SNAPPER SNIPPETS

LATE HEROICS: Tuesday's game-winning single by **Eric Marinez** is the 5th time this year the Snappers have won on a walk-off as Marinez is the 5th different player to deliver the big knock. Tuesday was the 2nd time this year the Snappers have walked off against Clinton in as many meetings after Beloit completed a sweep of the LumberKings with an **Edwin Diaz** walk-off single on April 26. Beloit has taken the lead to win in their final at-bat 9 times this season.

TAKING THE UPPER HAND: The Snappers have now won their last 3 series openers after taking game 1 vs. Clinton on Tuesday. Beloit went on to take 3 of 4 vs. Wisconsin in their last home series & then split 4 games at Quad Cities. The Snappers have won both 3-game series in which they won the opener.

CLOSE GAMES: After their 11th one-run win last night, the Snappers completed their 18th game decided by 1 run. Their 18 one-run games are the most in the Midwest League while Wisconsin has played in 17. All 7 games between Beloit & Clinton have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: Beloit has scored 5 runs or more in 24 games this season & are 21-3 when they hit that plateau. Beloit is now 8-3 in games that both teams reach 5 runs after Tuesday's walk-off win.

DIAZ DIALED IN: **Edwin Diaz** has hit safely in his last 10 games & carries an 18-game on-base streak. Diaz currently has his longest hitting streak during his Snappers tenure & tied with **Nate Mondou** with the longest hitting streak by a Snapper this year. Diaz is 17-for-38 over his last 10 games while raising his batting average from .230 to .290.

JUST 'DOU IT: Infielder **Nate Mondou** continues to rack up the hits for the Snappers with 10 hits in his last 5 games. He collected 3 hits Tuesday for the 6th time this year with 16 total multi-hit games. Mondou's .329 mark at the plate is 3rd in the Midwest League & leads the Athletics organization.

DOUBLE VISION: The Snappers have turned 60 double plays in 2017, the most in the Midwest League. That is also the 2nd-highest total in Minor League Baseball as the Athletics Double-A affiliate in Midland has converted the most with 63 twin killers during the 2017 season.

TODAY'S PITCHERS: **Mitchell Jordan** & **Jesus Zambrano** will face Clinton for the first time this season. Jordan has allowed 1 run or fewer in all but 1 outing this year, which was his last start at Pohlman Field. Zambrano faced the LumberKings twice last year & got the win in his Snappers debut on April 11.

FACING THE LUMBERKINGS: Meeting for their 3rd series already this season, the home team has won every matchup between Beloit & Clinton this year. Snappers manager **Scott Steinmann** managed Clinton for 3 seasons with a record of 179-238. According to MLB Pipeline, the LumberKings have 6 of the Mariners Top-30 prospects. Those players include pitchers **Brandon Miller** (#18) & **Nick Wells** (#26) along with fielders **Joe Rizzo** (#7), **Bryson Brigman** (#15), **Luis Liberato** (#19), & **Rayder Ascanio** (#28).
