

## **2017 First Data Field Security Procedures**

This Spring Training the New York Mets will administer several security measures at the First Data Field Sports Complex in accordance with Major League Baseball security regulations and in conjunction with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

Fans should take the time before coming to the complex to review these protocols.

### **New for 2017:**

- All fans will be subject to passing through walkthrough metal detectors upon entry into First Data Field Sports Complex. Re-entry is NOT permitted. The sports complex is a smoke free facility. Vaping and electronic cigarettes are prohibited.

### **Guests are allowed to bring the following items into the First Data Field Sports Complex:**

- Bags no larger than 16"x16"x8" in size. All bags will be inspected.
- Strollers that are able to collapse under a seat.
- Small tote umbrellas that do not interfere with other fans.

### **The following items will NOT be permitted inside the First Data Field Sports Complex:**

- Glass bottles or metal cans
- Alcohol or illegal substances
- Outside food or beverage
- Brooms, poles, selfie sticks
- Video cameras, professional cameras for commercial use, tripods
- Signage that is hung on/in the field of play, displays advertisements or is offensive
- Weapons (firearms, knives) regardless of permit.
- Pets (except for service animals)
- Noise making devices (air horns, cowbells, musical instruments, etc.)
- Personalized Recreational Vehicles (skateboards, roller blades, wheeled footwear, bicycles, hover boards, razor boards, segways, etc.)
- Baseball bats (except mini bats purchased in the team store)
- Unmanned aerial vehicles (drones)
- Folding chairs or stools

The Mets reserve the right to determine what is acceptable for entry into the First Data Field Sports Complex. The Mets also reserve the right to change or modify these guidelines at any time without notice.
