Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (15-24) fell to the Mobile BayBears (16-23) by a 4-3 score in the fourth game of the five-game series at Hank Aaron Stadium on Tuesday night. Jacksonville led 3-1 going to the bottom of the ninth inning only to see the BayBears rally for three runs to win in walk-off fashion on a two-run single by Zach Gibbons. The series is now even at two games apiece heading into tomorrow's final game of the five-game set. BayBears reliever Ivan Hernandez earned the win despite giving up a pair of runs in the eighth that gave Jacksonville a 3-1 lead. Jacksonville reliever Kyle Lobstein (0-1) took the loss, and Ryan Beckman blew a save by giving up the winning score in the ninth. The BayBears scored the game's first run in the bottom of the second when Wade Wass scored from third on a wild pitch from Jacksonville starter Chris Mazza. Jacksonville quickly tied the game in the top of the third inning. After Yefri Perez started the inning with a triple, Alex Yarbrough brought him home on a sacrifice fly to even the score at 1-1. The tie remained until the top of the eighth. With Perez at first and one out, David Vidal hit an RBI triple to centerfield to score Perez and put Jacksonville in front 2-1. With Brian Anderson at the plate, BayBears catcher Jose Briceno threw to third to check on Vidal, but the throw sailed into left field to score Vidal, as Briceno's throwing error put the score at 3-1. Lobstein worked a scoreless eighth, then in the ninth the leadoff batter Forrest Allday reached first on a fielding error by Jacksonville shortstop Yarbrough. After the BayBears loaded the bases with one out, Jacksonville relieved Lobstein with Beckman. The first batter he faced Luis Tejada ripped an RBI single to left field to score Allday and keep the bases loaded as it became a 3-2 game. Beckman struck out the next batter Luis Triunfel for the second out, and then Zach Gibbons ended the game with a two-run single to left to deliver the BayBears a 4-3 victory.

Power Against Mobile: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp have had no problems hitting home runs against the Mobile BayBears so far in 2017. 12 of Jacksonville's 23 home runs have been hit against Mobile in only eight games this year.

Bencomo Against Mobile: Today will mark the second start of the season for Omar Bencomo against the BayBears. He first faced them on Saturday April 29 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Bencomo worked five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts as the Shrimp won 4-2. The win was the cherry on top of a great month of April for Bencomo, and for his great work he was named the Miami Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month.

Bye-Bye BayBears: After today's finale of the series, the Jumbo Shrimp will not face the BayBears again until a six-game series in Jacksonville from June 28 to July 3. Jacksonville will have a return trip to Mobile from August 16-20 back here at Hank Aaron Stadium.

LAST START: Bencomo had a no decision in his start on Friday May 12 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Bencomo worked six innings where he allowed three runs on nine hits with no walks and five strikeouts. Bencomo left with the game tied 3-3, only to see the Shuckers get a run in the ninth to win 4-3.

SMOKIES LOSS: Bencomo took his first loss of the season on Sunday May 7 in the first game of the doubleheader against the Tennessee Smokies at Smokies Stadium. Bencomo worked four and a third innings where he allowed nine runs (eight earned) on eight hits with a walk and four strikeouts as the Smokies won 9-2.

BAYBEARS WIN: Bencomo earned his second straight victory by defeating the Mobile BayBears on Saturday April 29 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Bencomo worked five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts as the Shrimp won 4-2.

MARLINS MiLB PITCHER OF THE MONTH FOR APRIL: Bencomo has been named the Miami Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April, announced by the Marlins front office on Friday May 5. Bencomo made five stats for the Jumbo Shrimp in April, going 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA. Over his 28 and one-third innings pitched, Bencomo held opponents to a .236 batting average, while striking out 33 batters compared to just five walks. The Jumbo Shrimp have also gone 4-1 in Bencomo's starts, and he hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in any outing this season.

BARONS WIN: Bencomo earned his third win of the year on Monday April 24 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Bencomo worked seven and a third innings where he allowed a run on four hits with a walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts. Bencomo's first seven innings were scoreless until he gave up a solo homer to Mason Robbins in the bottom of the eighth. Jacksonville won the game 4-1.

VENEZUELAN WINTER LEAGUE: Following the 2016 season, Bencomo pitched in the Venezuelan Winter League for Bravos de Margarita from October to November. There he was 4-3 with a 4.21 ERA in his 14 starts, with 48 strikeouts in his 68 and a third innings of work.

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on Feb. 10, 2017

2016 Highlights: Bencomo began the 2017 season in the Southern League with the Chattanooga Lookouts, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Bencomo went 406 with a 3.86 ERA in 19 appearances and seven starts. That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo closed out 2016 with the Rochester Red Wings in the Triple-A International League. With the Red Wings he was 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

2015 Highlights: Following time in the Tampa Bay Rays system from 2007-2011, Bencomo did not pitch professionally in the United States from 2012-14. In 2015 he pitched for the Wichita Wignuts and the Laredo Lemurs in the independent American Association. With Laredo he went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA in four starts while with Wichita he was 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA in his nine starts for the Wignuts. He was later signed that season by the Minnesota Twins and closed out the year at High-A Fort Myers. With the Miracle, he was 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts in the Florida State League.

2011 Highlights: 2011 was Bencomo's last year in the Tampa Bay organization. With Single-A Bowling Green, he was 4-5 with a 3.97 ERA in 38 games in relief.

2010 Highlights: Bencomo spent the 2010 season with Hudson Valley in the New York-Penn League. With the Renegades he was 1-3 with a 4.60 ERA in 15 appearances and three starts.

2009 Highlights: Bencomo spent his first season in the United States with the Princeton Rays in the Appalachian League. With Princeton he was 2-1 with a 3.47 ERA in nine starts.

2008 Highlights: With the Venezuelan Summer League Rays he was 1-6 with a 4.45 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts.

2007 Highlights: With the Venezuelan Summer League Devil Rays/Reds, Bencomo was 2-3 with a 2.89 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.
