ODDS AND ENDS:

A rare day game - The Generals are playing a game at 2:05 for the first time since June 15th, a 2:05 game with Jacksonville in Jackson. Today's heat index at first pitch will be 107.

"LOOKOUT" It has been a while - The Generals are facing the Chattanooga Lookouts for the first time since a series April 19-23 in Jackson. The Generals are 5-7 against Chattanooga and 2-5 in Jackson this season.

Familiar Names for Lookouts - Saturday's 1B Alex Liddi, once a top prospect for the Mariners played in 134 games for Jackson in 2010, batting .281 with 15 home runs, 37 doubles, 8 triples, and had a .353 on-base percentage. The now 26-year-old was a 2010 SL All-Star.

Chattanooga SS Corey Seager is the youngest brother of former General and current M's All-Star 3B **Kyle Seager**. Corey was the Dodgers 1st round pick, 18th overall in 2012. He is rated by Baseball America as LA's No. 2 overall prospect. Kyle's middle brother Justin currently plays for Seattle's Low-A affiliate in Clinton.

Leading the SL in Homers Since July 1st - After hitting just 40 home runs over their first 81 games, Jackson has hit 46 home runs over their last 50 games since July 1st which leads the Southern League in that period of time. The Generals have hit 25 home runs in August and 10 in their last 7 games.

Today's starter Olson finishing strong - Over his last 4 starts in August, LHP **Tyler Olson** is 3-1 with a 1.09 ERA (3 ER, 24.2 IP). During this stretch he has limited opponents to a .223 (21x94) average, while walking 4 and striking out 20. After going 3-5 with a 4.56 ERA (36 ER, 71.0 IP) over his first 13 AA starts, Olson is 5-2 with a 2.41 ERA (11 ER, 41.0 IP) over his last 7 starts.

RH Trevor Miller has not allowed an earned run in his last 21.2 innings over 9 relief appearances. During this stretch, since July 24, he has limited opponents to a .192 (14x73) average, while walking 4 and striking out 18.

GENERALS STREAKS:

INF Dan Paolini has hit in 4 straight games with 2 multi-hit efforts. He's batting .538 (7x13) with 3 doubles, 3 runs, 1 RBI and 3 walks.

GENERALS IN SEATTLE:

The current active Mariners roster features 13 former Generals. 3B **Kyle Seager** was named an American League All-Star.

Roenis Elias, Tom Wilhelmson, Dominic Leone and Yoervis Medina, Erasmo Ramirez and Taijuan Walker are members of the M's pitching staff.

Dustin Ackley, Michael Saunders, Kyle Seager, Brad Miller, Jesus Sucre, Mike Zunino and Chris Taylor are position players.

GENERALS RECAP:

The Generals scored a run in the bottom of the 4th inning and rallied for 1 in each of the final 3 innings, but Jackson fell to Chattanooga 15-4 on Saturday night.

1B Dan Paolini (2x3, 2 R, 2B, BB) led the team with 2 hits, while **LF Leon Landry** (1x5), **2B Patrick Brady** (1x5, R), **3B D.J. Peterson** (1x2, R, 2 BB), **CF Patrick Kivlehan** (1x4, RBI), **C Tyler Marlette** (1x4, 2B) and **SS Brock Hebert** (1x4, 2 RBI) each recorded 1 of the Generals 8 hits.

Starter **Cam Hobson** (5.1, 13, 10, 9, 0, 3, HR) recorded his 10th loss of the season, allowing 10 runs (9 R) on 13 hits in 5.1 innings. **RH Moises Hernandez** (1.0, 7, 5, 5, 3, 3, HR) allowed 5 runs in the 6th inning, while **RH Stephen Shackleford** (0.2, 0, 0, 0, 0, 1) and position player **RH Kevin Rivers** (2.0, 3, 0, 0, 0, 2) combined to hold the Lookouts scoreless over the final 2.2 innings in relief.

KIVLEHAN, LARA & PETERSON PUTTING UP BIG NUMBERS:

Overall this season, **Patrick Kivlehan**, **Jordy Lara** and **D.J. Peterson** have put up impressive numbers that rank among the best in MiLB. Here is how they rank in all of MiLB and the Seattle Mariners organization. Lara currently is T-1st in all of MiLB in hits with 169 this season. Peterson and Lara are the first two Mariners farmhands to reach 100 RBI's this season.

During this stretch he has limited opponents to a .223 (21x94) average, while walking 4 and striking out 20. After going 3-5 with a 4.56 ERA (36 ER, 71.0 IP) over his first 13 AA starts, Olson is 5-2 with a 2.41 ERA (11 ER, 41.0 IP) over his last 7 starts.

vs. Chattanooga: ...This will be his first start against the Lookouts

Last Outing: ...Olson picked up his second straight win in game 1 of a doubleheader at Huntsville on Tuesday, allowing just 2 runs on 7 hits in 5.1 innings pitched. Olson struck out 4 and did not walk a batter as Jackson won 6-2 at Joe Davis Stadium.

PERSONAL:...Tyler R. Olson...graduated from University (WA) High School in June, 2008...originally selected by Oakland in 17th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player draft, but did not sign...

2014 Season: ...Began season with A+ High Desert and in 5 starts was 2-1, with a 3.13 ERA before being promoted to Jackson on 5/2 when RHP Stephen Landazuri was placed on the DL...
 • Season-long and 2nd-longest outing of his career on 6/5 at Birmingham allowing 3 runs on 5 hits in 8.0 innings, earning his 2nd AA win.

GONZAGA CAREER: graduated from Gonzaga University in June, 2013...was named West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Year and named WCC Pitcher of the Month for April in 2013... Finished his career with a 13-10 record and a 3.63 ERA in 45 games, 33 starts, 6 complete games, 1 save, 223.1 innings pitched, 73 walks, 188 strikeouts...His senior season in 2012 he was 5-4 with a 2.77 ERA in 15 starts, 4 complete games, 110.1 innings, 27 walks, 90 strikeouts...

TOMORROW'S GENERALS STARTER - RHP STEPHEN LANDAZURI (6-5, 4.13)

Monday's Start: 22-year-old RHP Stephen Landazuri makes his 18th start of 2014 in game 4 of the series vs. Chattanooga. Landazuri was on the DL from 4/29-6/14 with an oblique strain. This is "Lando's" 76th career game and 71st career start.

vs. Chattanooga: ...In 2 starts against Chattanooga this season Landazuri is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA. His last start vs. CHA was on 4/22 in Jackson and he allowed 3 runs on 4 hits in 5.0 innings pitched while walking 1 and striking out 9.

Last Outing: ...Landazuri suffered his 3rd loss in his previous 4 starts on Wednesday in Jackson's 6-4 loss at Huntsville. He allowed 4 runs on 2 hits in 2.2 inning pitched, walking 4 and striking out just 1.
