Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Nick Neidert struck out a season-high 11 batters in 6 2/3 scoreless innings, and third baseman Brian Schales had his first career multi-homer game in a 7-3 win over the Mobile BayBears in front of 4,365 on Budweiser Thirsty Thursday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. After Neidert's scoreless first inning, Jacksonville (17-23) began quickly against Mobile right-hander Luis Pena (1-4). Designated hitter Kyle Barrett reached on a bunt single, center fielder Monte Harrison hit an infield single, and left fielder Cade Gotta hit an RBI single to center field. Pena's wild pitch scored Harrison to make it 2-0, and with two outs, Schales homered out of the ballpark to left field for a 4-0 lead. The lead grew in the third inning, as Gotta hit a leadoff double to right field, and Schales hit a two-out, two-run home run over the left-field ribbon board to make it 6-0. Neidert (4-3) allowed only two walks and two hits, the last of which was a triple by BayBears designated hitter Jose Rojas in the second inning, when Neidert walked a batter and got all three outs with runners at first and third bases. He retired 11 straight batters in one stretch and 17 of the final 18 he faced, becoming Jacksonville's first four-game winner this season. Pena did not allow further runs, but with one out in the sixth inning, his pitch knocked Schales' batting helmet off his head. Schales remained in the game, and the umpires issued warnings to both dugouts. Jumbo Shrimp manager Randy Ready argued and was ejected. Pena allowed eight hits and two hit batters with no walks and four strikeouts in six innings. Jacksonville added a run when Mobile right-hander Samil De Los Santos walked four batters in the seventh inning. Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Jose Pena pitched 1 1/3 scoreless innings. In the ninth inning, left-hander Jeff Kinley allowed three unearned runs on a three-run home run by BayBears catcher Michael Barash before finishing the win.

NEWS AND NOTES

Let's Play Two: Time for a doubleheader! The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp will be playing in just their second doubleheader of the season today. On April 18 in Chattanooga, Jacksonville was swept in a twinbill in Chattanooga, losing 12-4 and 3-2, with Kolton Mahoney starting Game Two of the doubleheader like he will today. Last year the club played 10 doubleheaders, and the Jumbo Shrimp won their last six doubleheader games in the second half of the season en route to a second half Southern League title. Today's doubleheader is necessary because of a postponed game on Sunday April 15 between the BayBears and Jumbo Shrimp in Jacksonville.

Schales Go Boom: Last night's two-homer game for Jumbo Shrimp third baseman Brian Schales was the first of his five-year career. Schales is just the second Jumbo Shrimp player with a multi-homer game, with the other being Austin Dean at Tennessee on April 22. Schales already has four home runs this season, and the most homers he has hit in a professional season came last year when he hit six home runs for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. Schales is hitting well lately for Jacksonville, with hits in six of the last eight games, and over the past 10 games is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with two homers and six runs batted in.

BayBears are Back: Tonight's game starts the second of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mobile BayBears, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Earlier this season the Jumbo Shrimp won three out of four games played in the first home series of the year from April 11-14. The game on Sunday April 15 was postponed due to rain, creating the need for a doubleheader on Friday May 18. This is the last trip for the BayBears to Jacksonville, and the two Jumbo Shrimp visits to Hank Aaron Stadium in Mobile will be in the second half from July 4-7 and July 28-August 1. Last year Jacksonville had a winning record against Mobile, going 14-7 overall. The clubs split the two series at Hank Aaron Stadium 5-5, while the Jumbo Shrimp were 9-2 against the BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville last season.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

33 – PABLO LOPEZ, RHP

LAST START: Lopez had his first loss of the season on Sunday May 13 against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. Lopez turned in a season-long seven innings where he allowed one run (on a fourth inning solo home run by Nick Solak) on five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. Jacksonville lost the game 1-0, and the run he allowed was his first after 22 and two-third innings were scoreless to start the year.

SMOKIES START: Lopez had his fourth straight no decision and his third straight scoreless start on Tuesday May 8 against the Tennessee Smokies at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Lopez worked five innings where he scattered two hits while walking none and striking out six batters. The Smokies won 2-1 in 10 innings.

SHUCKERS START: Lopez had his third straight no decision on Thursday May 3 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Lopez fired five scoreless innings, allowing just three hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Lopez left the game with Jacksonville in front 1-0, only to see the Shuckers win 3-2 in the bottom of the ninth on a walk-off home run by Corey Ray.

