told, Mazza was 6-5 with a 4.16 ERA in 19 appearances and 14 starts with Jacksonville.

2015 Highlights: Split the season between the Twins and the Marlins organizations. Mazza had five relief appearances with the GCL Twins with no record and a 0.00 ERA in six innings pitched. With the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Midwest League, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 9.00 ERA in two games in relief and three innings pitched. Mazza was released by the Twins organization on July 22, 2015. The Miami Marlins signed him as minor league free agent on August 4, 2015, and assigned him to High-A Jupiter. With the Hammerheads, Mazza went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 11 games in relief, striking out 11 batters in 15 innings pitched. **2014 Highlights**: Mazza spent all of 2014 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza was 4-4 with a 279 ERA in 25 games pitched, and struck

out 62 batters compared to 11 walks in 48 and a third innings pitched.

2013 Highlights: Mazza spent all of 2013 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 6.23 ERA in seven games

pitched in relief with a pair of saves.

2012 Highlights: After he was drafted by the Twins, Mazza was 2-1 with a 0.60 ERA in nine relief outings for the GCL Twins. In the Appalachian League with Elizabethton, Mazza was 3-1 with a 3.45 ERA in nine games in relief, striking out 15 batters in his 15 and a third innings pitched.

College: Mazza pitched collegiately at Menlo College. Mazza is the program's all-time record holder in triples, saves, and is tied for home runs with an astounding 19. During the 2011 campaign, Mazza helped lead the Oaks to their first ever Conference Title with an impressive team leading .337 batting average, five home runs, and 41 RBIs while accumulating equally imposing stats on the mound, with a team low 2.37 ERA and nine saves. He was the first player ever drafted out of Menlo, although Gino Cimoli (1956-1965, All Star in 1957 with the Brooklyn Dodgers), and Bill Renna (1953-59) have played in the majors.

Personal: Mazza was originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 27th round of the 2011 draft out of Menlo College in Atherton, California. Mazza attended Clayton Valley HS in Concord, California, same alma mater as former major leaguers Clyde Mashore and Damon Mashore.
