SNAPPER SNIPPETS

STATE OF THE SNAPPERS: The Snappers have lost their last 5 games after being swept in 4 games for the first time this year at Quad Cities. They return to Pohlman Field where they have won 9 of their last 11 home games with 8 upcoming games against Clinton & Wisconsin. Beloit is below .500 for the first time since July 27 & have had the same amount of wins & losses 16 times in 2017.

STARTING STORY: Beloit pitching has hit a rough patch in August after owning the league's best team ERA in July (2.57) by allowing at least 5 runs in the last 6 games. Snappers starters alone have shouldered a 9.58 ERA in the last 6 contests.

PREMIUM PUNCH OUTS: Snappers pitching reached double digits in strikeouts for the 44th time this season in Tuesday's series finale in Quad Cities. Beloit is 5th in the Midwest League in strikeouts & are on pace to snap the franchise team record of 1,186 set in 2005.

MARTIN ON THE MOVE: Mike Martin swiped his 19th base with the Snappers & his Athletics organizational-best 22nd base of the season on Monday night. Only 3 A's farmhands have swiped 20 bases in a season for the Snappers & he leads the Midwest League in stolen bases since July 4th.

RBI GUYS: Kyle Nowlin, Luke Persico, & Miguel Mercedes are the first trio with 50+ RBI for Beloit since 2015. Nowlin has delivered 23 RBI in his last 25 games while Mercedes has collected 9 in his last 8.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Beloit's defense has made a habit out of making extra outs. They lead the Midwest League in double plays (113) & outfield assists (44) while sitting 2nd in runners caught stealing (54). Luke Persico leads the league with 14 outfield assists while Collin Theroux has gunned down 35 baserunners from behind the plate, the most in the league.

CLOSE GAMES: The Snappers have played a total of 70 games decided by 3 runs or fewer & Beloit has a record of 34-36 in those contests. Additionally, Beloit's 39 one-run games are 2nd-most in the league.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers are 39-10 this year when they reach 5 runs & 13-10 in ballgames that both teams reach 5 runs.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Kyle Twomey takes the mound for the Snappers to open the homestand in his 10th start of the year. Twomey has locked in recently with 2.32 ERA over his last 5 outings as he makes his 5th consecutive start at home. Twomey has a 3.33 ERA at Pohlman Field in 2017 vs. 6.89 outside of Beloit.

FACING THE LUMBERKINGS: The Snappers & LumberKings series this season has been a streaky one dominated by the home squad. Beloit kicked that trend to begin the 2nd half by taking 3 of 4 in Clinton at the end of June. The LumberKings carry 3 of the Mariners top-30 prospects with INF Joe Rizzo (#15), RHP Seth Elledge (#22), & INF Bryson Brigrman (#27).

TWOMEY NOTES:

- Played for Short-A Eugene in 2015
- Combined on a no-hitter for the Emeralds with Preston Morrison, Luis Hernandez & Trey Masek, the team's first no-hitter since 1968; Twomey was the 2nd pitcher & walked 1 with 3 K's, also picked up the winning decision
- Went 8-2 with a 2.88 ERA during his junior season at USC in 2015, All-Pac-12 honorable mention; 12-12 record, 3.80 ERA over 3 years pitching for the Trojans
- USC had 2 winning seasons (2014-15) with Twomey on the roster & helped return the program to the NCAA Tournament in 2015 for the first time since 2005 (12 National Championships, most in NCAA baseball)
- First USC pitcher drafted by the Cubs since Mark Prior went 2nd overall in 2001
- Pitched 2 seasons in the Cape Cod Baseball League (2013-14) & was named a top-15 prospect both years
- His dad, Mark, worked as an athletic trainer in the Angels & Tigers organizations
