SNAPPER SNIPPETS

SHUTOUTS ON THE 8'S: The Snappers pitching tossed their 8th shutouts of the season in Thursday's 8-0 win which was also the 8th time Kane County had been blanked in 2017. It was also Beloit's 3rd shutout in their last 6 games.

RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD: Beloit & Kane County will need the 3rd game of the series to decide a winner after splitting the first 2. The Snappers are 4-5 in rubber matches this year & this is their first of the second half. The Snappers & Cougars have played one rubber game this year that resulted in their 17-inning marathon back in April.

POWER OUTAGE: Between Beloit & Kane County, there have only been 2 home runs in the season series at Northwestern Medicine Field, both hit by Snappers (**JaVon Shelby** & **Josh Vidales**). The home of the Cougars has seen the fewest home runs hit among Western Division ballparks (37) with West Michigan's Fifth Third Ballpark being the only stadium with fewer (31).

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: Beloit has won 10 of their last 14 games & are one game below the .500 mark. The Snappers have not been .500 since June 9 when they were 30-30 & have had the same amount of wins & losses 14 times in 2017.

CLOSE GAMES: The Snappers have played a total of 65 games decided by 3 runs or fewer & Beloit has a record of 31-34 in those contests. Each of Beloit's last 7 games have had finals of 3 runs or less. Additionally, the Snappers have played in 35 one-run games which is the 2nd-most in the Midwest League behind only Kane County.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: The Snappers are 35-7 this season when they score at least 5 runs. Beloit is 11-7 in ballgames that both teams reach 5 runs.

LOEHR IN JULY: Trace Loehr has been scorching hot at the plate this month. His .373 average this month is 4th in the Midwest League & he has 9 multi-hit games over 21 games played. Loehr has hit 2 homers this month, the first month of his pro career with multiple home runs. Trace also legged out his 3rd triple of the month last night & his 14th as a Snapper, just 2 behind **Brian Finley's** franchise record of 16 triples between 1982-84.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Zack Erwin will toe the rubber for the Snappers in the season finale against Kane County. Erwin is riding a 15-inning scoreless stretch spanning his last 3 starts. He began this streak with 6 shutout innings against the Cougars on July 10 & set a career-high in strikeouts with 8. This will be Erwin's 3rd career start against a Diamondbacks affiliate. His other appearance was with Stockton vs. Visalia & took the loss after 7 IP.

FACING THE COUGARS: Beloit has an opportunity to win their first series against Kane County in the final meeting of the season between the 2 squads. The Cougars clinched the season series with a 3-2 win on Wednesday night when they played their 7th one-run game head-to-head. The Cougars currently carry 4 of the Diamondbacks top-30 prospects with **Marcus Wilson** (#8), **Anfernee Grier** (#11), **Mack Lemieux** (#29), & **Tyler Mark** (#30).

- Began the season in Athletics Extended Spring Training & added to the Snappers roster on May 27
- Two-time Midwest League Pitcher of the Week in 2017; June 12-18 with 11.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 11 K's over 2 starts vs. Quad Cities & July 10-16 with 2 scoreless starts reaching 11 IP, 6 H, & 15 K's
- First Snappers player since Tyler Marincov in 2014 to earn weekly league honors multiple times in the same season & first pitcher to win multiple Pitcher of the Week awards since Daniel Osterbrock was Midwest League Pitcher of the Week in back-to-back weeks in 2010
- Set new career-high in strikeouts with 8 over 6 scoreless innings vs. Kane County on July 10

2016:

- Made his Athletics organization debut with High-A Stockton on April 12 vs. Lancaster; made a total of 18 outings for the Ports including 16 starts
- Reassigned to Beloit on July 20 & made 5 appearances with the Snappers before going on the DL on August 19
- Struck out a career-high 7 hitters at Pohlman Field on August 12 vs. Wisconsin over 5.0 IP to get his lone winning decision for Beloit

- Split his first professional season between Great Falls & Kannapolis in 2015 in the White Sox organization
- Highest of 7 total Clemson players drafted in 2015 & the 2nd selection by the White Sox that year after taking RHP Carson Fulmer with the 8th overall pick in the draft
- Carried a 3.50 ERA over 3 seasons at Clemson & had a career record of 16-9; went 7-4 his junior season & career-best 3.04 ERA as the Saturday starter for the Tigers that season
- Teammates at Clemson with fellow Athletics farmhands RHP Daniel Gossett & INF Eli White
- Tossed 8.0 IP & struck out 11 to get the win vs. No. 3 Louisville on May 21, 2015 in the ACC Tournament; Tigers lost in NCAA regionals all 3 of his seasons
- Had a 1.70 ERA in the Cape Cod League in 2014, No. 20 prospect in the league that summer according to Baseball America
- Owns school records in career & single-season wins & strikeouts at Duluth HS in Georgia; also 3-year letterman in basketball
