## LANCASTER JETHAWKS (29-35) vs. INLAND EMPIRE 66ERS (31-33)

RHP RICO GARCIA (5-7, 3.86 ERA) vs. RHP ERIK MANOAH (1-5, 6.49 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks take on Inland Empire (LA Angles) in the 2nd game of a 4-game series and 7 -game road trip...RHP Rico Garcia (5-7) takes the mound seeking a team-leading 6th win opposite 66ers RHP Erik Manoah (1-5).

STORM CHASERS: Lancaster enters the day in 4th place in the South Division, 3.0 games behind 1st-place Lake Elsinore...Inland Empire and Rancho Cucamonga are tied for 2nd place, 2.0 games ahead of the JetHawks... 6 games remain in the 1st Half...the club finishes the half with 3 games at Lake Elsinore...Lancaster's first half elimination number is 4 .
'HAWK STARS: The Cal League announced the rosters for next Tuesday's All-Star Game in Lancaster...eight JetHawks, the most of any South Division team, were selected...OF Vince Fernandez and IF Roberto Ramos were voted into the starting lineup...the club's pitching and reserve selections include RHP Rico Garcia, RHP Heath Holder, RHP Reid Humphreys, RHP Justin Lawrence, IF Alan Trejo and IF Colton Welker...the South club will be managed by JetHawks skipper Fred Ocasio.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Lancaster couldn't hold on to leads of 8-4 and 10-6 in a 14-11 loss to Inland Empire in the series opener...Brandon Gold tied a club season-high by allowing 8 earned runs over 5.1 IP...Kenny Oakley allowed 5 runs in relief to take the loss...it was the JetHawks' 1st loss when scoring $10+$ runs this season.

A MOVE: RHP Kenny Oakley was placed on the 7-Day DL prior to Tuesday's game...RHP Juan Pena returns from Extended Spring Training.

MARIACHI MASHER: IF Roberto Ramos blasted his league-leading 17th homer Monday...also leads league with 42 RBI a .655 SLG and a 1.053 OPS...was named the Cal League Player of the Month for May...led league with 9 homers and hit .345 with a 1.201 OPS.

SIX UNDER: Monday's loss dropped Lancaster to a season-high 6 games under .500...club has lost 14 of last 21 games.

SERIES BUSINESS: Lancaster is now 5-15 in series openers after Monday's loss...the clubs has lost 3 -straight series...last series win was a 3 -game sweep of Visalia at home, May 15-17.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys has not allowed an earned run since April 21 at IE...current 14.0 scoreless-IP streak is longest on the club this season...ranked $2 n d$ in league with 12 saves.
vs. THE EVIL EMPIRE: The JetHawks are 5-10 in the season series against Inland Empire and 3-5 in games played at San Manuel Stadium...tonight's game is the 16th of 28 in the season series and the 9th of 14 in San Bernardino.

LAST START ( $\mathbf{6} / 7 \mathrm{vs}$. RC): Took the loss despite recording a quality start...marked his 4th-straight loss despite allowing 3 -or-fewer earned runs in 3 of the 4 starts...struck out 8 and walked 1 over 7.0 IP...allowed 3 runs on 5 hits including a home run.

ALOHA, 2018: Was club's Opening Night starter (4/5) and allowed 5 earned runs on 9 hits over 5.0 frames vs. Modesto.

LAST SEASON: Began season with Short-Season Boise...went 0-4 with a 3.95 ERA over 8 starts...was promoted to Low-A Asheville and made full-season debut out of the bullpen on July 30...made 8 appearances overall with Tourists and went $2-2$ with a 2.57 ERA...started his final 4 appearances...struck out 30 batters and walked 7 over 28.0 IP in South Atlantic League.
