**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Hillcats bounced back against the Potomac Nationals on Friday night, winning by a final score of 5-1. Lynchburg scored all five of their runs in the first two innings of the game and got a strong performance from their bullpen after starter **Jean Carlos Mejia** was removed from the third inning due to an apparent injury. The only run scored by the P-Nats was unearned against reliever **Aaron Pinto**. **Nolan Jones** supplied the pop on offense, crushing a two-run home run, his fifth of the season in the second inning.

**TAKE A LOAD OFF:** Coming into the series in Potomac, infielders **Luke Wakamatsu** and **Wilbis Santiago** had gone a long time without a day off. Wakamatsu was not in the lineup on Thursday for the first time in 32 games, while Santiago got his first day off in 30 games when he sat on Friday. The addition of infielder **Connor Smith** to the roster on June 4 has given the Hillcats flexibility to give Wakamatsu and Santiago days off. The 32 consecutive games played for Wakamatsu is a team-high.

**RACE FOR THE FINISH:** The Hillcats, who enter Saturday 8.5 games behind the Wilmington Blue Rocks for first place in the Carolina League Northern Division, still have a chance to win the first half crown. Lynchburg will play its final seven games of the first half against Wilmington, meaning the Hillcats must be no more than seven games behind the Blue Rocks entering that stretch to still be in the running for the first playoff spot. The Hillcats' elimination number is currently two.

**SHUFFLING THE DECK:** The Hillcats have had a lot of movement on their roster in the month of June. Lynchburg has had at least one roster move in each of the last nine days, dating back to May 31. On Saturday, the Hillcats announced that starter **Jean Carlos Mejia** would be placed on the injured list while **Felix Tati** would be reinstated from the injured list to replace him. Entering Saturday, 15 of the 25 active players on the roster were on the 'Cats Opening Day roster.

**WE'VE GOT OUR HORSES IN THE BACK:** The bullpen has been a strength for the Hillcats entering Saturday's game with Potomac. In the series with the Nationals so far, Hillcats relievers have not allowed an earned run across 12.1 innings of work. Over that stretch, six Lynchburg relievers have struck out 13 batters while walking five. Lynchburg has the league's best bullpen with a 2.41 ERA.

**TOP-30 IN THE HILL CITY:** Lynchburg enters the season with a trio of top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. Third baseman **Nolan Jones**, the second overall prospect in the system, returns to Lynchburg after playing in 30 games for the Hillcats in 2018. Starting pitcher **Jean Carlos Mejia**, listed at No. 17, appeared in one game for Lynchburg last year after spending the majority of the season with Lake County. Outfielder **Oscar Gonzalez** rounds out the group, as the No. 22 prospect. He spent all of 2018 with the Lake County Captains, where he ranked fifth in the Midwest League in hits with 135.

**VETERAN AT THE HELM:** The Hillcats are led this season by veteran MiLB skipper Jim Pankovits, who managed Mahoning Valley, Cleveland's Short-Sea-son affiliate last year. Pankovits has managed more than 2,600 games in his minor league career, which includes stops in the Boston Red Sox, Seattle Mariners, and Houston Astros organizations. Pankovits picked up his 1,300th career managerial victory on April 21 against Myrtle Beach.

Pankovits is in his second year managing in the Indians organization after leading the Mahoning Valley Scrappers in 2018. Pankovits has 16 years of managerial experience under his belt with the Red Sox, Astros, Mariners, and Indians organizations. 2019 marks Pankovits' second stint in the Carolina League after he led the Salem Red Sox from 2006-2008. The Pennington Gap, Virginia native enjoyed a Major League career with the Astros and Red Sox as an infielder that spanned six seasons from 1984-1990.

Torres enters his first season with the Hillcats after serving as the pitching coach for Lake County in 2018. The former left-handed pitcher was selected with the 10th overall draft pick in 2000 by the Anaheim Angels and played in the minor leagues for 13 seasons, eventually reaching Triple-A. The 36-year-old Torres is a native of the Bronx, NY.

Narron comes to Lynchburg by way of Triple-A Columbus where he served in the same capacity for the Clippers in 2018. Narron is entering his third season in the Indians organization and brings Major League coaching experience to the Hillcats' staff after serving as the Milwaukee Brewers hitting coach from 2012-2014. With the Brewers, he instructed stars such as Ryan Braun, Jean Segura, Aramis Ramirez, and Carlos Gomez.

2019 will mark Mergenthaler's first season coaching stateside after serving as the hitting coach for Cleveland's Dominican Summer League co-op for two seasons. Mergenthaler is no stranger to the Commonwealth, having starred at Richmond in his college days.

Legan is entering his first season with the Hillcats and fifth in the Indians organization. Legan held the same position with the Captains in 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Scott went a career-high six innings and struck out a career-high 11 batters against Down East on June 2, earning the win in a 5-1 win by the Hillcats.

**LAST TIME VS. POTOMAC:** Scott did not last long against the Nationals on April 15, allowing four runs (one earned) in 1.2 innings while taking the loss in an 11-5 Potomac win.

### NOTABLES:

- Has only walked more than two batters in a start twice in his professional career
- In his most recent outing against Down East on June 2, went a career-high six innings while striking out a career-high 11 batters
- Started 59 games at Wofford (most in school history) of 67 games played
- Set school records with 364.2 innings pitched and 389 career strikeouts
- Ranked second in school history with 26 wins ... Third in SoCon history with 389 strikeouts
- Sister, Elizabeth, played volleyball at the University of Buffalo
- The Indians, after selecting Wofford pitcher Adam Scott in the fourth round, flew him and his girlfriend, Lauren, up to Cleveland the next day. They watched an afternoon game against the Milwaukee Brewers from a luxury box suite, were taken out to an expensive dinner and then returned to Progressive Field, where they got a private tour of the locker room, training room, weight room, batting cages and everything else.
- Scott signed his contract – with a slot-position bonus estimated at about \$400,000 – in the Cleveland clubhouse

Selected out of Wofford in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...Made stops at four different levels in 2018: Arizona, Mahoning Valley, Lake County, and Lynchburg...Made two scoreless appearances with the Hillcats...Went 8-5 with a 3.14 ERA in his senior season with Wofford while serving as a starter...Struck out 137 batters with only 18 walks...Ended his career as the active DI leader in strikeouts (389) and innings (364.2)