WAHOOS START: Lopez had a no decision in his first start in Jacksonville on Friday April 27 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. Lopez turned in five scoreless innings where he allowed four hits, walked a batter, and struck out three. Lopez left with the game scoreless, and the Wahoos scored their lone run in the top of the eighth inning on a solo home run by Brian O'Grady as the Wahoos won 1-0.

THE STREAK: Lopez started his time in the Southern League with his first 22 and two-third innings in scoreless fashion, a streak that stretched four complete starts and into his fifth start of the year at Montgomery on May 13. The first run he allowed came in the fourth inning of that game when he allowed a solo home run to Montgomery's Nick Solak that just cleared the centerfield wall. Despite his streak, Lopez received little run support during that time on the mound, and the Shrimp did not win any of his first five starts, during a time where he struck out 27 batters compared to four walks in 26 innings on the mound.

DISABLED LIST TO START SEASON/HOW HE GOT HERE: Lopez started the season on the disabled list with a right elbow contusion, an injury suffered during spring training. Lopez is regarded as Miami's No. 22 prospect according to MLB.com and No. 25 according to Baseball America. Lopez was originally signed by the Seattle Mariners as a non-drafted free agent on July 4, 2012. The Marlins acquired Lopez from the Seattle Mariners with OF Brayan Hernandez, RHP Brandon Miller, LHP Lukas Schiraldi in exchange for RHP David Phelps on July 20, 2017.

2017 Highlights: In 2017 was 5-8 with a 5.04 ERA in 18 starts with the Modesto Nuts before trade to Marlins. Finished the year with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads, where he was 0-3 with a 2.18 ERA in eight appearances and six starts. In 2017 walked just 20 batters in more than 145 innings, good for a walk rate of 1.2 per nine innings, that would have led the Florida State League if he had enough innings to qualify.

2016 Highlights: Spent the entire season with Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League, where he was 7-1 with a 2.13 ERA in 17 appearances and 13 starts.

TONIGHT-SPOT START: Tonight right-handed pitcher Kolton Mahoney will make a start in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader against Mobile. This marks Mahoney's third start of the season, and he has not allowed an earned run in nine innings of work in his starts. He started Game Two of Jacksonville's only other doubleheader on Wednesday April 18 at Chattanooga, working four scoreless innings where he allowed five hits with no walks and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 3-2. Mahoney made his second spot start on Wednesday May 9 in Jacksonville against the Tennessee Smokies, filling in for Elieser Hernandez who left his major league rehab assignment early to join the Marlins in Miami. Mahoney proceeded to work five innings allowing one run (unearned) on four hits with no walks and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-2 in 10 innings.

STARTING EXPERIENCE: Mahoney is a prime candidate for the rotation and this spot start, with 31 career starts under his belt. Last year pitching for Single-A Greensboro, he went 4-5 with a 4.76 ERA as a starter in 13 starts for the Grasshoppers.

SKIPPING HIGH-A: Prior to the 2018 season, Mahoney had never pitched above the Single-A level before. Mahoney had a strong spring training in Marlins minor league camp to earn his Double-A assignment to begin the 2017 season as a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen, and now as a starter in this doubleheader.

2017 IN REVIEW: Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

2017 Highlights: Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

2016 Highlights: With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 4-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.

2015 Highlights: Selected by the New York Yankees in the 16th round of the 2015 draft out of Brigham Young University. With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 3-2 with a 2.29 ERA in 12 appearances and 10 starts, with 50 strikeouts in 55 innings of work.

College: Prior to being drafted in 2015, he went 4-8 in 13 starts this season for the Cougars, striking out 91 and earning a 5.27 ERA in 85 1/3 innings pitched. In summer 2014, pitched for Orleans (Massachusetts) Firebirds in the Cape Cod League. He finished his stint there with six starts, a 3-2 record, one save, a team-high 47 strikeouts and a 1.97 ERA in regular-season play. Three times, he had double-digit strikeouts for Orleans, including 13 in a playoff victory. After his junior season with BYU, Mahoney was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23rd round in 2014 but did not sign.

Personal: Served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santa Rosa, Calif. Also was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23rd round of 2014 draft. Started for Northridge High ... honorable mention all-state in 2010 ... played in the 5A all-star game ... selected to Deseret News All-Area team ... recorded 77 strikeouts in nine starts ... threw a no hitter in 2009 against Clearfield.
