Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp catcher Cam Maron singled and homered for a career-high five RBIs, and first baseman Dustin Geiger finished a triple shy of the cycle to a 10-6 win over the Tennessee Smokies in front of 3,384 and a crowd of dogs attending Canines and Crustaceans Wednesday night at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp (13-13 second half, 43-53 overall) posted three first-inning runs against Smokies right-hander Preston Morrison (1-8). With two outs and the bases empty after a double play, right fielder John Norwood had an infield single down the third-base line. Geiger walked, and third baseman David Vidal singled to load the bases. Maron hit a two-run single into right field, before second baseman Alex Yarbrough added an RBI single to right field for a 3-0 lead. In the third inning, Norwood hit a leadoff single, and Geiger's double to left field put runners at second and third bases. Norwood was retired on a fielder's choice, but Maron hit his fourth home run down the right-field line, scoring three runs for a 6-0 lead against Morrison, who allowed eight hits and two walks with three strikeouts in three innings. Left-hander Matt Tomshaw (9-5) kept Tennessee (15-11, 51-44) scoreless the first three innings, evading a bases-loaded, no-out jam in the second. In the fourth, he hit third baseman Jason Vosler with a pitch, and right fielder Yasiel Balaguert homered to left field. That was all Tomshaw allowed in six innings, allowing six hits and no walks with seven strikeouts. In the bottom of the fourth inning, Smokies right-hander Daury Torrez allowed left fielder Austin Dean's one-out infield single before Geiger's two-out, two-run home run to the left-field berm. Playing his first game against Tennessee since he was a Smokie for 137 games in 2014 and 2015, Geiger hit his first Southern League homer since July 22, 2014. Geiger's seventh-inning single preceded Vidal's RBI double and scoring on a passed ball to make it 10-4. Jacksonville right-handers Esmerling De La Rosa, Andy Beltre and Severino Gonzalez each went an inning and combined to allow four runs.d

## NEWS AND NOTES

Roster Moves: The Miami Marlins announced a pair of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to tonight's game against the Tennessee Smokies at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville at 7:05 p.m. Right-handed relief pitcher Tayron Guerrero has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Guerrero pitched in 17 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, going 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA in his 16 innings of work. In a corresponding move, left-handed relief pitcher Jose Quijada (pronounced Key-Ha-Dah) has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Quijada pitched in 29 games for the Hammerheads, going 4-1 with a 2.47 ERA with one save. Quijada, 21, is a native of Maturin, Venezuela, and this is the first call-up to the Double-A level in his career since he was signed by the Marlins as an international free agent in 2013.

Home Is Where the Shrimp Are: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp have saved their best baseball of the season for the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville this season. Jacksonville is 27-20 at home this season, and 9-3 in the second half of the season. That's compared to a 16-34 record on the road, with a 4-11 mark in the second half. At home is where the Jumbo Shrimp have also won all of their series, going 7-2 in home series compared to a 0-10 mark on the road. The Jumbo Shrimp also hit better at home, with a .256 average at home compared to .229 on the road.

Norwood Southern League Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for the week of July 10-16, announced by the league office Monday morning. Over the past week in seven games, Norwood hit .370 (10-for-27) with three home runs, one double, five runs batted in, and four runs scored during his active seven-game hitting streak. His walk-off home run Wednesday against Biloxi was his third walk-off home run of the season for Jacksonville, and his 15 home runs are tied for second in the Southern League. In his first Double-A season, Norwood is tied for third in the Southern League with 93 games played and is third with 151 total bases.

Lee Leads The League: Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with a .326 batting average, and his 108 hits are also tops in the Southern League, in addition to his 60 runs scored. Lee also has the fifth-best on-base percentage in the league at .406. Lee had been the Southern League Player of the Week after hitting .571 from June 26 to July 2 in his first week as a Jumbo Shrimp. Lee was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the Miami Marlins on June 26 in exchange for Miami shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria.
