



MISSISSIPPI BRAVES (20-27) VS. JACKSONVILLE JUMBO SHRIMP (20-27)

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue their fifth homestand of 2018 with game three of the five-game series (0-2) at Trustmark Park against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (MIA). The M-Braves are coming off a 5-5 road trip to Jackson (3-2) and Tennessee (2-3).

LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves dropped a doubleheader to Jacksonville on Thursday at Trustmark Park, losing Wednesday's suspended game 8-1 and the nightcap 3-0. The second game was delayed 1 hour, 36 minutes due to rain. In game two, RHP **Touki Toussaint** matched a season-high with 10 strikeouts and no walks over 6.0 quality innings. He allowed 2 runs on 6 hits and suffered the tough luck loss.

M-BRAVES AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: RHP **Touki Toussaint** leads the Southern League in strikeouts (66), 2nd among SL starters with an 11.80 SO/9IP ratio and 5th in opponents batting average (.214). OF **Michael Reed** is 3rd in the SL with a .445 OBP, and is 7th in batting average (.313). RHP **Jacob Webb** is T-3rd in appearances (17) and T-2nd in saves (7). RHP **Josh Graham** is T-2nd in appearances with 18.

M-BRAVES VS. JUMBO SHRIMP: The Braves and the Jumbo Shrimp (formerly Suns) meet 21 times in 2018 with 11 games being played at Trustmark Park and 10 games being played in Jacksonville. The Braves are 79-84 all-time against the Jumbo Shrimp and 35-40 at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves went 8-12 against Jacksonville in 2017 and 5-5 at Trustmark Park.

TOUKI TOUSSAINT CLIMBING MILB STRIKEOUT LEADERBOARD: RHP **Touki Toussaint** ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball with 66 strikeouts on the season in 50.1 innings, trailing only Jose Suarez's 69 in the Angels system. The 21-year-old also has a 2.45 ERA over his last 6 starts (4 quality) with 40 strikeouts and 10 walks over 33.0 innings.

MARLETTE RIDING 8-GAME HITTING STREAK: C/INF **Tyler Marlette** has an 8-game hitting streak, batting .423 (11-for-26) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 3 RBI. The streak is currently the longest active streak in the Southern League.

REED SETTING THE TABLE FOR M-BRAVES: OF **Michael Reed** has a .446 OBP during the month of May with 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 17 walks and 14 runs in 19 games. Reed has already logged a 12-game hitting streak (4/6-4/23) and 18-game on-base streak (4/5-4/27) this season.

10-GAME ROAD TRIP BY THE NUMBERS: The M-Braves went 5-5 over the ten-game road trip to Jackson (3-2) and Tennessee (2-3), winning their first road series of 2018. The club averaged 4.4 runs per game and batted .248 with 6 home runs. On the mound, the M-Braves posted a 3.25 ERA with 72 strikeouts in 83.1 innings.

THIS DAY IN BRAVES HISTORY: On this day in 1935, at Forbes Field, Boston Braves outfielder Babe Ruth hits three homers and a single in an 11-7 loss to the Pirates in Pittsburgh. The 'Sultan of Swat's' seventh-inning solo shot off Gary Bush, a blast which clears the ballpark's roof, will be the Bambino's 714th and final home run.

FROM PEARL TO ATLANTA: RHP **Mike Soroka** became the third M-Brave alum to make his MLB debut in 2018 on May 1 in New York. The Calgary, Canada native joins OF **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (April 25) and LHP **Jesse Biddle** (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 132 players, have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005.

HAMMER TIME: Jackson, MS native **Chris Maloney** enters his first season as the M-Braves manager and is the seventh skipper in franchise history.

- Maloney attended Jackson's St. Joseph High School and graduated from Mississippi State University in 1983.
- Maloney spent the previous six years on the St. Louis Cardinals Major League coaching staff as the team's third base coach (2016-July 2017) and first base coach (2012-15).
- Prior to joining the Cardinals, Maloney was the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) manager for five seasons (2007-11), leading the team to winning records in four of his five seasons.
- Maloney ranks ninth among active minor league managers in wins with 1,350 entering the 2018 season.

PROSPECTING: The Atlanta Braves farm system was ranked No. 2 in Major League Baseball by MLB.com. The M-Braves roster currently features one Top 100 prospect in RHP **Kyle Wright** (No. 30). The roster has a total of seven of the Top 30 Atlanta prospects in Wright (No. 2), RHP **Touki Toussaint** (No. 11), RHP **Bryse Wilson** (No. 13), C **Alex Jackson** (No. 14), OF **Travis Demeritte** (No. 21), LHP **Ricardo Sanchez** (No. 27) and RHP **Josh Graham** (No. 29).

TODAY'S GAME

- RHP **Bryse Wilson** makes his fourth Double-A start for the M-Braves against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in game three of the five-game series at Trustmark Park. Wilson was 2-0 with a 0.34 ERA (26.2IP, 1ER) twith the High-A Florida Fire Frogs in the FSL before his promotion on May 8. He did not allow a run over his last two starts and 13.1 innings. In his career, Wilson is 14-8 with a 2.03 ERA over 41 games and 38 starts with 198 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP.

LAST TIME OUT

- Wilson was an out away from his first Double-A quality start when a defensive miscue ended his outing in the 6th inning with 2 outs at Tennessee last Saturday in game one of a doubleheader. He allowed just one unearned run on 2 hits with 2 walks and a season high 8 strikeouts. The M-Braves lost the game 4-3 in 9 innings, the first extra-inning game of the season.

ACQUIRED

- Selected by the Braves in the fourth round (109th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

2018 NOTES

- Entered the 2018 season ranked in the Braves farm system as the No. 12 prospect according to Baseball America and No. 13 prospect according to MLB.com
- Promoted to Double-A Mississippi on May 8 after going 2-0 with a 0.34 ERA (26.2IP/1ER) with 26 strikeouts and seven walks. He had a 0.86 WHIP and pitched 6.2 innings in each of his final two FSL starts and allowed no runs.
- Made Double-A debut on May 8 vs. Mobile at Trustmark Park and earned the win during the 10-3 win. He allowed two runs in the 2nd inning, but that was it over 5.0 innings with one walk and five strikeouts.

2017 NOTES

- Named by the organization as Rome's Pitcher of the Year after going 10-7 with a 2.50 ERA (38ER/137.0 IP), one shutout and 139 strikeouts over 26 starts.
- Paced all Atlanta starting pitcher farmhands in starter's ERA (min. 75.0 IP), and ranked in the Top 10 in wins (2nd, 10), strikeouts (5th, 139) and innings (6th, 137.0), while ranking fifth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.76) and tied for ninth in hits per 9.0 innings (6.9) among prospects with at least 30.0 innings.
- Earned South Atlantic League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star honors.
- Was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for 7/3-9 after tossing a five-hit, 9.0-inning shutout on 7/8 vs. West Virginia, fanning seven without a walk.
- Allowed opponents to bat .211 (105-for-497) on the season, including just a .176 (19-for-108) mark with runners in scoring position.

2016 NOTES

- Made nine appearances (six starts) after being selected in the fourth round of the First-Year Player Draft and went 1-1 with a 0.67 ERA (2 ER/26.2 IP) for the GCL Braves.
- Allowed just 16 hits over 26.2 innings and held opponents to a .172 (16-for-93) average, including a .138 (8-for-58) mark by right-handed batters...Did not allow an earned run over 18.0 innings in his six starts, while pitching to a 2.08 ERA (2 ER/8.2 IP) over three relief appearances.
